IMPORTANT SAFETY CONSTRUCTION

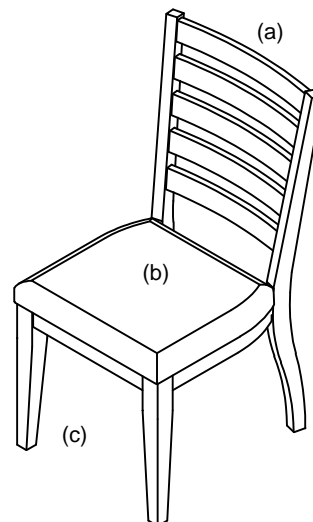
Thank you for purchasing this quality product. Be sure to check all packing material carefully for small parts that may have come loose inside the carton during shipment. Please read all instruction carefully before assembling. For your safety, assembly by two people is recommended.

- (1) Chair Back (a)
- (1) Complete Seat (b)
- (2) Front Legs (c)

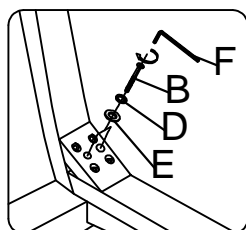

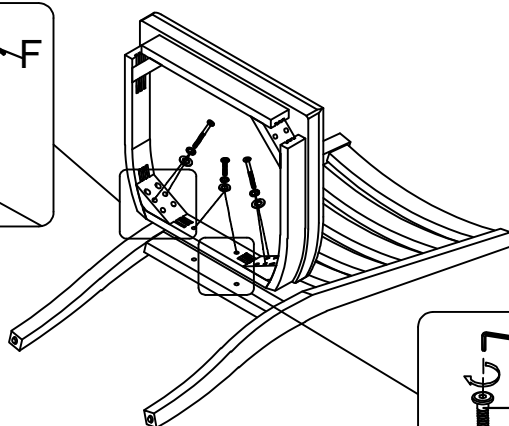
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:

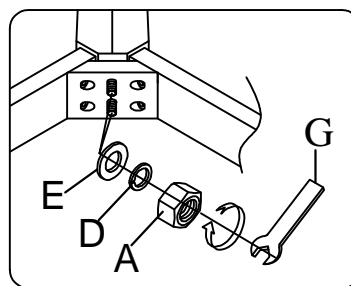
- Carefully lay Chair Back flat on a smooth flat surface to prevent scratches.
- Affix Complete Seat to Chair Back by inserting a Flat Washer (E), Lock Washer (D) with Short Bolt (C) into holes at the back rail of the seat, and Long Bolt (B) into holes at the Complete Seat corners. (See Detail A & B).
- Tighten screws with provided Allen Key (F) by turning clockwise until secure



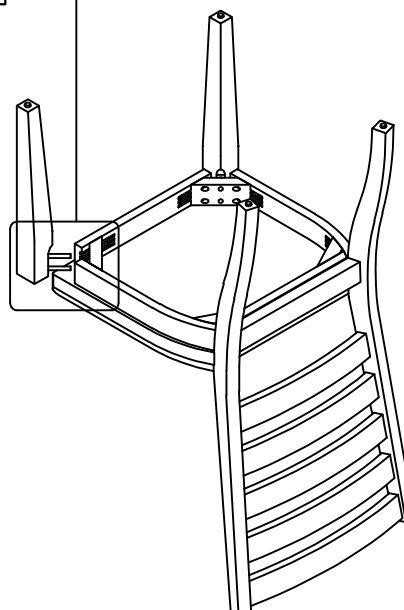

STEP 2:

- Carefully turn chair upside down and affix each Leg to the front corners of the Complete Seat. Place Flat Washer (E), Lock Washer (D) and Nut (A) on each leg bolt, tightening the Nut using provided Key Wrench. (See Detail C)
- Be sure to level the chair prior to tightening all the nuts/screws

NOTES:

The use of power tools for assembly is not recommended. Power tools can damage hardware or split wood.
