Rough Wall Opening

Overall Size	Rough Wall Opening
36 in.(W) X 26 in.(H) X 5 in.. (D)	36-1/4 in(W) X 25-5/16 in. (H) X 3-7/8 in. (D)

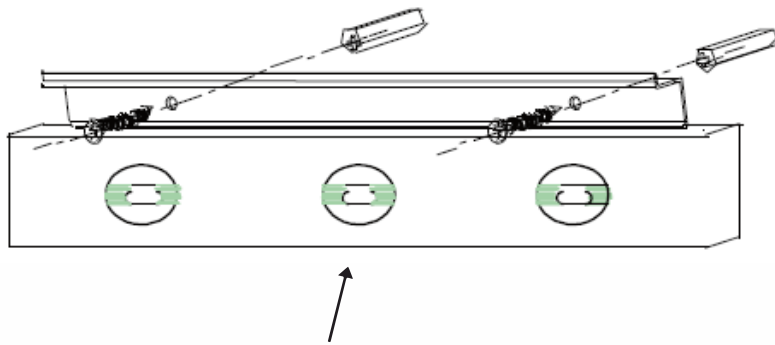

Installation Guide

Step 1

Measure and mark two bottom mounting holes on the wall corresponding to the pre-drilled hole locations in the bottom mounting bar.

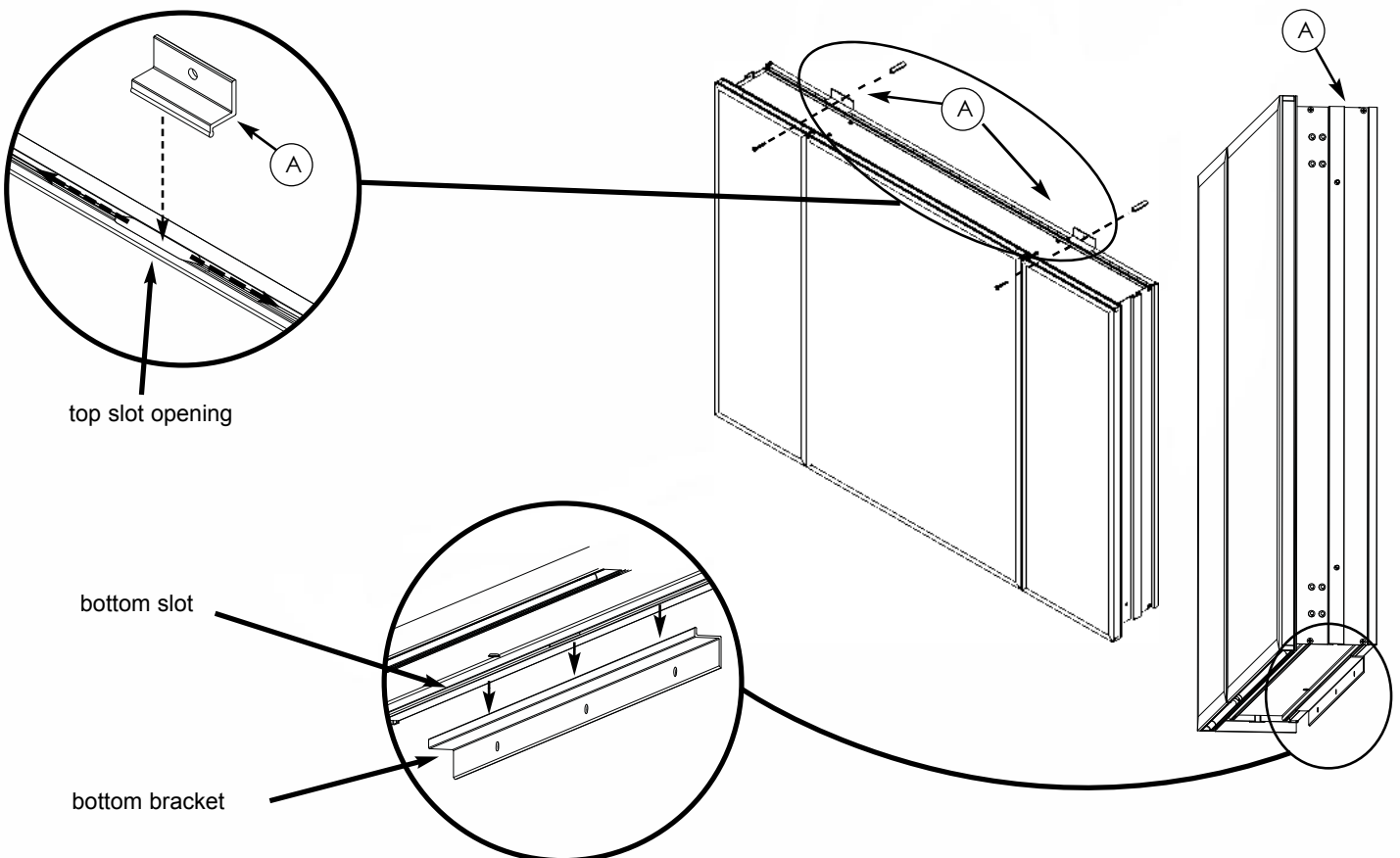


Draw horizontal line connecting the two bottom marked locations. the line should to be level. adjust to level if necessary.

