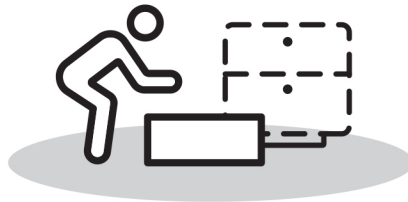
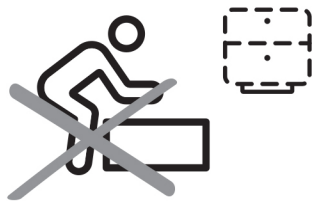
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



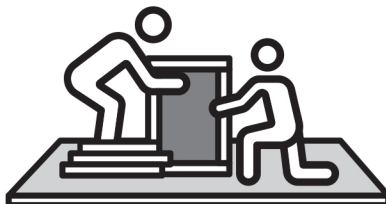
Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

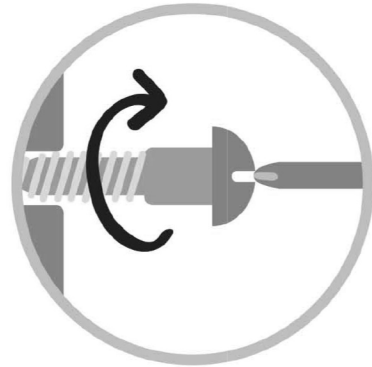
ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE

Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.

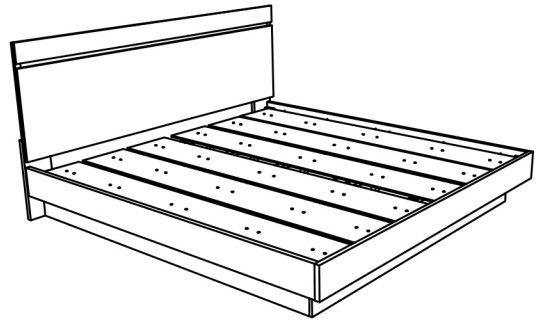
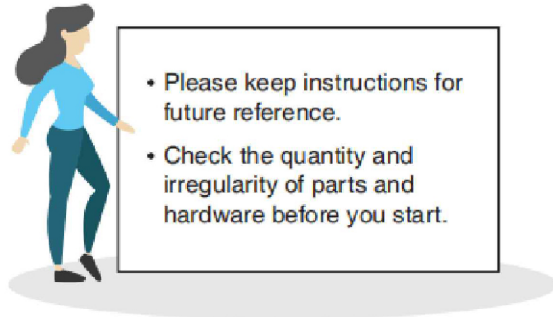
Use the appropriate hand tools

screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.













After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

- Part #1 x1pc
- Part #2 x2pcs
- Hardware #B x4pcs
- Hardware #C x4pcs

- Hardware #E x8pcs

Align headboard legs (#2L/R) to the headboard (#1). Secure using bolts (#B) with washers (#C,D) and screws (#E) as shown in the diagrams.

