 Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



• Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



 Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



• Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



 Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



 Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

Please look in carton for hardware packs and legs. Sets often ship in multiple boxes and may arrive a day or two apart.



Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




• Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

Assembly Steps




This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble.

To give you an overview of the Chair, the above picture is to help you put the rious parts into perspective.


Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourselfwith the parts and steps bef ore assembly.

Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.





Position the Seat(D) on a clean, non-marring surface as shown. Carefully take out the Hardware from the bottom of the Seat(D).




With the assistance from your partner, lift the Seat (D) up, place it on top of Backrest(A). Attach Seat(D) to Backrest(A) using a Bolts(), Spring Washers(), and Washers() with the Allen Wrench () as pictured above.

Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

DO NOT fully tighten a Bolt in one go and then move on to the next.

Rather, In a sequential manner, gradually tighten each Bolt until all Bolts are evenly secured.





Turn the assembled Seat (D) and Backrest (A) over.

With the assistance from your partner, lift the Right Armrest (C) up, align the Connector on Right Armrest (C) with the Connector on Backrest (A).

Insert the Connectors to match together.


Attach the Right Armrest (C) to the assembled Seat (D) using Bolts(), Spring Washers(), and Washers() with Allen Wrench(as pictured above.

Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

DO NOT fully tighten a Bolt in one go and then move on to the next.

Rather, In a sequential manner, gradually tighten each Bolt until all Bolts are evenly secured.





Turn over the assembled Chair.

With the assistance from your partner, lift the Left Armrest (B) up, align the Connector on Left Armrest (B) with the Connector on Backrest (A).

Insert the Connectors to match together.

Attach the Left Armrest (B) to the assembled Seat (D) using Bolts(), Spring Washers(), and Washers() with Allen Wrench(as pictured above.

Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

DO NOT fully tighten a Bolt in one go and then move on to the next.

Rather, In a sequential manner, gradually tighten each Bolt until all Bolts are evenly secured.

Step 5 Test for stability

Your Chair is ready for use.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.
