Attach RSF Headboard Leg (B) to Headboard Panel (C) using Bolt (E), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) with L-Allen Key (L). Turn Threaded Rod (F) into RSF Headboard Leg (B). Then attach RSF Headboard Leg (B) to Headboard Top Bar (D) using Threaded Rod (F), Hexagon Nut (J), Lock Washer (G), Flat Washer (H) and Half Moon Nut (I) with Wrench (K).

Attach LSF Headboard Leg (A) to Headboard Panel (C) using Bolt (E), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) with L-Allen Key (L). Turn Threaded Rod (F) into LSF Headboard Leg (A). Then attach LSF Headboard Leg (A) to Headboard Top Bar (D) using Threaded Rod (F), Hexagon Nut (J), Lock Washer (G), Flat Washer (H) and Half Moon Nut (I) with Wrench (K).



















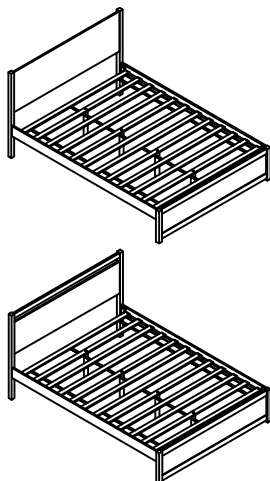
Cleaning & Care

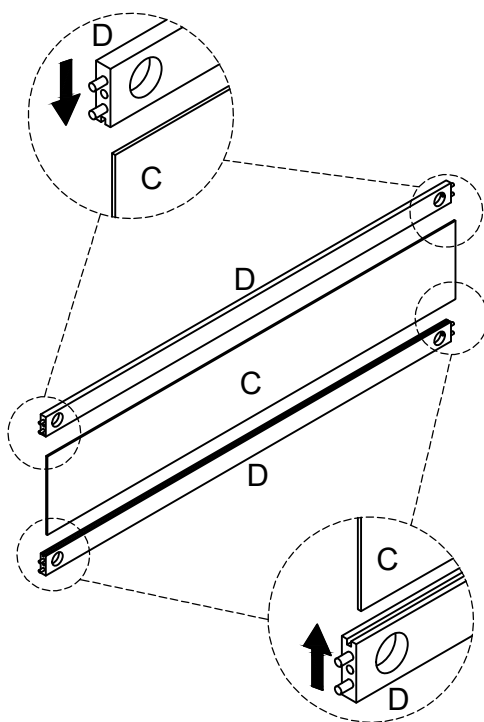

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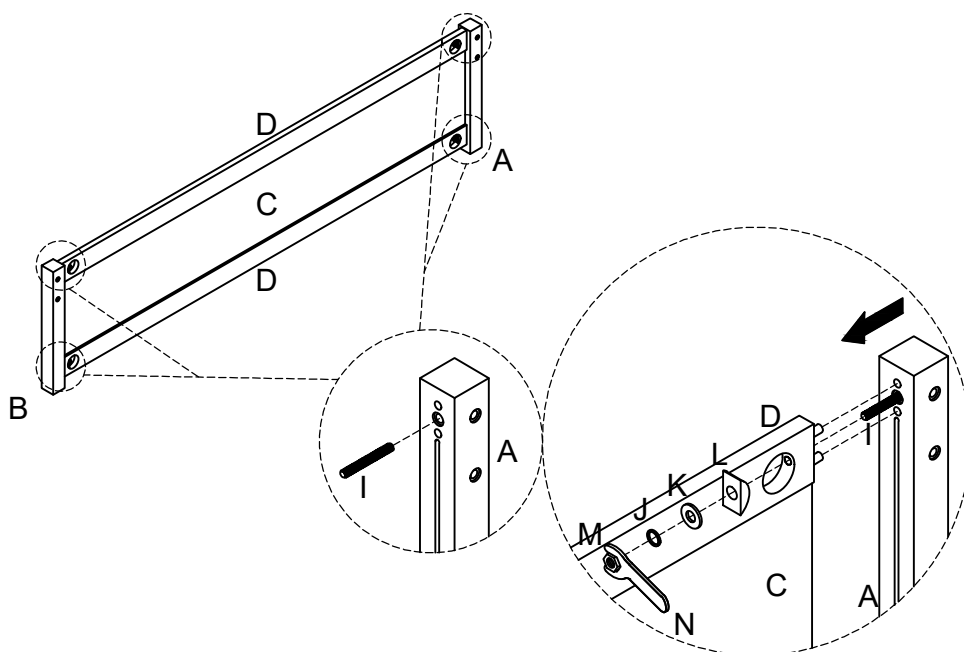

Attach Footboard Top and Bottom Frame (D) to Footboard Panel (C).



