### Storage and transport


- Do not expose the product to the weather unnecessarily.

- The product is sensitive to frost. Store the product for the winter where it is dry and well ventilated.


## Disposing of the packaging


The packaging consists of cardboard and correspondingly marked plastics that can be recycled.

- Make these materials available for recycling.


