Align the Headboard leg (#3) to the Headboard (#1) and secure by using Bolt (#B) with Lock washer(#C) and Flat washer (#D).

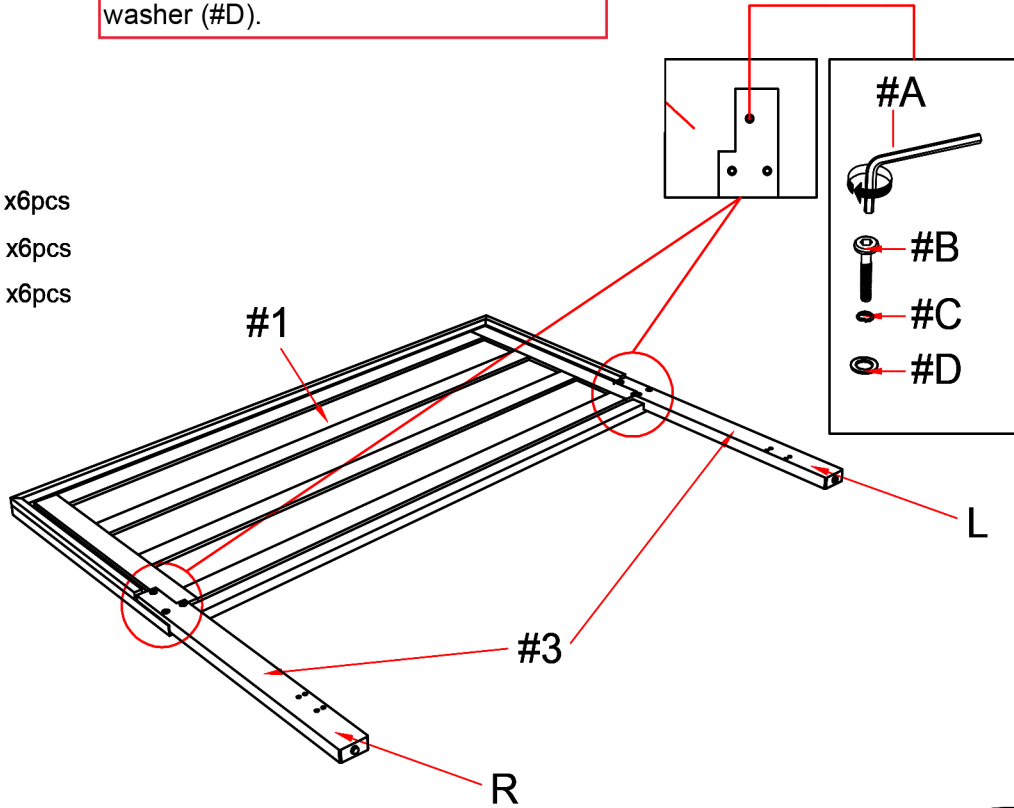

