


- I. The 2 support rails (#5) are already attached behind the dresser (#1). Position the support rails (#5) vertically to align with the predrilled holes of the dresser (#1) and the mirror (#4).
- II. Prepare 6 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#C) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order. The other 2 bolt assemblies are already attached to the support rails (#4) from the factory.
- III. Insert the bolt assemblies through the support rails (#5) and secure those bolts using an Allen wrench (#D) to lock with the dresser (#1) and the mirror (#4). Tighten all bolts, including those that were already attached from the factory.
- IV. If needed, adjust the leveler according to the ground level. To lower or to raise the support leg, turn the leveler clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.
