
## The tools might be applied to the following places:



#### Step 1 Faucet installation



- 1. Unscrew the pre-assembled washers & lock nut and screw.
- 2. Screw rubber washer, metal washer onto the pipe under sink and screw with lock nut and screw.




- 3.Connect the flexible hoses to water supply valve (not included) and copper tubes, and tighten it with adjustable wrench. DON'T OVER TIGHTEN!
- Caution: make sure connect the hot and cold flexible hose to supply valves correctly.



Warning: The supply valves are not included, please purchase them in plumbshop.

### Step 2 Checking and testing



- 1.Turn the faucet handle all the way on, turn on hot and cold water supply and flush water lines for one minute.
- 2. Check all connections at arrows for leaks, re-tighten it if necessary.


## Step 3 Cleaning and care

Daily cleaning and care are required in order to keep the product shining and properly working.


- 1 Clean it with water and dry it with soft cloth.