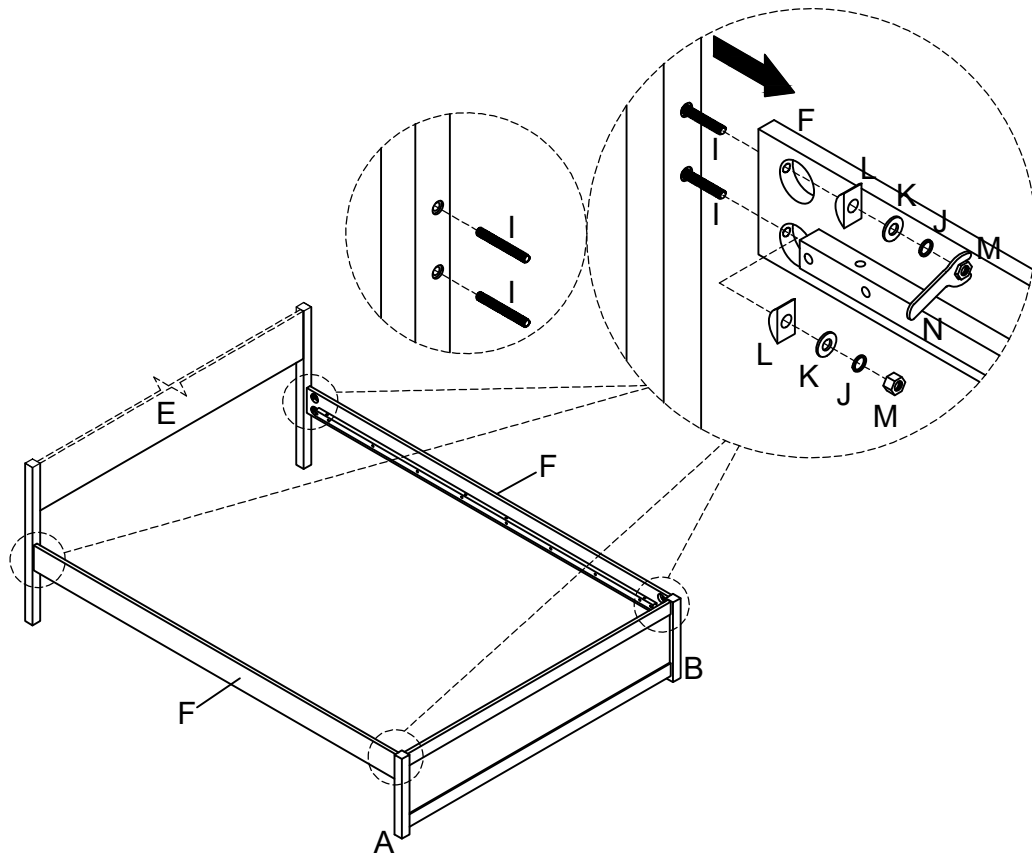

Turn Threaded Rod (I) into LSF & RSF Footboard Leg (A & B). Then attach LSF & RSF Footboard Leg (A & B) to Footboard Panel (C) and Footboard Top and Bottom Frame (D) using Threaded Rod (I), Hexagon Nut (M), Lock Washer (J), Flat Washer (K) and Half Moon Nut (L) with Wrench (N).



