

IMPORTANT


- 1. Do not tighten bolts / screws completely until all bolts / screws are lined up and inserted into holes.
- 2. Do not over tighten screws and bolts to avoid stripping.
- 3. Please use hand tools to assemble this product. Do not use power tools.



Let's get this thing fired up! Please take a moment to match the sticker on the bottom of the chair back with the sticker on the corner block.



Do <u>NOT</u> overtighten hardware.






Let's secure those legs in place! Consider this your workout of the day.




Do <u>NOT</u> overtighten hardware.





Match the sticker on the bottom of the front chair legs with the sticker on the corner blocks before tightening hardware.






Last, but not least, screw on the Front Footrest (E) and Side Stretchers (F). We told you this was going to be easy! If you are having trouble getting the screws to catch, it is recommended to carefully use an electric screwdriver or drill with necessary bit for this step.



Do not over-tighten; holes may become stripped.






Issues with stretchers aligning at an angle?

If the stretchers are set at an angle when you are aligning them with their respective holes on the front & back legs, you have likely assembled the front legs incorrectly.



Re-check to confirm that the proper legs are installed in their intended position on the proper side of the stool.

The front legs are not interchangeable; therefore they may need to be rotated and swapped to the opposite side.





Carefully flip the stool over on a flat surface and make sure the legs are touching the ground evenly before tightening everything to 100%. You did it! Go tuck your bar stool into your kitchen island and celebrate with some pizza! If your stool feels a little wobbly or unstable, re-address all fasteners to ensure they are 100% tightened.

If your stool STILL feels a little wobbly or unstable,

try loosening some of the fastener connections slightly in order to allow yourself to re-level all the legs on a flat surface before going back around & re-tightening everything back to 100%.



We want your bar stool to last as long as possible, so we recommend that you tighten the screws 2 weeks after assembly and for added safety check the tightness of all screws every 2 months.
