



### **Proper Use**





#### **WARNING!**

#### Important!

This piece of furniture must be fastened to the wall with the enclosed wall fitting.

#### Please note:

Some wall materials require different types fixing parts, only use fixing parts suitable for the chosen walls in your home (not included). If you are uncertain about what wall fitting is required for your home, please contact your local hardware store for assistance.

Please keep small parts out of reach of children.

Always use on a level, even surface.

It is recommended that two people handle and assemble the item.

DO NOT leave spilled liquid in the cabinet

DO NOT make temporary repairs

**DO NOT** use outdoor

**DO NOT** use this item if any parts are missing, damaged or worn.

**DO NOT** use this item unless all fixings are secured.

DO NOT push the item as this will damage the base.

**DO NOT** place the item next to a radiator or direct sunlight—this item is susceptible to temperature change. It is recommended an even room temperature be maintained with no sudden fluctuations.