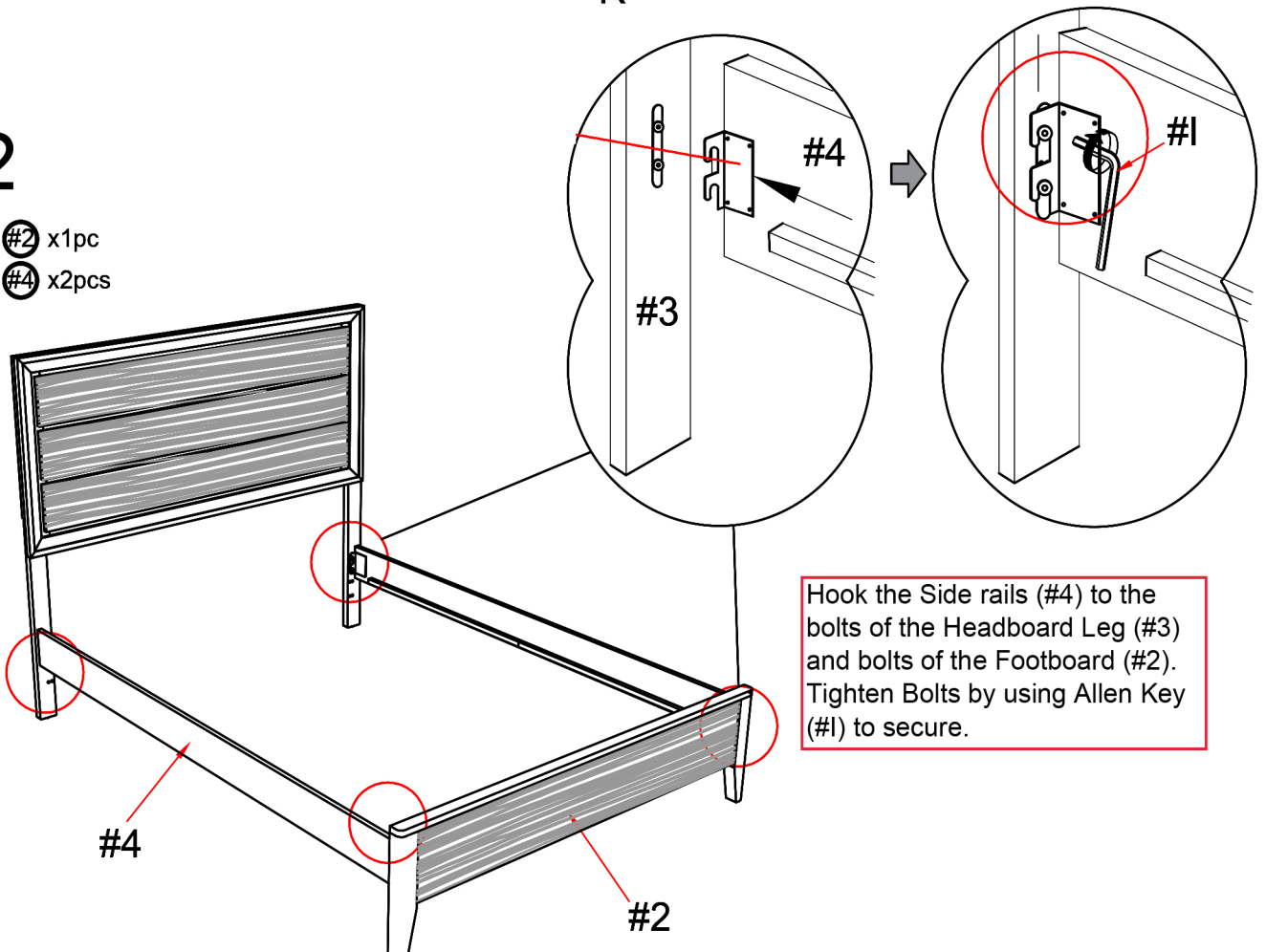

Hook the Side rails (#4) to the bolts of the Headboard Leg (#3) and bolts of the Footboard (#2). Tighten Bolts by using Allen Key (#1) to secure.