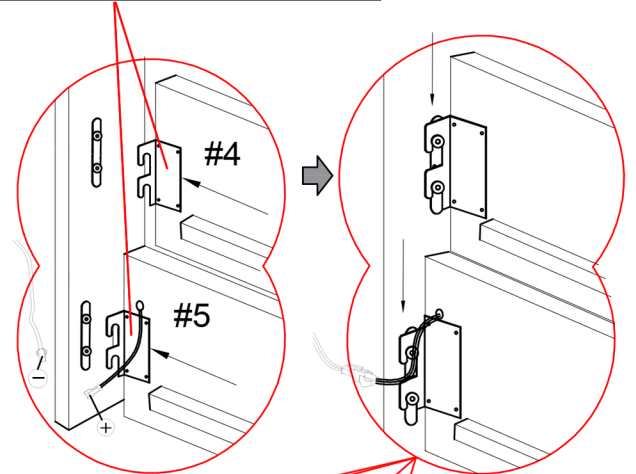

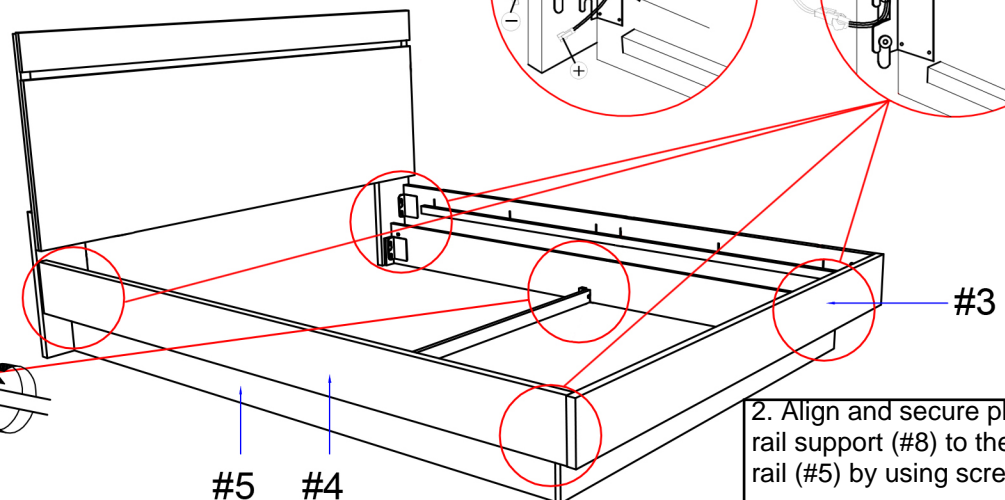
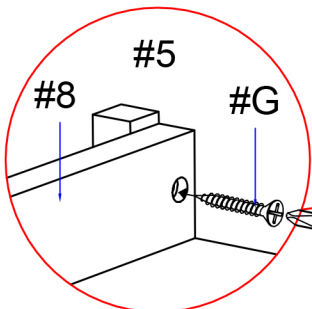


PLEASE REMOVE MASKING TAPE BEFORE CONNECT

1. Align and hook side rails (#4,5) to the headboard legs (#2L/R) and footboard (#3). Tighten the bolts to secure in place.

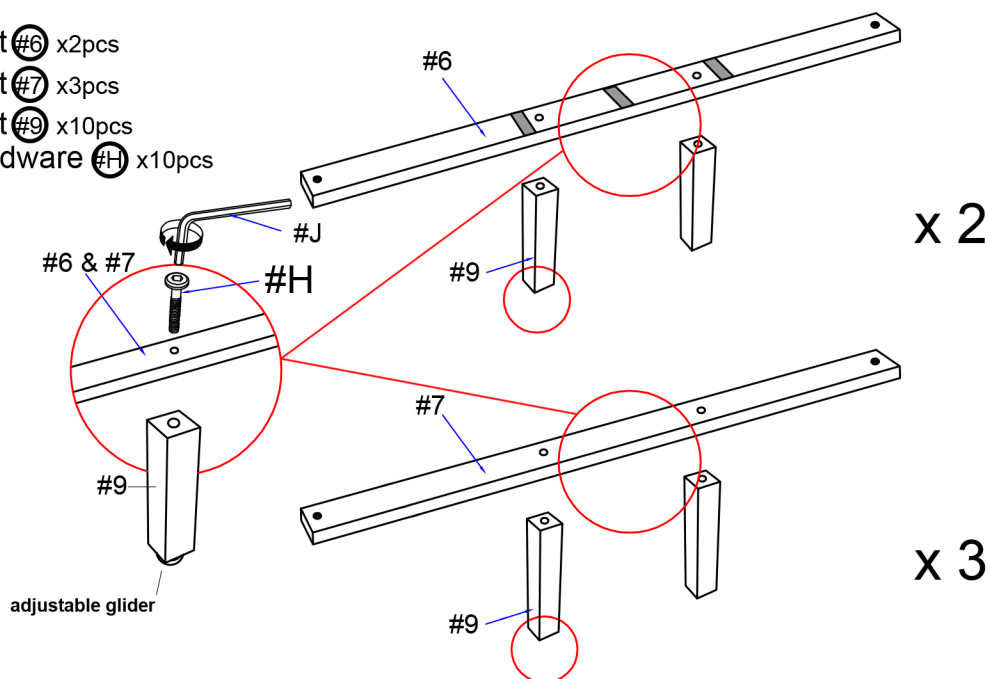
2. Align and secure platform rail support (#8) to the platform rail (#5) by using screws (#G).

