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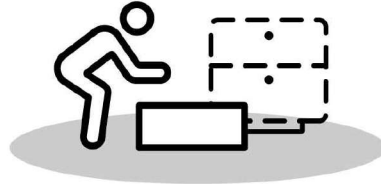
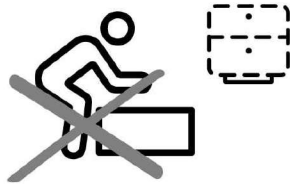
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Suitable Location

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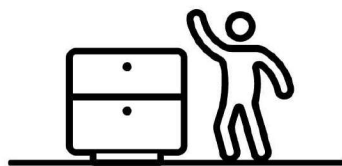
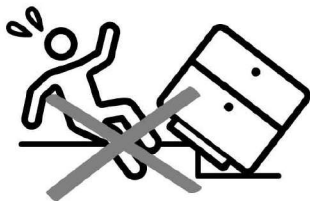
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

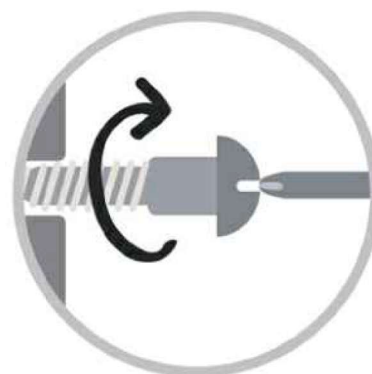

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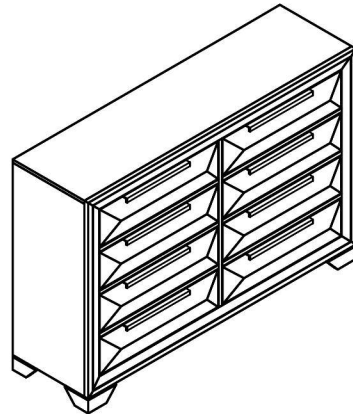
After two weeks, check and

Hardware © x 1pc

Place the Dresser into position so both mounting brackets are vertically in line. Insert Strap (C) through the L Bracket (D) at back of the Dresser (1) and Wall. Secure the strap laced and locked.



ASSEMBLY COMPLETED



Please ensure the furniture rests on an even and flat surface. If the product wobbles or feels loose, double-check all bolts and/or screws are properly tightened and secured.



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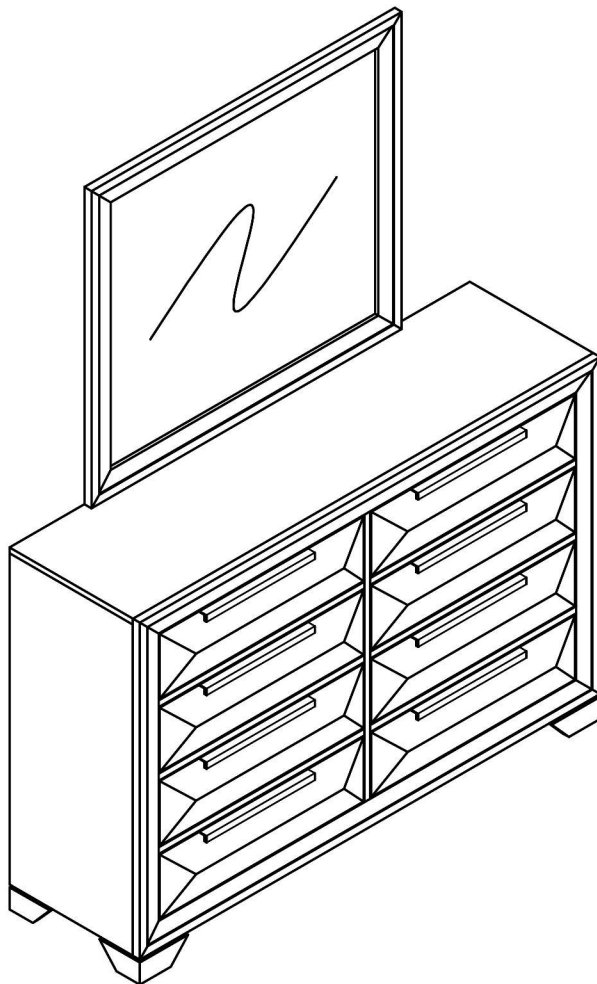


