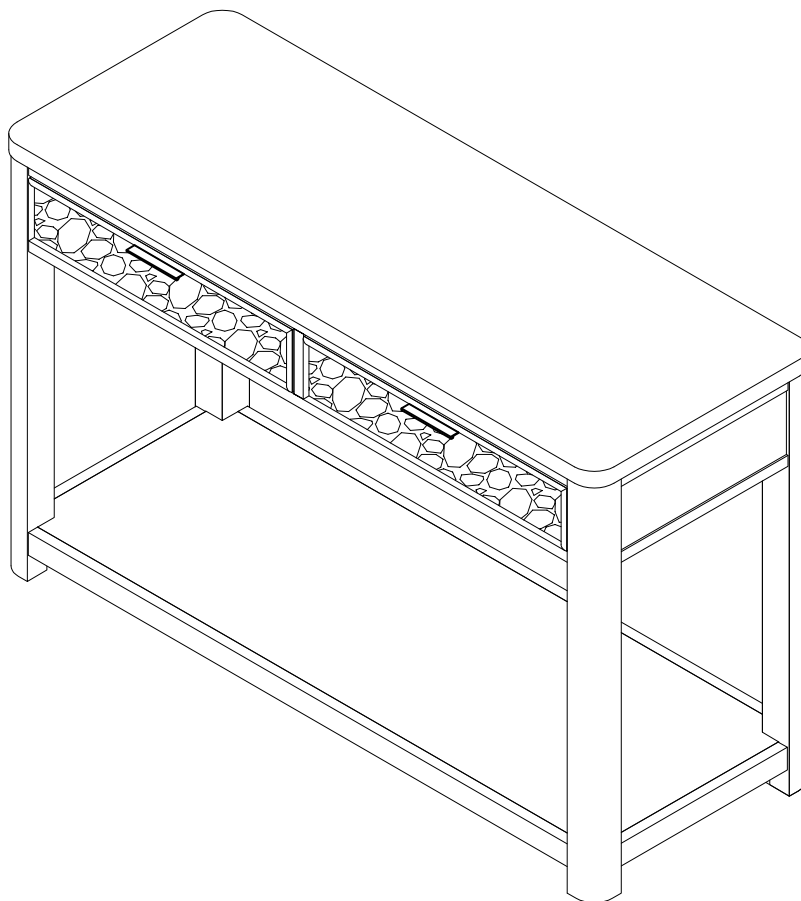


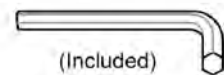

PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE



**FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW MAY

Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.



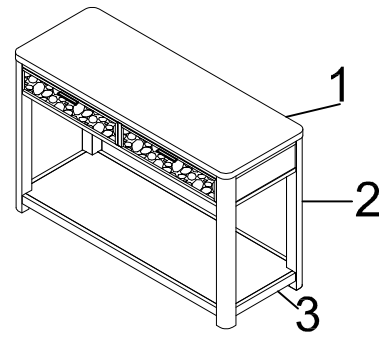
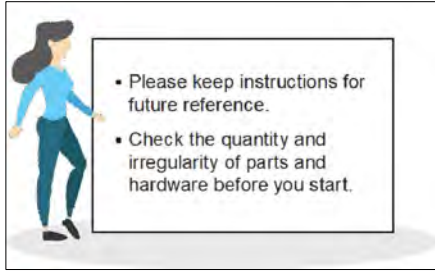
Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.



After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

- Part #1 x 1pc
- Part #2 x 3pcs
- Hardware #A x 1pc
- Hardware #B x 6pcs
- Hardware #D x 6pcs
- Hardware #E x 6pcs

