



Installation Instructions - Metal Wall Shelf




You have selected a great metal wall shelf!

A. Packing Includes: a) Metal Wall Shelf b) Brackets c) Screws, and d) Plastic Anchors






(Bracket Size – 3” x 5”)












(Screw Size-9 mm head

(4.8 mm)






(Anchor size- 13 mm

B. Preparation for Installation :

- Arrange following items (not supplied)

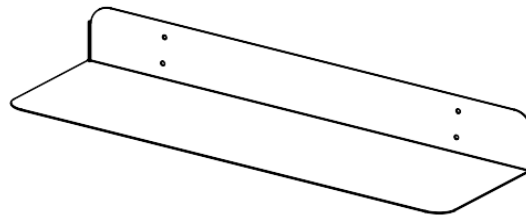
- C. Two persons would be needed for the installation.
- D. Take due care while unpacking and installing the wall shelf, especially around the edges.
- E. Do not install above cribs, beds, changing table, or walking area. Safer to install over the head height.
- F. Decide whether brackets are required (based on the weight of the wall usage) and, if needed, how the brackets should be placed, consider the following criteria whether/how to use brackets:

Potential Usage of Wall Shelf	How to use brackets	Weight Limit		Placing on the wall
		Shelf Size – 24”	Shelf Size – 36”	
Light weight use for placing home décor items (books, photo frames, small pots, vases, candle holder etc.)	Brackets are not needed.	26 lbs/12 kgs	40 lbs/18 kgs	
Medium weight use like in garage (small tool sets, bigger pots, etc.)	Brackets are needed–Long side on bracket on wall.	48 lbs/22 kgs	65 lbs/30 kgs	
Heavy weight use like in putting machinery parts, bulky kitchen items etc.	Brackets are needed–Small side of bracket on wall.	57 lbs/26 kgs	70 lbs/32 kgs	

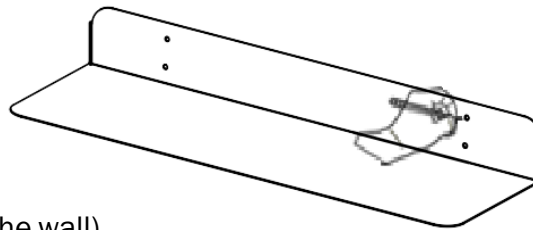
G. Screw holes in bracket –There are four screw holes in bracket. Only two holes in bracket are used for placing screws. Other two holes in bracket are extra and not used.

H. How to Install Wall Shelf :

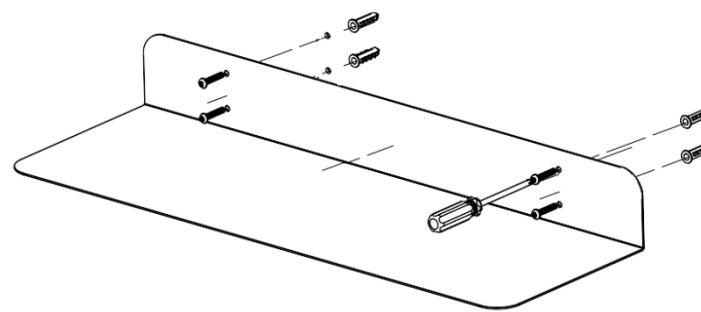
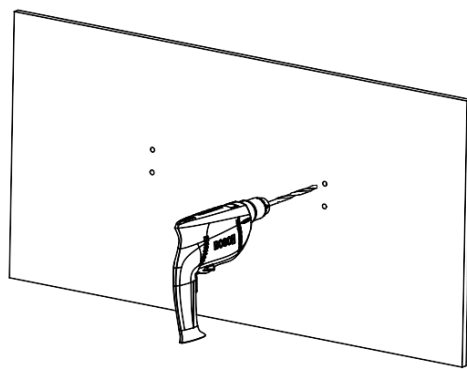
1. One person can hold wall shelf and place at desired location on wall.



2. Using pencil, second person can mark screw hole locations on the wall.



3. Keep wall shelf on side (after marking location of screws on the wall).



➤ **Wooden wall**

- In case of wooden wall, advisable to install on stud (on wooden frame). Stud finder (not supplied) can be used to find stud locations. Use the Internet search and follow how to use stud finder.
- Using drill bit size 5/32" (4 mm), make screw pivot holes in the wooden wall.
- One person can hold wall-shelf aligning with screw holes.
- Other person can insert screw and tight with Phillips screwdriver. Do not overtight as the color from screw top head might peel off.

➤ **Masonry Wall**

- In case of masonry wall, using a drill bit size 21/64" (8.5 mm), make screw pivot holes in the wall.
- Using hammer, push plastic anchor in the wall.
- One person can hold wall-shelf aligning with screw holes.
- Other person can insert screw and tight with Phillips screwdriver. Do not overtight as the color from screw head might peel off.

I. Care Instructions :

- Clean with a slightly damp, soft cloth. Watch for edge of the wall-shelf while cleaning.
- Do not use any abrasive cleaner.

J. Precautions :

- Do not install above cribs, beds, changing table, or walking area. Safer to install over the head height.
- Be careful about edge of the wall-shelf.
