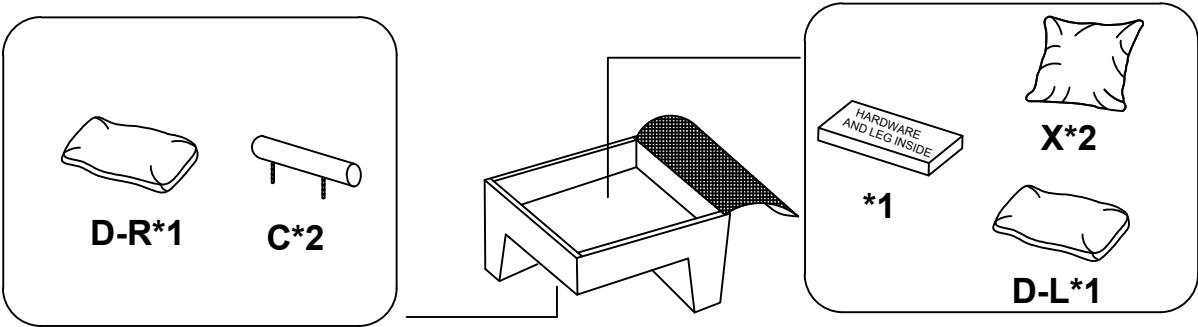
Corner Seat

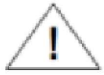
In order to maintain the original appearance of your corduroy furniture, please follow below care procedures:
