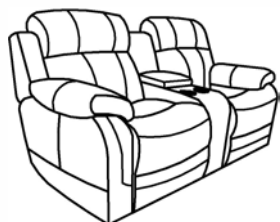
STEP #1

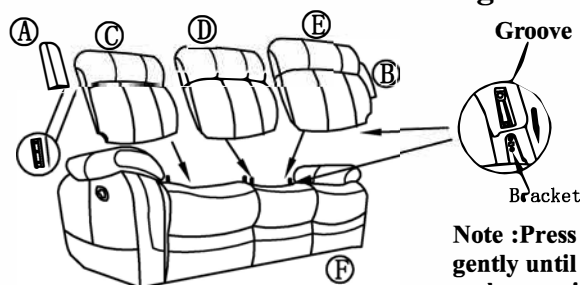

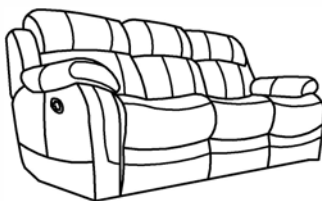
