ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Prepare 6 bolts assembly by inserting lock washer (B), then flat washer (C) onto bolts (A).
Align HB legs (3R/L) to the holes of the headboard (1). Secure by using bolts (A).

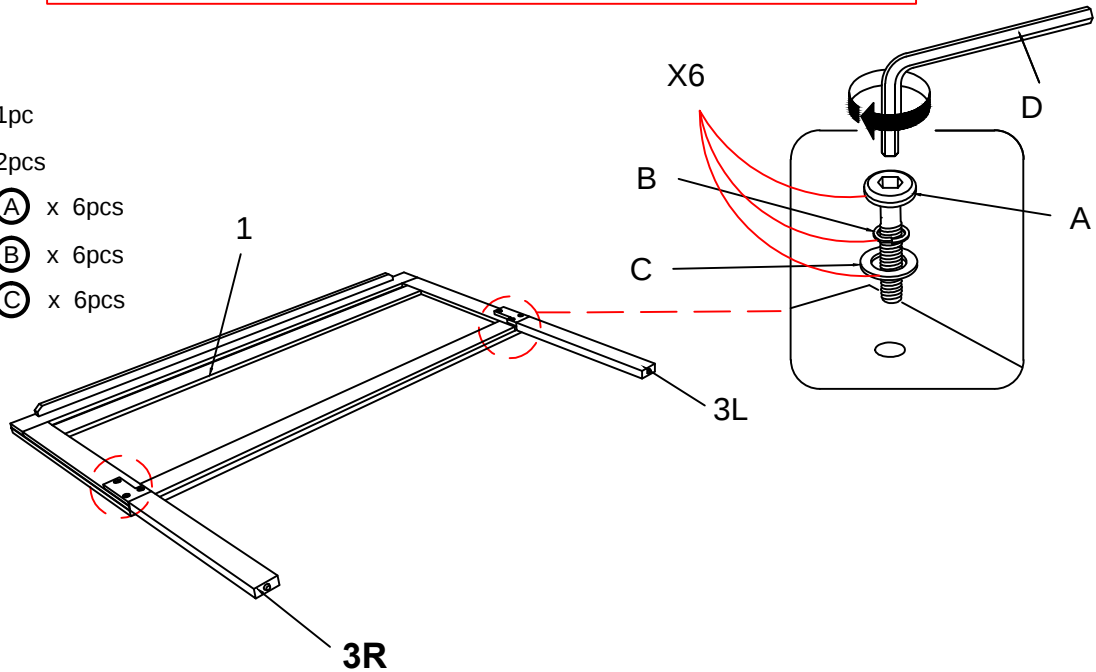

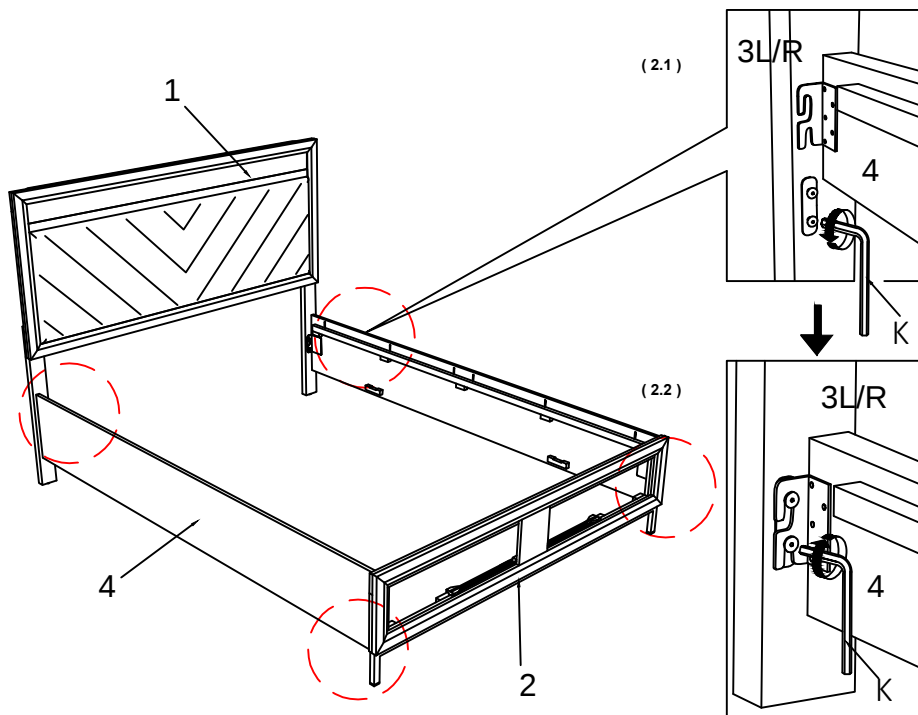

1) Loosen the bolts attached to headboard (1) and footboard (2), then hook the side rails (4) to the loosed bolts on the headboard (1) and footboard (2).
2) Tighten the bolts on the headboard (1) and footboard (2) to the side rail hooks (4).

