
1 Align and fasten mounting plate(B) to pedestal column(C) using hex nut(J), big spring washer(K) and big flat washer(L) and tighten with wrench(I).



2 Place table top upside down on soft surface. Align and fasten mounting plate(B) to table top(A) using bolt(F), small spring washer(G) and small flat washer(H) and tighten with Allen wrench(E).
** Do not fully tighten the nut or bolt until all nuts and bolts are attached.



3 | Screw in the leveler(M) to the bottom of pedestal leg(D). Align and fasten pedestal leg(D) to pedestal column(C) using hex nut(J), big spring washer(K), and big washer(L) and tighten with wrench(I).









Stand table up on an even surface and check that it is balanced. If there is a slight wobble, please adjust the leveler.


Cleaning & Care




1 Put the Chair Back (A) and Box Frame (B) upside down on the soft and smooth surface. With assistance attach Box Frame (B) (make sure Arrow sticker is facing upward) onto Chair Back (A). Then insert Jcbc Bolt (E), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) into predrilled holes of each corner by using Allen Wrench (J). Insert Jcbc Bolt (F), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) into the predrilled holes of the middle of Chair Back (A), by using Allen Wrench (J). Do not fully tighten the bolts in this step.




Take the Allen Wrench, and turn the bolts until the legs are secured.
DO NOT TIGHTEN COMPLETELY.

Stop when you feel you are adding force to tighten the bolt.

2 Attach Front Leg (D) (Left-Right) to corner of Box Frame (B) by inserting Flat Washer (H), Lock Washer (G) and Jcbc Bolt (E) with Allen Wrench (J).



3 Attach Wooden Seat (C) and Box Frame (B) with Csk-Cb Screw (I) by using Screwdriver (not included). Tighten all the screws in this step.



Stand chair up on an even surface and check that it is balanced. If there is a slight wobble, apply downward pressure in the corner where a leg is uneven. Keeping pressure in that corner, tighten all bolts. If balanced, apply downward pressure evenly in the center and tighten all bolts. Do not over-tighten beyond hole depth.

Helpful Tip: - Instead of applying downward pressure while reaching under to tighten bolts, have someone sit in the chair while you tighten the bolts.