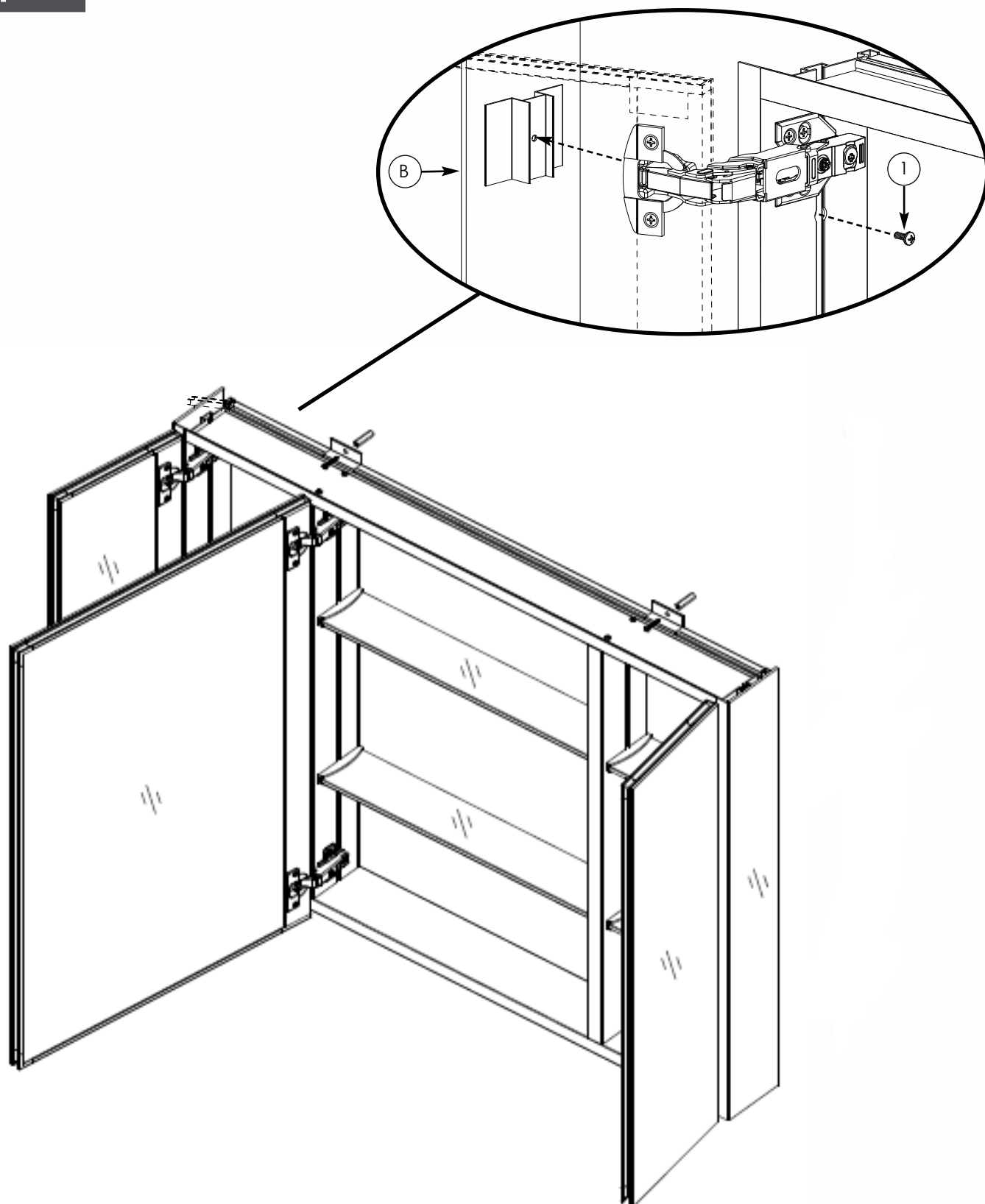
Use a 1/4 in. (6 mm) drill bit for drywall anchor installation. Use a 1/8 in. (3mm) drill bit for direct stud installation.

NOTE: If installing into a material other than drywall or into stud, consult a professional for proper installation.

