



Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-




Save all packaging until finished-

Assembly Steps




This chair has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1




Attach Left Front Leg(F) to Chair Plate(D) using Bolt(2) with Allen Key(4).

Step 2




Attach Right Front Leg(E) to Chair Plate(D) using Bolt(2) with Allen Key(4).

Step 3




Attach Junction Plate 1(G) between legs using Bolt(②) with Allen Key(④).

Step 4




Attach Left Arm(B) and Right Arm(C) to legs using Bolt(2) with Allen Key(4).

Step 5




Attach Backrest(A) to Arms and Chair Plate(D) using Bolt(1) and Bolt(3) with Allen Key(4).

Step 6



Attach Junction Plate 2(H) to Chair Plate(D) using Bolt(1) with Allen Key(4).
