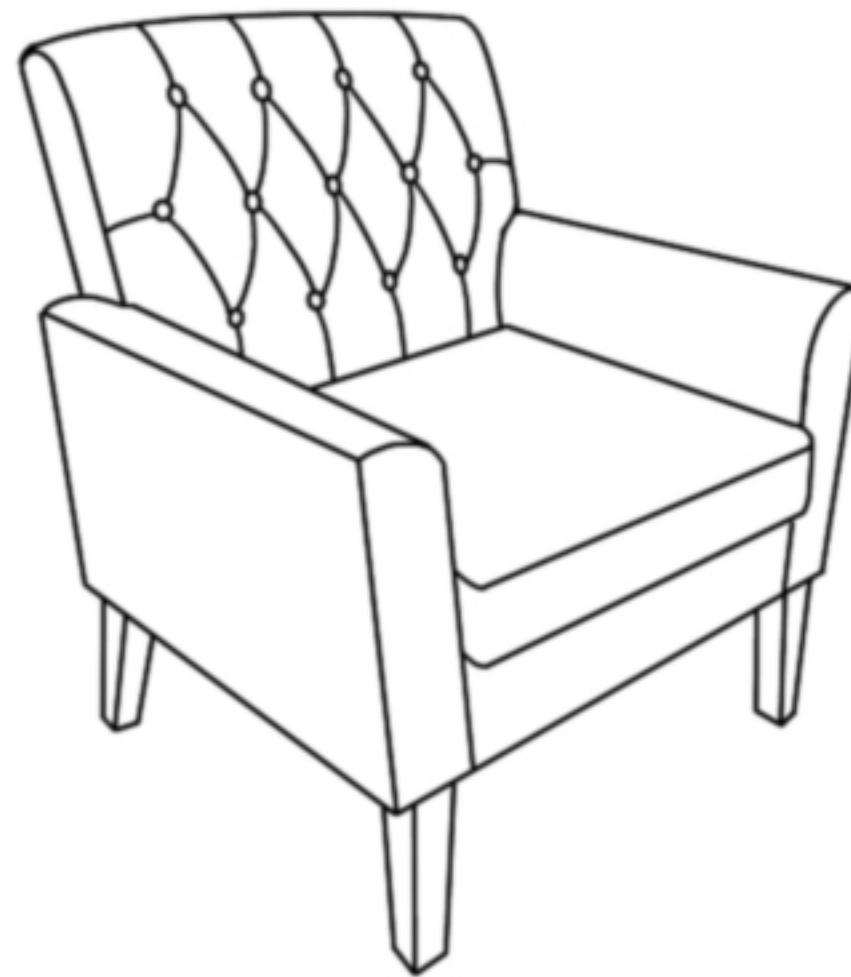

## Guide of Manual

- Instruction should be read carefully. It is very important to ensure each step followed in correct order and avoid any unnecessary troubles.
- Please check to make sure all parts are included as stated in the user manual when you unpack the product.
- The manual may not cover every detail of all possible situations and assembly steps. Please contact us if further information and help are needed.

## Warning

- It's kindly advised to assemble this product on a carpeted floor to protect it from being scratched.
- Small parts are included. Please keep the product away from children while assembling. Do not let children play or jump on the product. Do not stand on the item or use as a step.
- Please pay attention to the sharp corners during assembly. We recommend the use of gloves to prevent the undesired injury.
- Prior to use, please check to see if there's any loosening screw or part. Make sure that each screw and part is correctly installed and securely fastened.
- It's unnecessary to use any electric drill. Please at a low gear if you need.

## Care and Maintenance

- Use a soft, clean cloth that will not scratch the surface when dusting.
- There's no need to use furniture polish. If you need, test it first in an inconspicuous area.
- Using solvents of any kind on your furniture may damage the finish.
- Never use water to clean your furniture as it may cause damage to the finish.
- Liquid spills should be removed immediately. Gently blot the spill with a soft clean cloth to avoid rubbing.















## Further advice about the furniture care

- Extreme temperatures and humidity changes can cause fading, warping, shrinking and spitting of wood.
- we recommend to keep furniture from sunlight exposure to avoid possible surface damage.
- Proper maintenance and cleaning at home will extend the life of your purchase.
- Following these important and helpful tips will help retain your furniture's performance even when it ages.
- Periodically (every 90 days) make sure the screws are fully tightened.

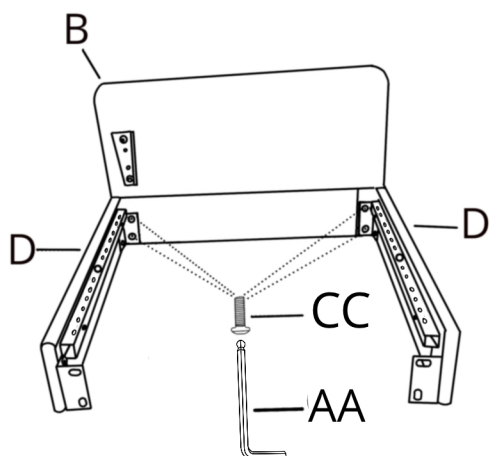


# Parts List & Assembly Instruction

2. Do not fully tighten all bolts until them haven been installed in corresponding locations.
3. "+" in below list indicates that additional pieces are replacement parts.

