Care & Maintenance







 Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



• Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



• Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



 Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



• Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



 Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.




• Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.

Please look in seat for hardware packs and legs.





Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-




Save all packaging until finished-

Assembly Steps




This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Take out the Wooden Legs(B) and Gaskets(1) from the Leg Pouch.

Step 2



Install the Wooden Leg(B) at the bottom of the Chair by placing one Gasket(1) on the threaded stem.

Then insert threaded stem into the mounting postion at the corner of the Chair.


Tighten by turning the Wooden Leg clockwise by hand.

Tighten until firm and secure.

Repeat the same process to install the remaining three Wooden Legs(B).


Note: The use of Gaskets(1) are OPTIONAL and are especially useful to help alleviate slight wobbles. Some Legs may need more than one Gasket whilst some Legs may not need any.

Step 3



With help of an adult partner, stand the Chair up.

Step 4



Position the Chair on a level surface and test for stability.

If the Chair is not Stable identify the Leg and Add/Remove a Gasket as needed.

Your Chair is ready for use.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.