Fasten the side mirrors (B) to the cabinet body (A) with side mirror screws (1), as shown.

RECESS MOUNT INSTRUCTIONS

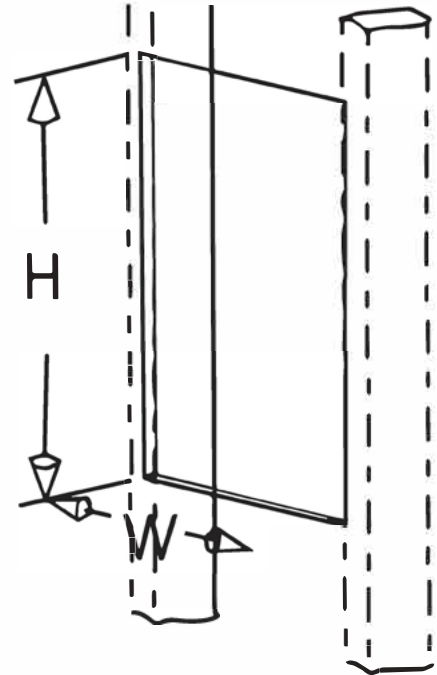
NOTE: Rough opening is not an exact measurement. The extra space allows cabinet to be inserted into the opening. Add shims to level and tighten space if necessary. Additional framing might be required.

STEP 1

NOTE: Before cutting the rough opening, check for pipes, electrical cables, or heating ducts. If it is required to remove part of stud, make sure that the wall is not a load bearing wall.

Prepare the opening in the wall for the cabinet body. Make sure that there is support on both sides of the opening to attach the cabinet body, as shown.

NOTE: The cabinet height should be a minimum 2 in. above faucet.

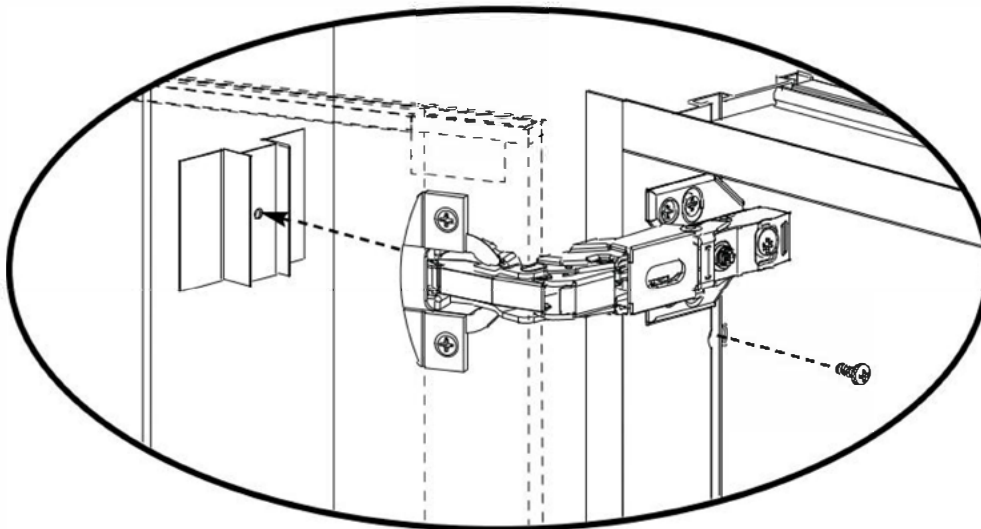


STEP 2

Position the cabinet body in the rough wall opening. Make sure that the cabinet body flange covers the wall opening uniformly.

Secure both sides of the cabinet body to the wall supports using mounting screws.

NOTE: The cabinet body must be level for the door to work properly.



SHELF ADJUSTMENT

For your convenience, adjustable shelves have been pre-installed. In order to adjust shelf location:

- 1 Carefully slide the shelf out from shelf clips. See fig.1.
- 2 Loosen each shelf clip screw (two for each shelf) and slide to the desired location. See fig 2.
- 3 Carefully slide the shelf into the shelf clips making sure shelf is level and retighten shelf clip screws.