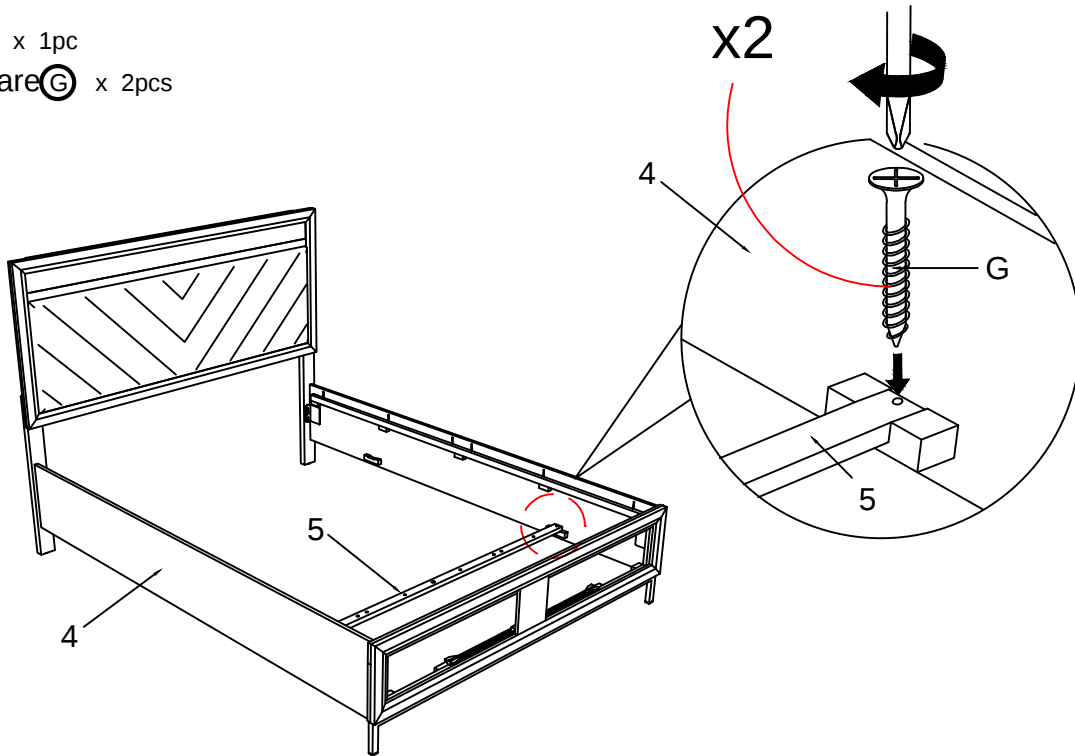

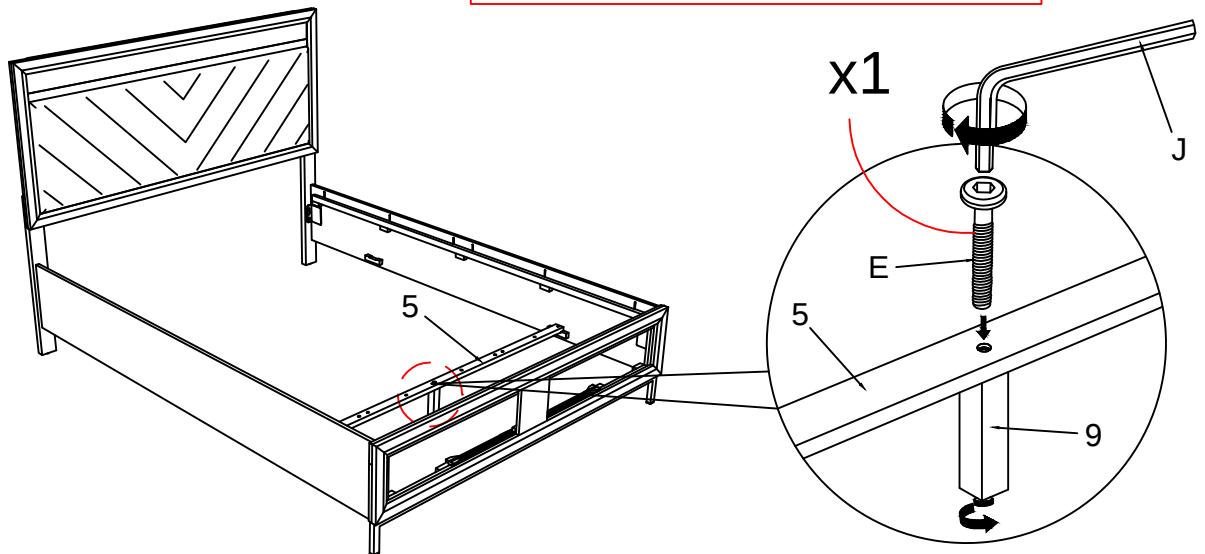
Align T-Runner Center Support (5) to the side rails (4), then secure by using screws (G).