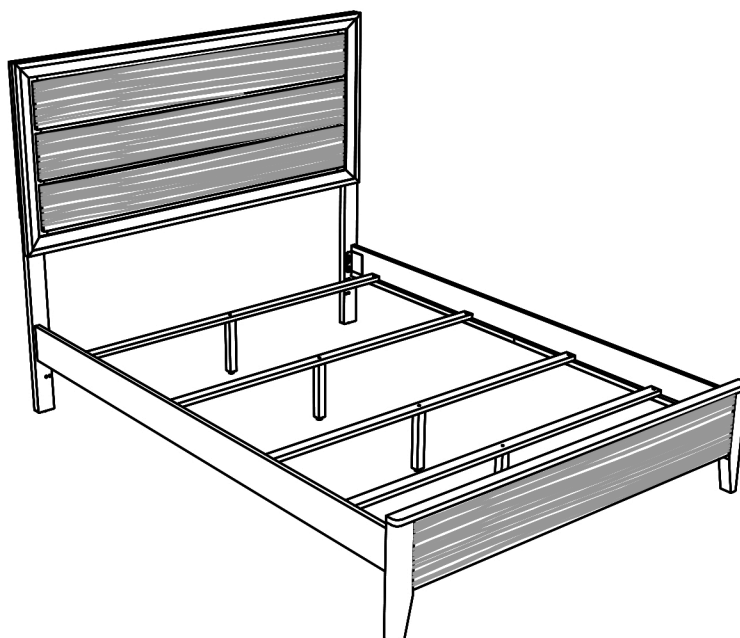
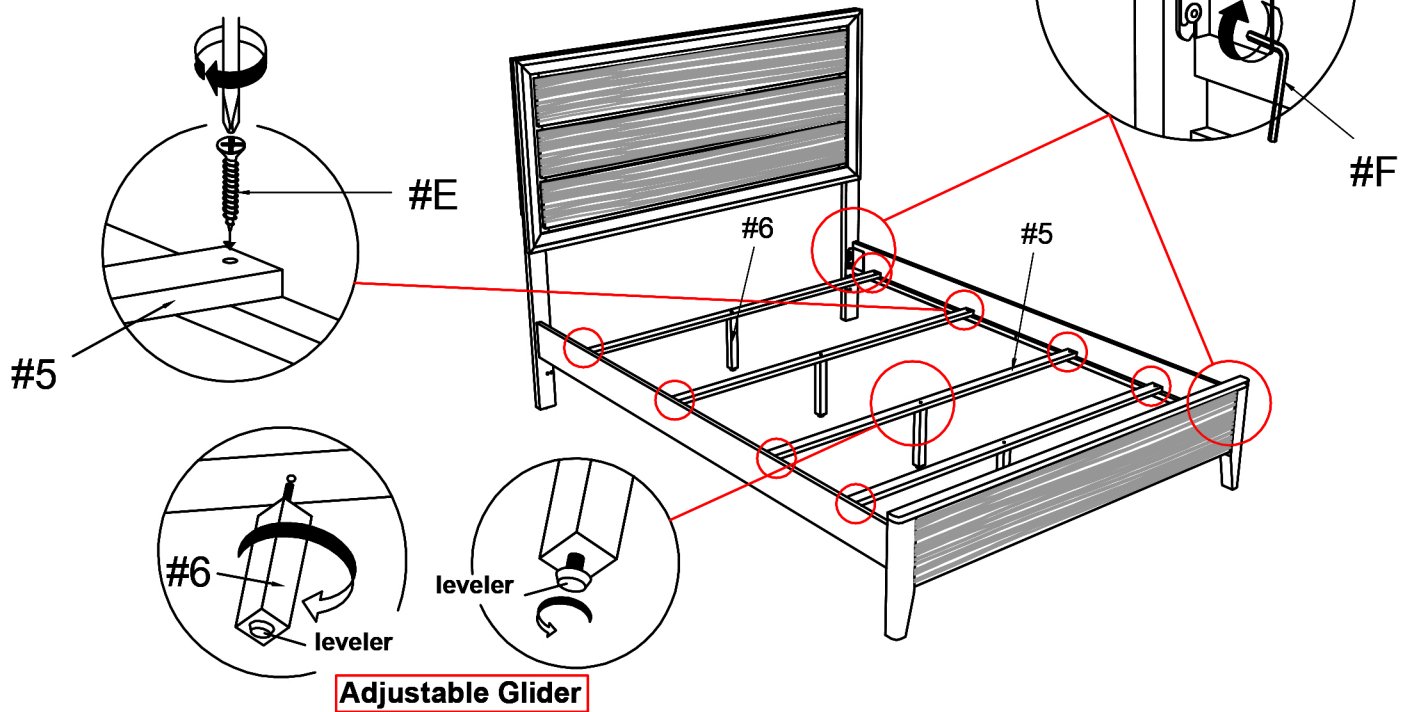
Align the Bed Slat (#5) to the Side rails (#4) and secure by using Screw (#E). Insert the bed slat support to the bed slats and adjust the bottom leveler to ensure it aligns with the floor. Secure side rail Bolts by using Allen Key (#F).

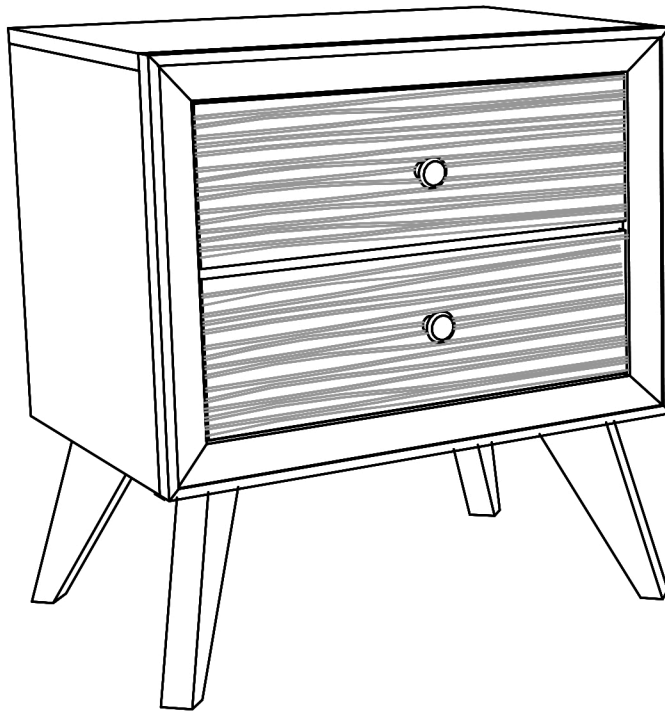
Remark : Turn the Night Stand to upside down position as shown.