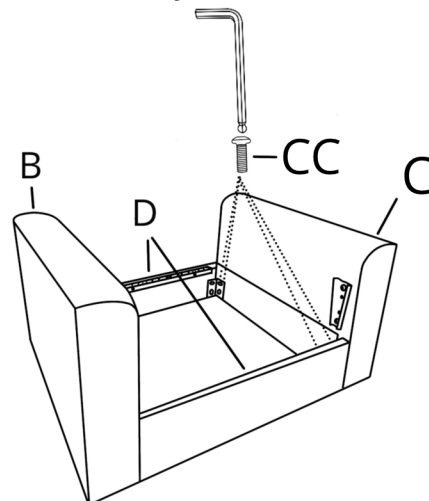

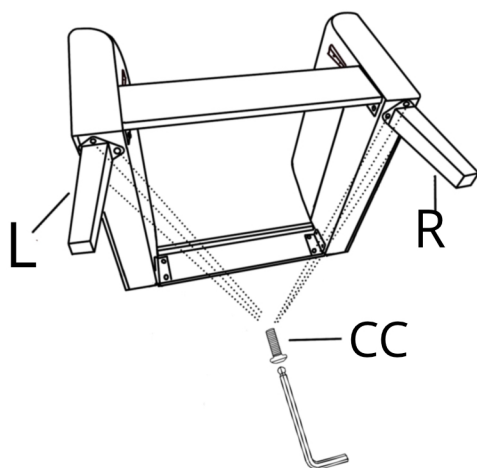
Fix the Left Armrest with Side Rails

### Step 2



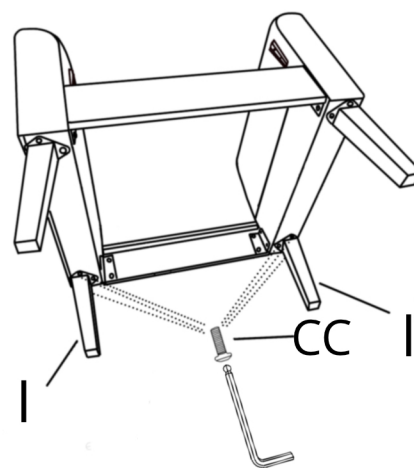
Fix the Right Armrest

### Step 3



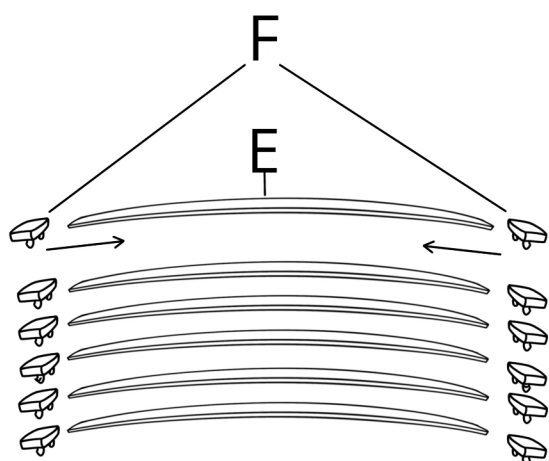
Fix the Back Feet (distinguish between left and right feet)

### Step 4



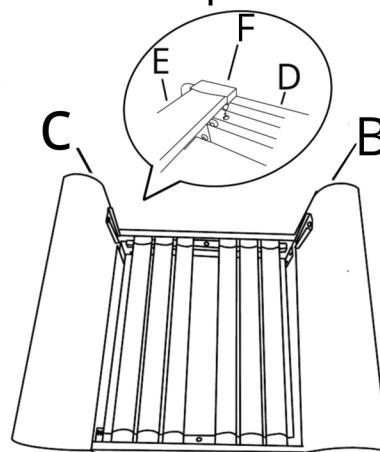
Fix the two same Front Feet

### Step 5



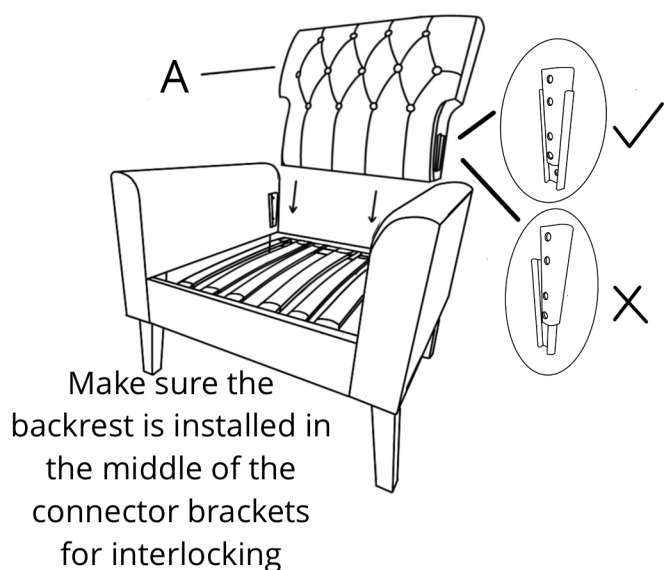
Make sure the convex surface like the bridge is upward and put on the caps

