



CAUTION

- Before starting installation of this fixture or removal of a previous fixture, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box.



INSTALLATION


STEP 1

Unscrew the **ball nuts** from the **mounting unit**. Use the **mounting screws** to attach the **mounting unit** to the junction box.



STEP 2


Install lamp holder on the **fixture**.



INSTALLATION


STEP 3

Install **stems** based on the desired length of the item, adding **canopy** once finished.



STEP 5

Secure the canopy to the mounting unit with the ball nuts.




STEP 4

Make the electrical connection from the junction box to the **fixture**. Connect the ground wire to the **mounting unit** using the preinstalled green ground screw. Then, connect the positive, negative and ground wires with the supplied **wire nuts**. Secure with electrical tape.

Connect Clear, Brown, Gold or Black Parallel Wire without tracer (round & smooth) or Black Fixture Wire to:

Black or Red Supply Wire or Insulated Wire (other than green) with copper conductor. Connect Clear, Brown, Gold or Black *Parallel Wire with tracer (square & ridged) or White Fixture Wire to:

White Supply Wire or Insulated Wire (other than green) with silver conductor



STEP 6 Install bulbs (not included)
