Caution: This Chair is NOT a TOY.


Keep your child/children at bay during the assembly process.

Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-




Save all packaging until finished-


Assembly Steps



This Left Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Left Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




Place Left Arm Panel (I) facedown as pictured.

Step 2.1: Insert dowel on Support Bar (K) into housing on Left Arm Panel (I). Attach Support Bar (K) to Left Arm Panel (I) by using Bolt (7) and Allen Key (9).

Step 2.2: Insert dowels on Backrest Panel (G) into housing on Left Arm Panel (I). Attach Backrest Panel to Left Arm Panel (I) by using Bolts (7) and Allen Key (9).

DO NOT FULLY TIGHTHEN BOLTS.




Place the Right Panel (H) facedown as pictured.

With the help of your adult partner, insert dowels on Support Bar (K) and Backrest Panel (G) of the pre-assembled in Step 2 into the housings on Right Arm Panel (H) as shown above.

Attach Support Bar (K) and Backrest Panel (G) to Right Arm Panel (H) by using Bolts (7) and Allen Key (9).

DO NOT FULLY TIGHTHEN BOLTS.




Stand the Chair frame up.

Insert Seat Panel (J) onto Chair frame as shown above.

Attach Seat Panel (J) with Chair by using Screws (8) with Allen Key (9).

Note: Using Screws (8) from inside to outside of Seat Panel (J)


DO NOT FULLY TIGHTHEN SCREWS.



Inspect the Chair and make sure all parts are adequately connected. Carefully sit onto the Chair. This pressure will help align all parts at all joints.


In a sequential manner, tighten all Bolts and Screws at all joints. Adjust the Levellers until the Chair is level with the ground.

To adjust the Levellers, get assistance from an adult partner to lift/lean and hold the Chair while you are working.



Place Back Cushion (M) and Seat Cushion (L) onto the Chair, and affix the velcro of Seat Cushion (L) straps around the Chair as shown above. The Chair is ready to be used.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.



With assistance from your adult partners, place the Chairs facedown and connect the pre-attached clips to connect the Chairs together.

Note: This is an optional step in case you want to connect all the Chairs in the set together and should be performed before affixing the cushions.
