




Place the Table Top (A) up side down on the floor with a piece of cloth or carpet underneath to prevent the finish from scratching. Attach the Table Leg (B) to Table Top (A) using Flat Washer (D), Lock Washer (E) and Hex Nut (C) by Wrench (F). Do not fully tighten.





Turn the Table to upright position, place it on flat surface and adjust legs so that Table is level and does not wobble. Assembly product is now completed.






Attach the Front Leg (C) to Wooden Seat (B) using Flat Washer (G), Lock Washer (H) and Hex Nut (F) by Wrench (J). Do not fully tighten.




Take the Allen Wrench, and turn the bolts until the legs are secure. DO NOT TIGHTEN COMPLETELY.


Stop when you feel you are adding force to tighten the bolt.




Do not over-tighten beyond hole depth.