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Attach bed slat supports (#9) to the slats (#6,7) using bolts (#H).
Adjust leveler to the height of the floor

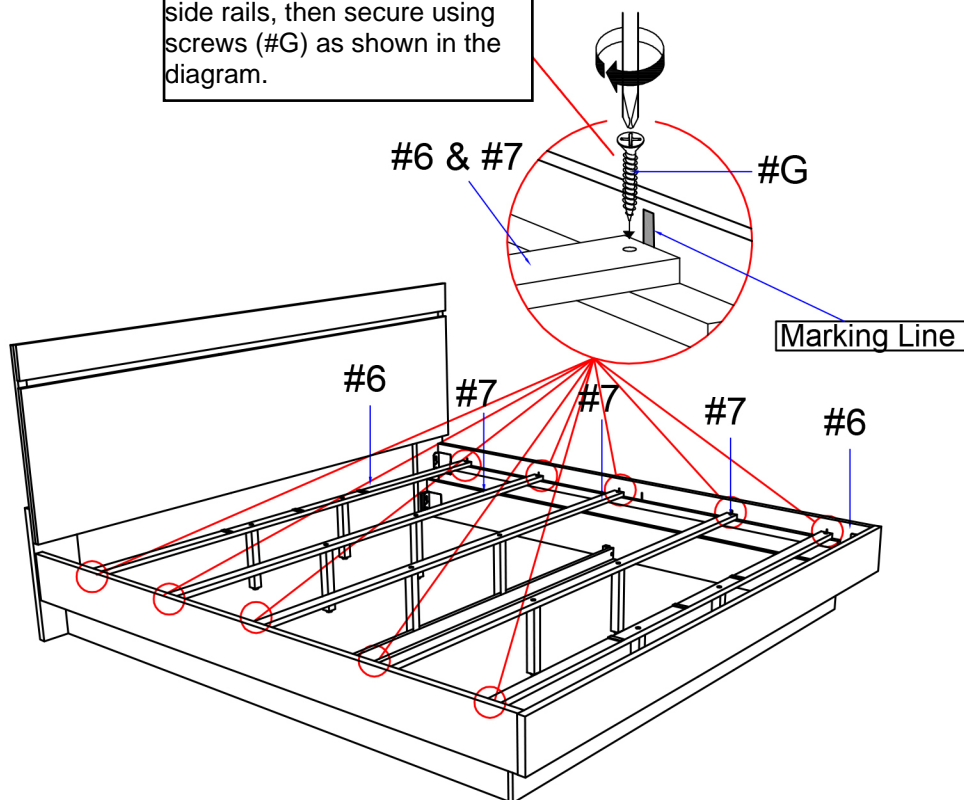

Align slats (#6,7) evenly to the side rails, then secure using screws (#G) as shown in the diagram.

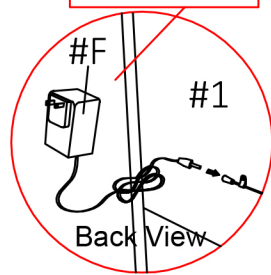

Marking Line



1. Please refer to step (#5) on how to align and place concealed panels (#10) correctly.
2. Secure the concealed panels (#10) to the bed slats (#6,7) by using screws(#I).

ASSEMBLY COMPLETED
