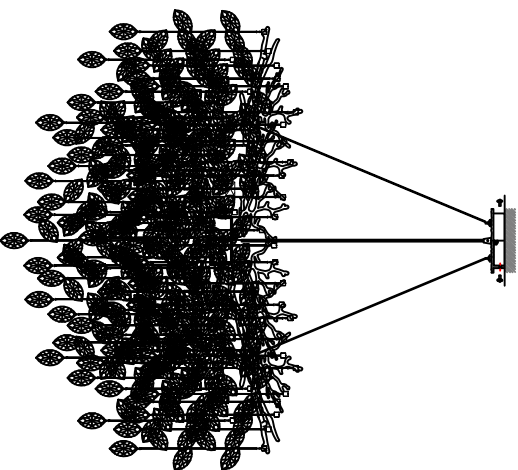
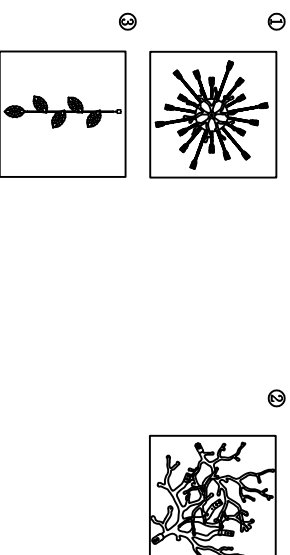
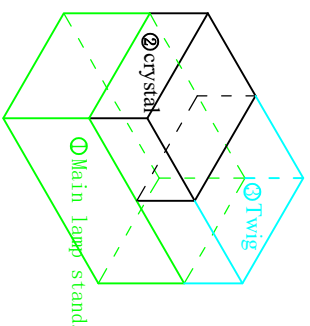

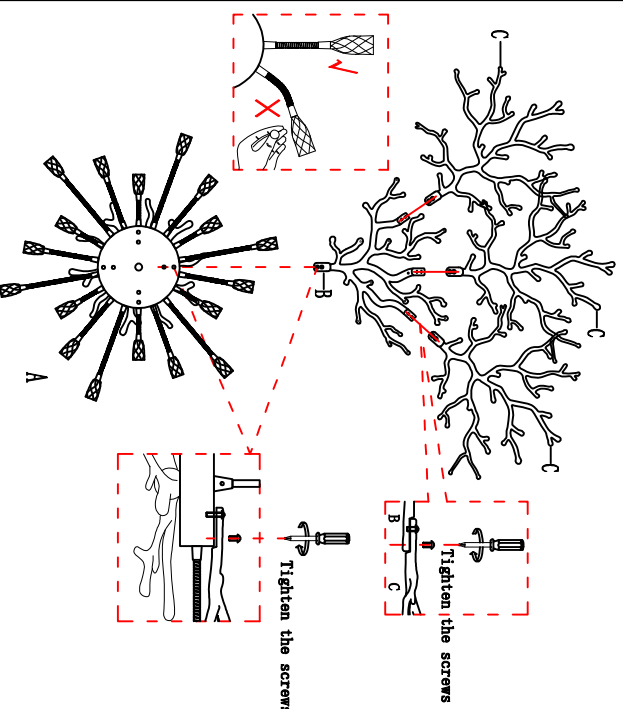

① Lamp body assembly:

- (1). Find Lamp Body A from the sorting list.
- (2). Assemble Lamp Body A with branches (B, C) according to the diagram, aligning the holes and tightening the screws (as shown in the figure).
- (3). Straighten the lamp head hose.

Chandelier Installation and Safety Standards

② Complete lamp assembly:

- (1). Remove the mounting plate and connect it to the wall,
 - (2). Connect the main power line to the main line of the lamp body, and secure the ceiling plate tightly.
 - (3). Hold down the tension head to adjust the lamp body height as needed according to the site conditions.
 - (4). Insert 18 G9 light bulbs into the lamp holders (not included with the product).
 - (5). Hang the crystals (a total of 126 strands, with 5 spare strands that do not need to be hung).
- Installation is complete.
