


- Place the Table Top (A) upside down on the smooth carpeted surface.
 - (i) Attach the Mounting Plate (D) to the Table Top (A) using Bolt (J), Lock Washer (L) and Flat Washer (M) with the Allen Wrench (N).
 - (ii) Attach the Center Stretcher (E) to the Table Top (A) using Bolt (K), Lock Washer (L) and Flat Washer (M) with the Allen Wrench (N).
 - (iii) Attach the Center Cross Bar (F) to the Post (C) using Bolt (G), Lock Washer (H) and Flat Washer (I) with the Allen Wrench (N).






Close the Table Top (A).



Adjust the spike to balance table.




Cleaning & Care










Place the Chair Back (A) upside down on the smooth carpeted surface. Attach the Seat (B) to the Chair Back (A) using Bolt (D), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) into the middle holes, and using Bolt (F), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) into the corner holes, tightening with the Allen Wrench (I).



Attach the Front Leg (C) to the Seat (B) using Bolt (E), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) with the Allen Wrench (I).