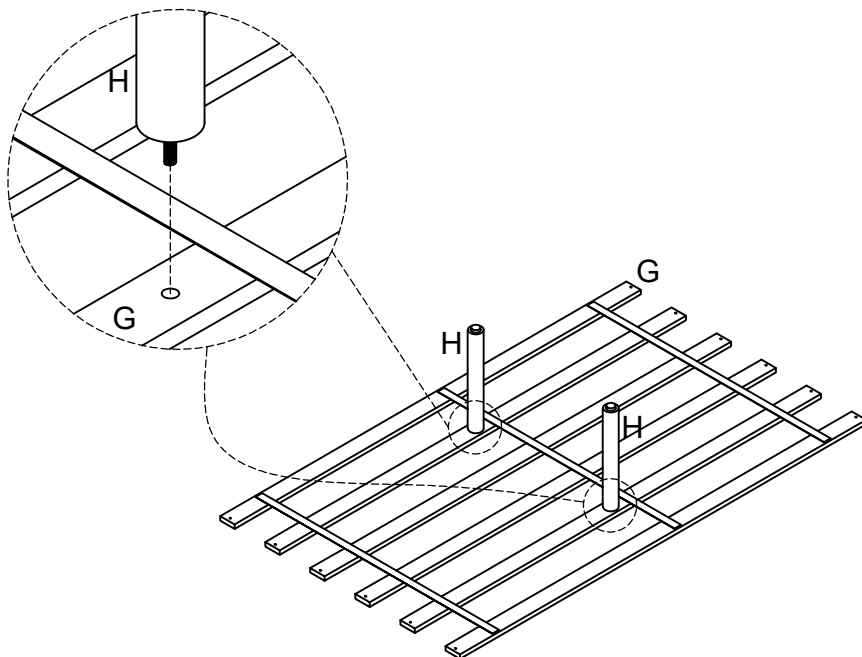

Turn Threaded Rod (I) into LSF & RSF Footboard Leg (A & B) and Headboard (E). Then attach LSF & RSF Footboard Leg (A & B) and Headboard (E) to Side Rail (F) using Threaded Rod (I), Hexagon Nut (M), Lock Washer (J), Flat Washer (K) and Half Moon Nut (L) with Wrench (N).



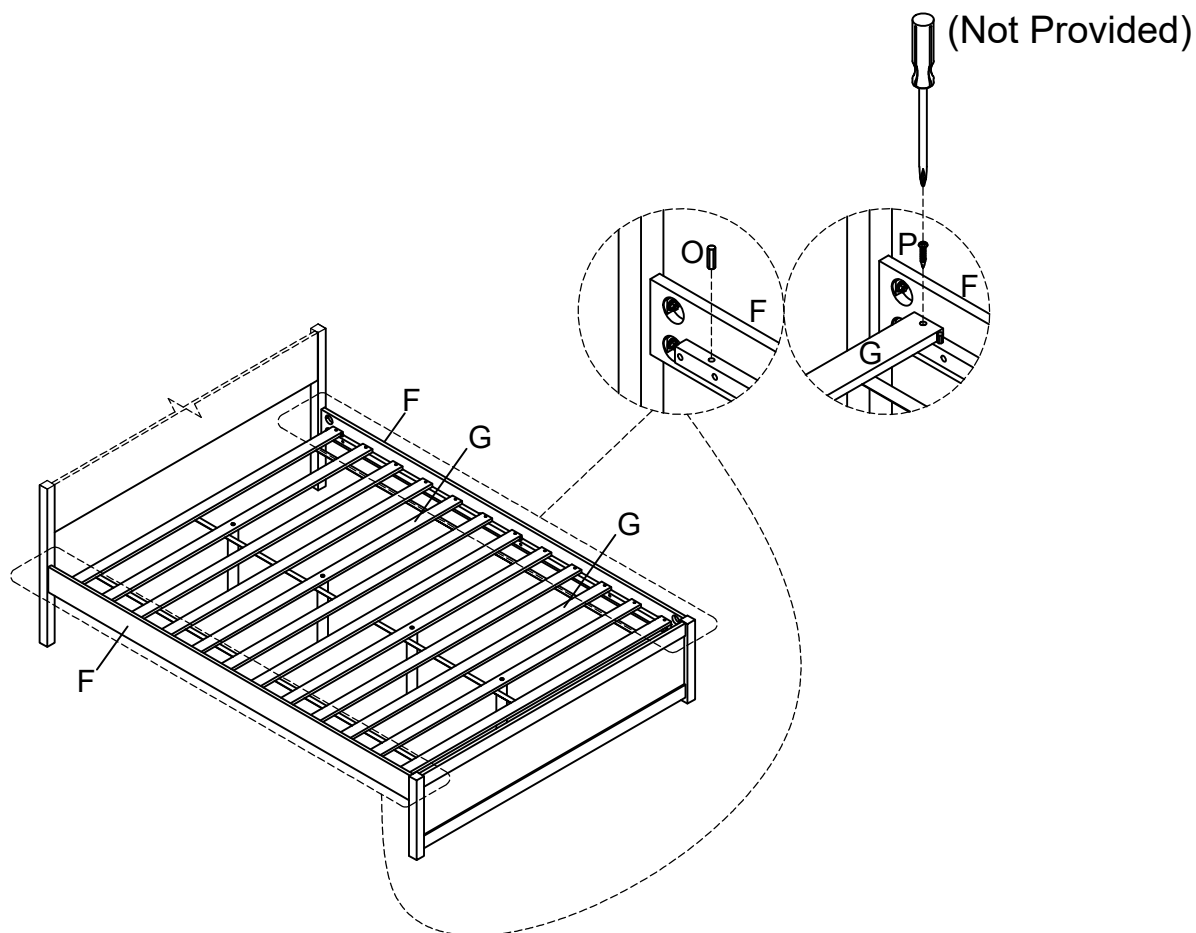

Turn Center Support Leg (H) into Slat (G).

Insert Wood Dowel (O) into Side Rail (F). Then attach Slat (G) to Side Rail (F) using Wood Screw (P) with Screwdriver (Not Provided).
