## Assembly Steps



This Chaise Lounge has multiple parts and may require up to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chaise Lounge parts picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Plethrough the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the perspective before assembly.


#### Step 1



Open the carton and place all parts on a clean, undamaged suthe support bar(C) into the leg bars and affix it with bolts (1) a Key (6).

Do not tighten the bolts completely.


#### Step 2



Insert the leg support tube (D) into the leg bars and affix it with Washer( $\Im$ )and the Allen Key ( $\Im$ ).

Do not tighten the bolts completely.


## Step 3



Affix the adjuster bar (B) to the backrest using Gaske (4), bolt Washer(3) and the Allen Key (6).

Do not tighten the bolts completely.

### Step 4



Stand the Chaise Lounge up.

Place the Chaise Lounge on a LEVEL SURFACE.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Gently and carefully, sit onto to the Chaise Lounge.

This will help to align all the parts at all joints.

Then get off the Chaise Lounge, and in a sequential manneer, tighten all Bolts.

When tightening the Bolts, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any Bolt fully and then move on to the next or This may cause the frame to warp.

If there are any wobbles after tightening, loosen the bolts and same process.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

• What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Califo significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defec reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Prop enables Californians to make informed decisions about their expendences.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowing significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking v Proposition 65requires California to publish a list of chemicals kn cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list? The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthet that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common hous food, drugs, dyers, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be use manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of ch processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.
- What does a warning mean?


If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chem By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly bel observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.