### Step 6

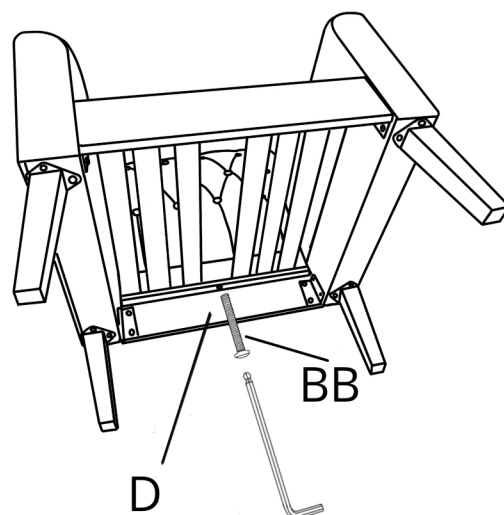


Press the cap to lock the slate in the hole (convex surface is still upward)

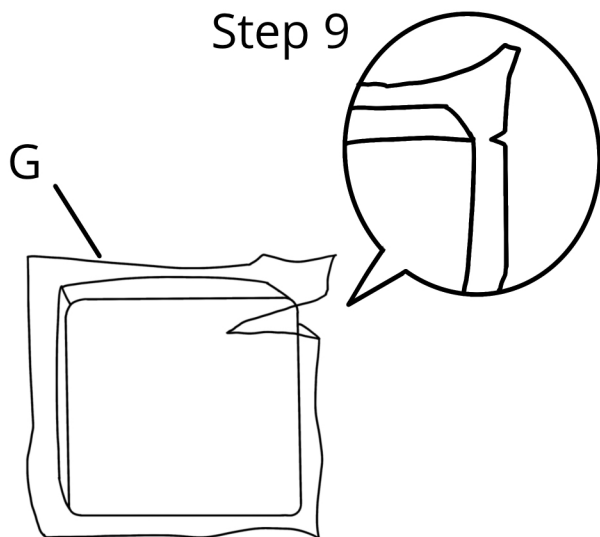

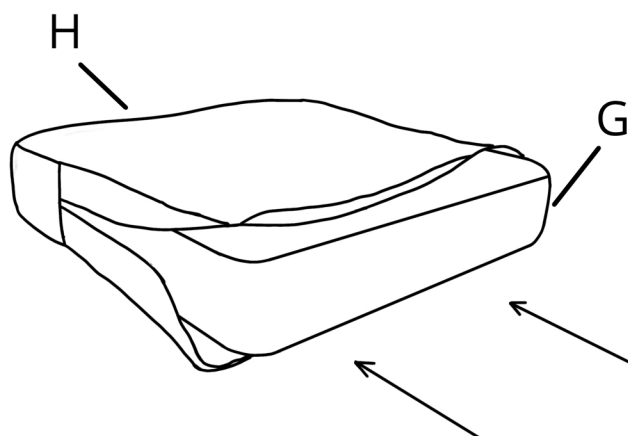

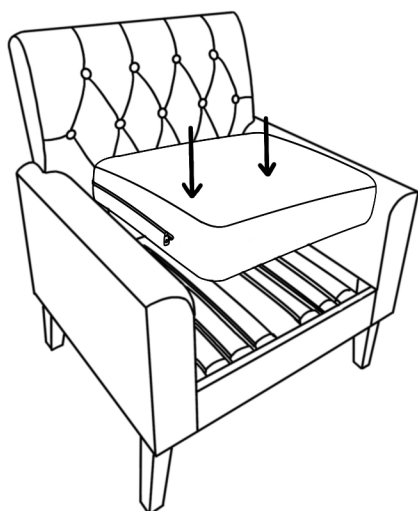
Split the compressed package and take out the cushion

### Step 10

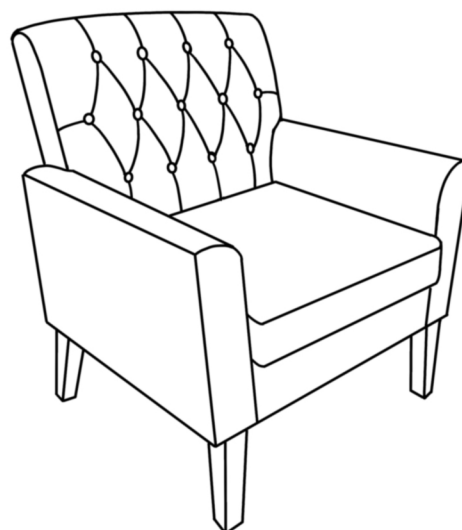


Insert the cushion into the cover and zip up it
