
# Assembly Steps

## Overview



This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

## Step 1




Open the carton and place all the parts onto a clean, non-marring surface.

**Please ensure the two "F" labels are facing the same direction.**

Attach the Front Leg (D) and Back Leg (C) to the Seat Panel (B) using Bolts (②), Washers (④) and the Allen Wrench (①) as shown in the picture above.


Do not fully tighten the bolts at this time.

## Step 2




Then attach the Front Leg (D) and Back Leg (C) together using Bolts (③), Washers (④) and the Allen **Wrench** (①) as shown in the picture above.  
Do not fully tighten the bolts at this time.

## Step 3



Now tighten all Bolts in a sequential manner.  
Then add the Nut Caps (⑤) onto the 4 Bolts as shown in the picture above.


## Step 4



Attach the Top Panel (A) to the Seat Panel (B) using Bolts (③), Washers (④) and the **Allen Wrench** (①) as shown in the picture above.

Do not fully tighten the bolts at this time.


## Step 5



Now tighten all Bolts in a sequential manner.


Then add the Nut Caps( ⑤ ) onto the 3 Bolts as shown in the picture above.

## Step 6



Place the Cushion (E) onto the Basket Seat.

## Step 7



Adjust Pre-installed  
Levellers height for  
balance












Place the Chair on a LEVEL SURFACE to check for wobbles.

If it wobbles, adjust the Legs' Pre-installed Levellers until the Chair is level with the ground.

Your Chair is ready for use.

**This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.**

## **Care & Maintenance**

- ⊘  • Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  • Keep away from sources of ignition.
- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