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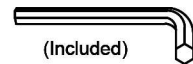
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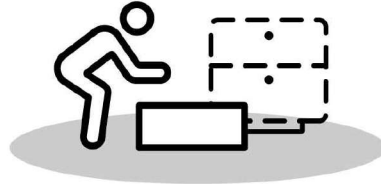
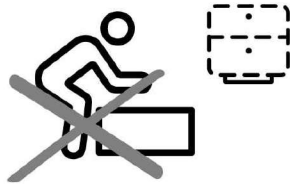
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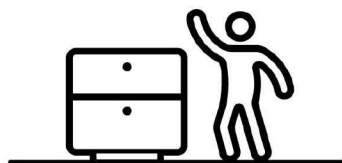
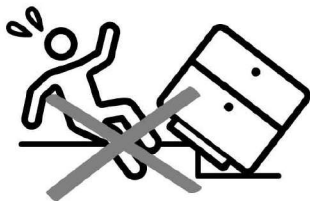
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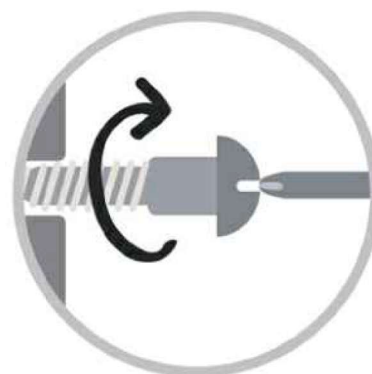
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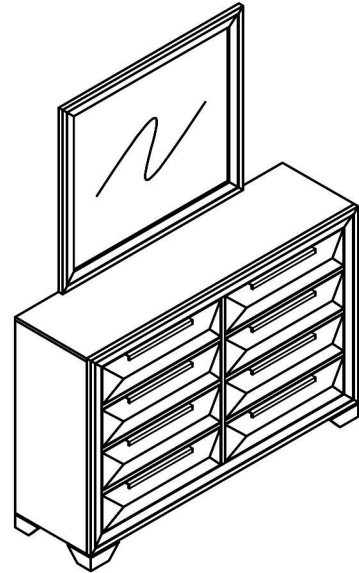

Align the top holes along the mirror support rail (3) to the holes along the back sides of the mirror (1), then insert bolts (A), lock washer (C) & flat washer (B) into each hole. Secure using allen wrench (D).

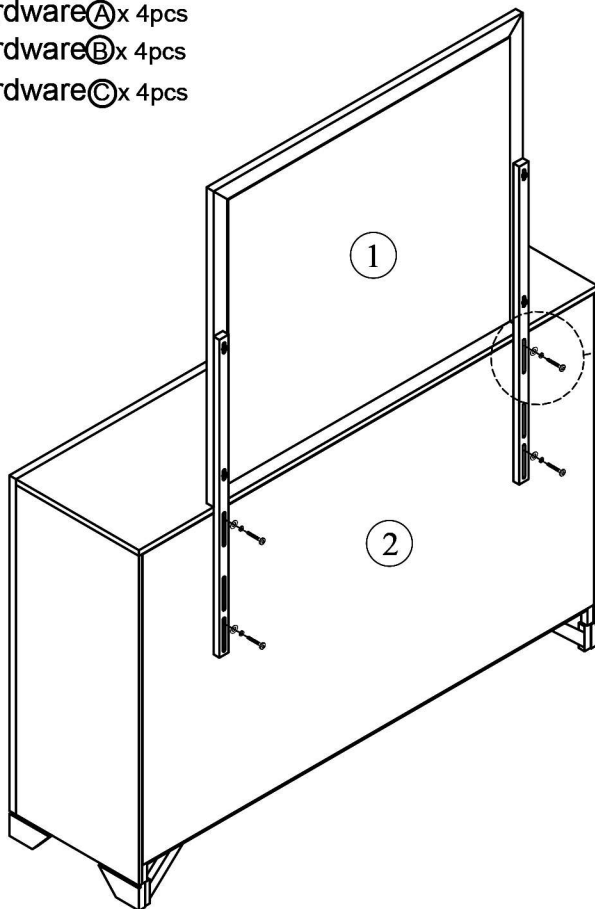
