
1 Take out the drawer from the Top (A).




2 Attach the Leg (B) to the Top (A) using Bolt (E), Spring Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) with Allen Wrench (I). Do not fully tighten the bolts in this step.



3 Attach the Shelf (C) to the Leg (B) by Connecting Metal (D) using Bolt (F), Spring Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) with Allen Wrench (I). Fully tighten the bolts in this step.




4 Put the drawer into the Top (A).




## Cleaning & Care






1 Take out the drawers from the Top (A).




2 Remove the Leg box from the bottom of the Shelf (C) and take out the Leg (B).




3 Attach the Leg (B) to the Top (A) using Bolt (E), Spring Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) with Allen Wrench (I). Do not fully tighten the bolts in this step.



4 Attach the Shelf (C) to the Leg (B) by Connecting Metal (D) using Bolt (F), Spring Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) with Allen Wrench (I). Fully tighten the bolts in this step.



5 Put the drawers into the Top (A).