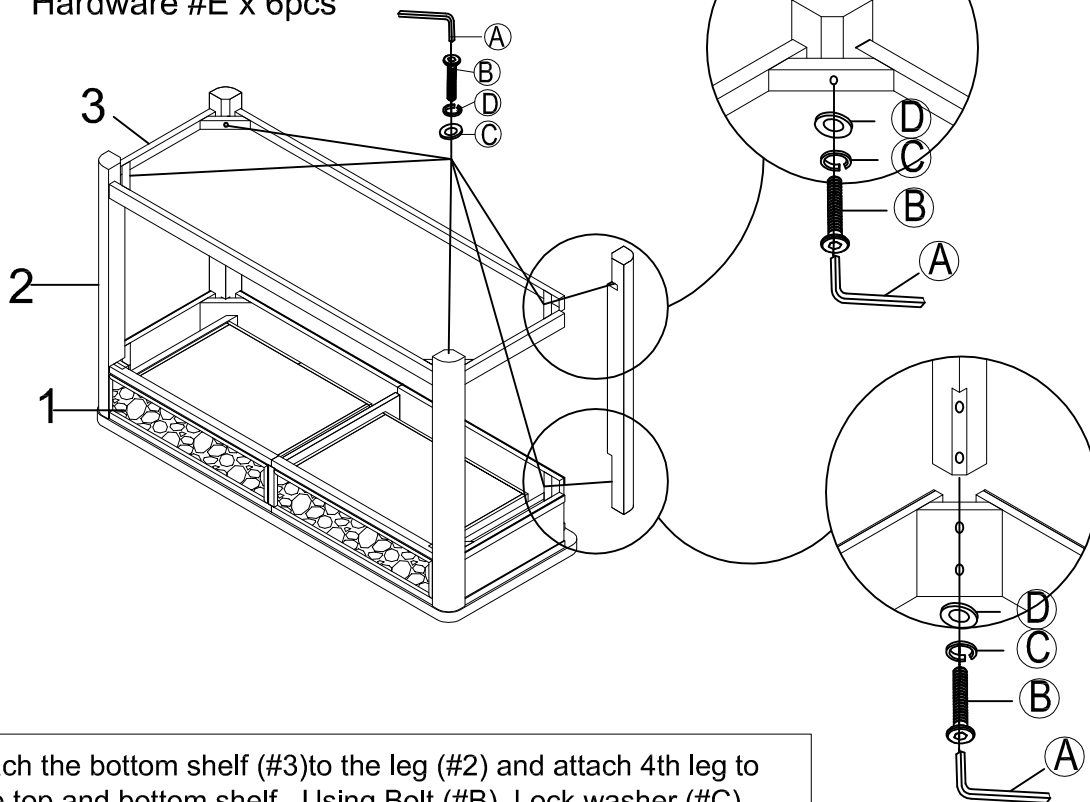
Remove drawer from case as shown

Attach the Legs(#2) to Table Top (#1). Secure by using Bolt (#B) with Lock Washer (#D) and Flat washer (#C) Allen wrench(#A).



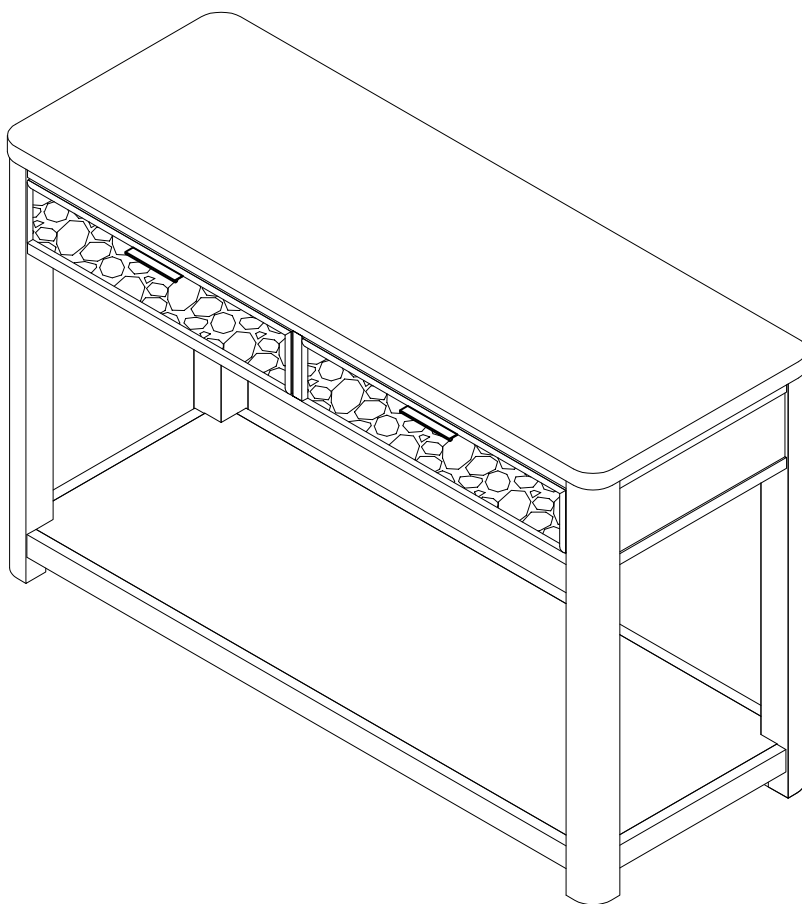

Attach the bottom shelf (#3) to the leg (#2) and attach 4th leg to table top and bottom shelf. Using Bolt (#B) Lock washer (#D), Flat washer (#C), and Allen Wrench (#A). Put the drawer on case.