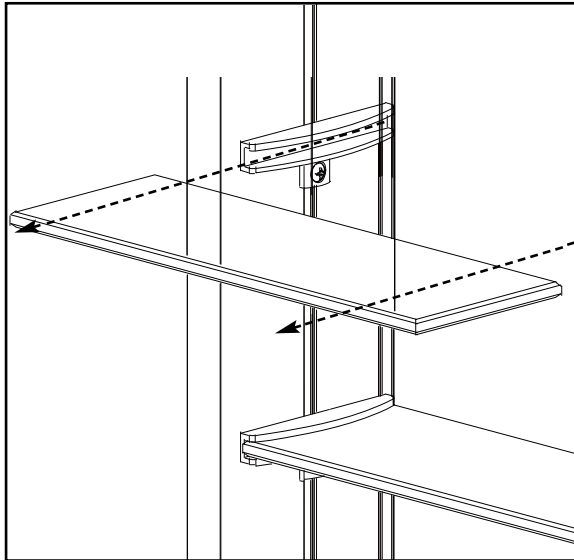
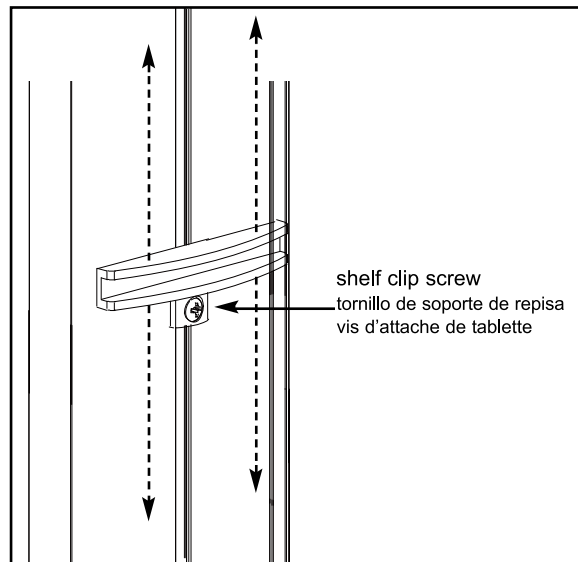

HINGE ADJUSTMENT

SIDE-TO-SIDE:

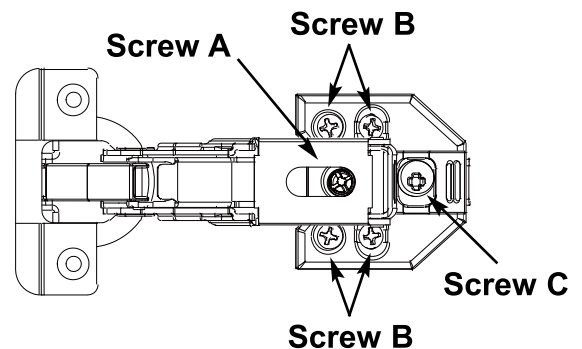
Door is adjustable side to side by turning screw A clockwise or counterclockwise.

UP-DOWN:

Loosen screw B on both top and bottom of hinge plate. Raise or lower door to the desired position and re-tighten both screws.

IN-OUT:

Loosen screws C on both top and bottom hinges. Move the door in or out to desired position and re-tighten.

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This warranty is extensive in that it covers replacement of all defects. Future Glass may, at its option, examine and inspect the alleged defective product and Future Glass may request that parts be returned to Future Glass at Owner's expense for factory assessment and inspection. If Future Glass determines product to be covered by the above Warranty, replacement parts will be shipped via ground shipping. Increased costs for expedited delivery, if requested by the Customer, will be the responsibility of Customer. Parts replaced under the terms of this Warranty will be warranted for the remainder of the original warranty period.
LABOR CHARGES AND/OR DAMAGE INCURRED DURING

INSTALLATION, REPAIR, OR REPLACEMENT, AS WELL AS ANY OTHER KIND OF ANCILLARY COST, LOSS OR DAMAGE ARE EXCLUDED. Please allow up to 1-3 business days for processing of warranty issued parts. Once warranty replacement parts are shipped, warranty is activated and product cannot be returned for refund thereafter.

SHOWER & TUB DOORS, SHOWER ENCLOSURES GLASS, MEDICINE CABINETS

Future Glass shower doors, tub doors, shower enclosures and medicine cabinets are backed by a Limited Lifetime Warranty. Future Glass warrants the glass of shower doors, tub doors, shower enclosures and medicine cabinets to be free from defects in workmanship and materials under normal residential use for a period commencing from the initial date of purchase by the owner/ end-user, contractor or builder from an authorized Future Glass dealer for the life of the product as long as the original consumer purchaser owns the home in which the product is installed. Warranty for plastic seal strips, sweeps or any other vinyl components shall be limited to one (1) year. Future Glass does not warrant glass for scratches, chips, water spots, breaking or any other damage after installation.

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This warranty excludes all industrial, commercial and business usage. The warranty period for products installed for commercial applications or used in commercial ventures, including but not limited to motels, hotels, casinos, student housing, condos, apartments, and fitness centers, is a one (1) year limited warranty from the date of purchase for shower doors, bathtub doors, shower enclosures and a three (3) month limited warranty from the date of purchase for mirrors, with all other terms of this warranty applying except the duration of the warranty.