Align slat support (8) to the hole of the bed slat with marking (7). Secure by using bolts (E).

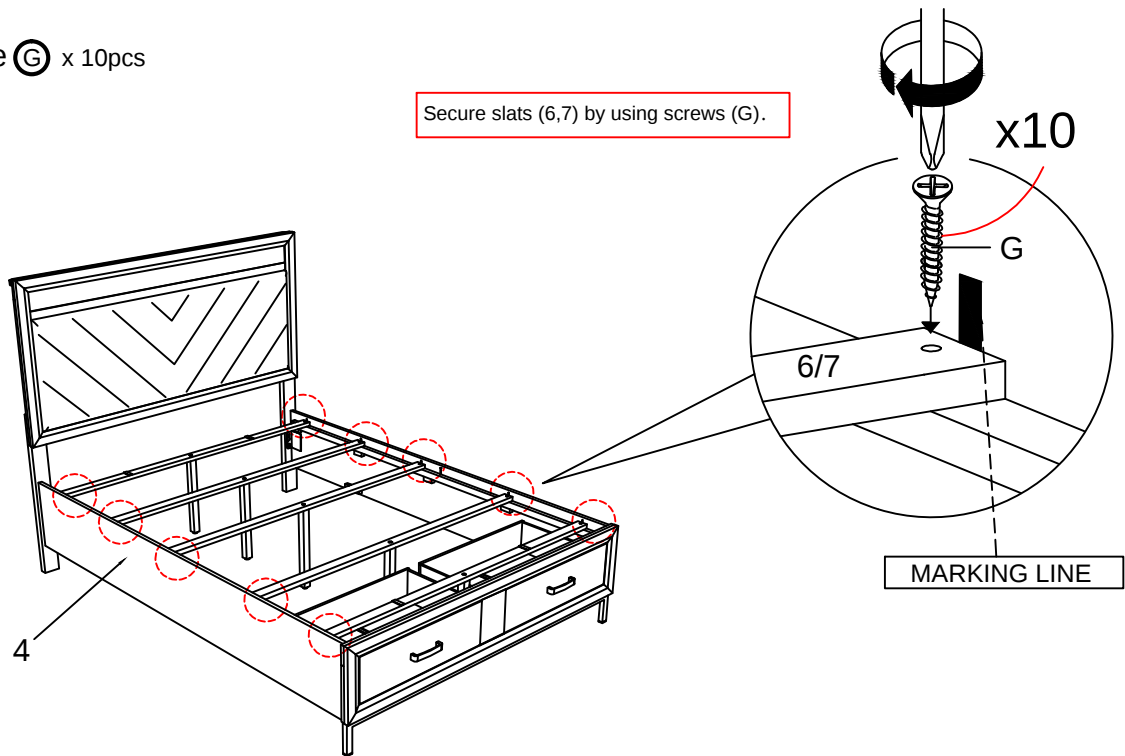


Align slats (6, 7) to the side rails (4) by follow the Marking Line provided .

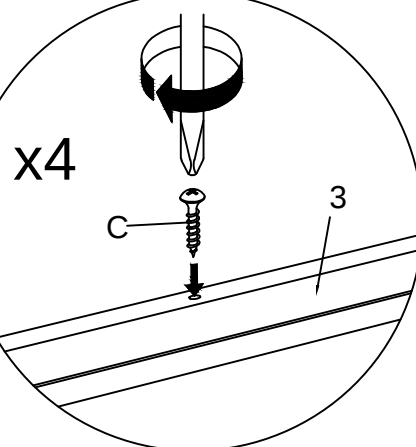
Secure frame leg(3) by using screws (C).

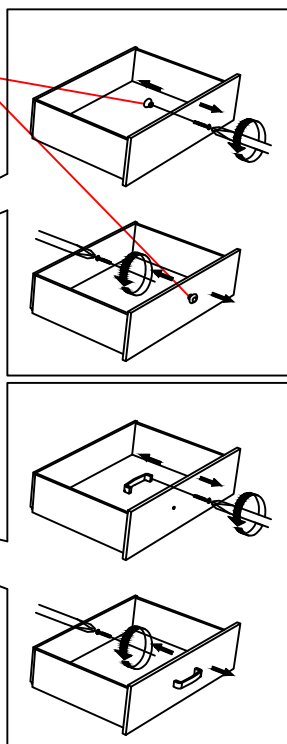
