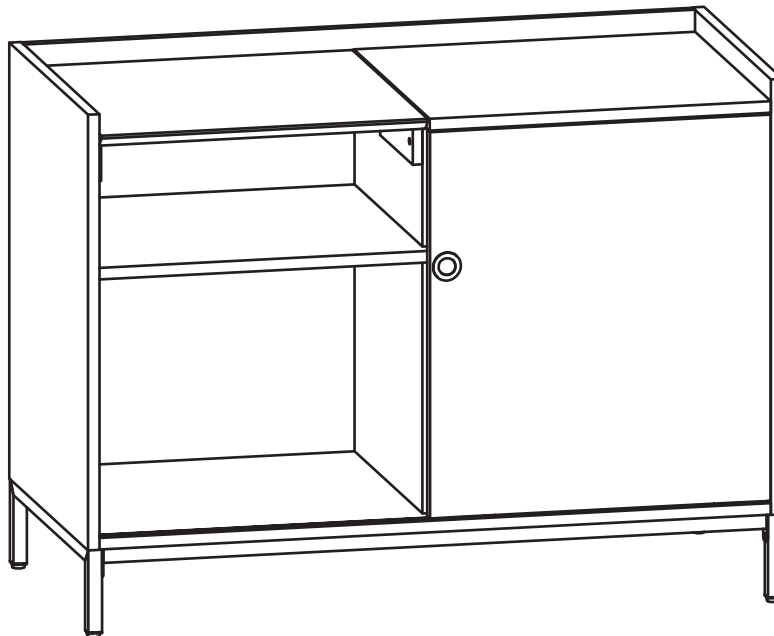


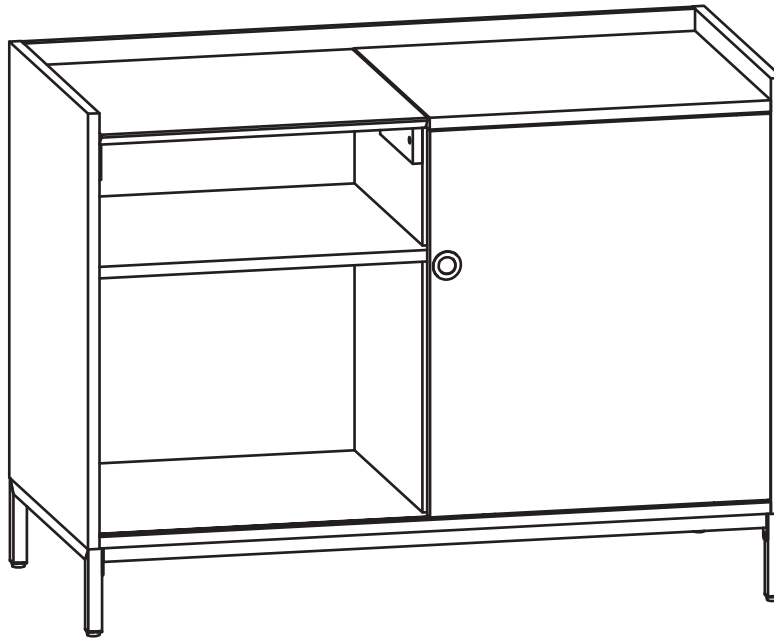

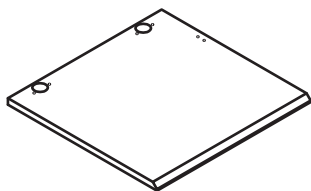


1. Do not use this product unless all screws and bolts are securely tightened.

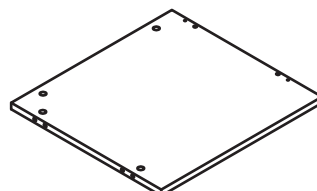
#### **LIMITED WARRANTY**

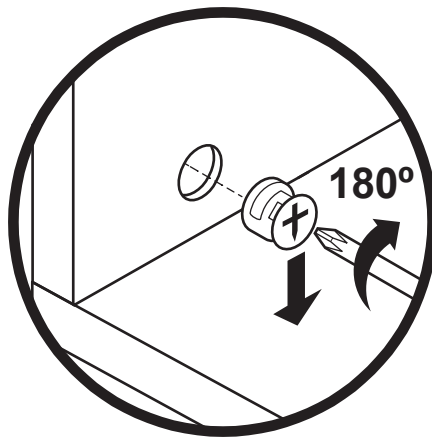
## CAM LOCK INSTALLATION

Do not overtighten, and do not leave a gap.

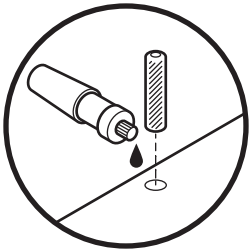


Align hole in panel with Cam Bolt and attach.



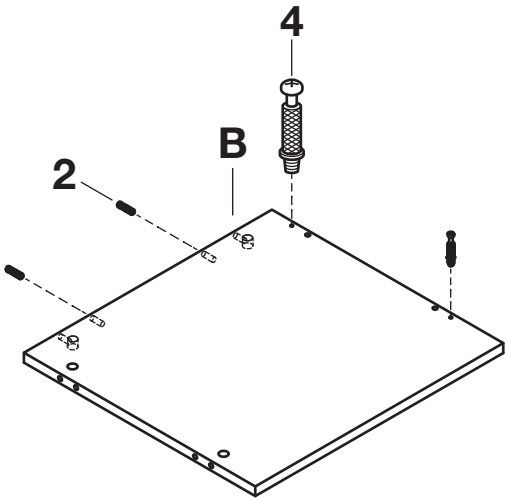
Insert Cam Lock into hole (arrow faces Bolt). Turn clockwise until you

## STEP 17



1. Check to make sure that the latch slider switch on pre-assembled Latches (ZB) are located in the **DOWN** and **UNLOCKED** position.
2. Place the pre-assembled Rollers (ZA), which are attached to the **BOTTOM** of Door (L) assembly, down in the groove on Bottom Panel (D).
3. Align the Latches (ZB), which are attached to the **TOP** of Door (L) assembly, and then push the latch slider switch up until it reaches the upmost **LOCKED** position.
4. Check the travel of Door (L) assembly, making sure it slides freely.
5. If the Door (L) assembly doesn't slide smoothly, please adjust the height of the Rollers (ZA) by loosening the screw in the center of Rollers (ZA) and turn Rollers (ZA) clockwise slightly and tighten screws again.

## STEP 18

### ANTI-TIP KIT INSTRUCTIONS

Place unit in desired location. Carefully drill a 1/4" pilot hole into wall, and gently tap Wall Anchor into pilot hole. Secure Bracket to wall using Long Screw. Fully tighten Long screw. Secure second Bracket to unit using Short Screw. Fully tighten Short Screw. Loop Safety Strap through both Brackets and fasten.
