

Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




· Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



Assembly Steps



This Left Armchair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Left Armchair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.



Open the carton and place all the parts onto a clean, non-marring surface.

Place the Left Armrest(H) with its inside facing up.


Attach Chair Back(I) to the corresponding point in Left Amrest(H) using Bolt(②) and Washer(③) with Allen Key(①) as shown above.

Do not fully tigthen.

ATTENTION: There may be some PE wicker that may have covered the Mounting Points. To ease assembly, guide and slide the PE wicker away from these Mounting Points.

DO NOT CUT AWAY ANY PE WICKER as this would cause the wicker to unravel!


Step 2



Attach Seat(J) between the Left Armrest(H) and Back(I) using Bolt(2) and Washer(3) with Allen Key(1) from position # I to # V as shown above.

Do not fully tigthen.


Step 3



Attach Side Plate(D) between the Back(I) and Seat(J) using Bolt(②) and Washer(③) with Allen Key(①) as shown above.


Do not fully tigthen.

Step 4



Attach the Foot(E) to the Chair using Bolts((2))with Allen Key((1)).

Step 5



Turn the Left Armchair right side up.

Place the Left Armchair on a LEVEL SURFACE.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Gently and gracefully, sit into to the Left Armchair.

This would help to align all the parts at all the joint areas.

Then get off the Left Armchair, and in a sequential manner, proceed to tighten all bolts.

When tightening the Bolts, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any Bolt fully and then move on to the next one.


This may cause the frame to warp.

If there is still wobbles, loosen the bolts and execute this same process.

If the Left Armchair is not stable it could lead to damage to the product.

Note: This step is done better with the assistance of a second adult.


Step 6



Place the Back Cushion(G)and Seat Cushion(F) onto the Left Armchair as shown. Your Left Armchair is ready for use.

Caution: This Left Armchair can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Additional Hardware:



In the event that you should purchase more than one pieceof this Sofa,the Connector G(4) can be used to link up the Sofas to achieve a Sectional Sofa. Simply place the Sofas together and firmly push the Connector G(4) down until it locks into place.

Care & Maintenance



Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface





Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor prodcts, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
