
This Cabinet has multiple parts and may require up to some 60 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Cabinet parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

<p><u>Step 1</u></p>	 <p style="text-align: right;">③ × 16</p>
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Attach the Leg(K) to Bottom Panel (B) with Bolt(③) using Allen Wrench(⑩).


<p><u>Step 2</u></p>	 <p style="text-align: right;">⑤ × 12</p>
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Attach the Dowel(⑤) to Left Side Panel(C).
Repeat the previous steps to the Middle Side Panel(D), and Right Side Panel(E)

<p><u>Step 3</u></p>	 <p style="text-align: right;">④ × 4</p>
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
Insert Cam Nut() into Left Side Panel(C) and Middle Side Panel(D)
using Allen Wrench() turning anticlockwise until tight.

Insert Back Panel(J) into the groove of Left Side Panel(C) and Middle Side Panel(D).





Insert Cam Nut(④) to Right Side Panel(E) using Allen Wrench(⑩) turning anticlockwise until tight.




Insert another Back Panel(J) into the groove of Middle Side Panel(D) and Right Side Panel(E)

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


Attach Cam Bolt(①) to Top Panel(A)

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Insert Cam Nut(②) into the mounting positions on Top Panel(A) using Allen Wrench(⑩) turning clockwise until tight.



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Inset Shelf Support() into Left Side Panel(C) , Middle Side Panel(D) and Right Side Panel(E)

Attach Back Bottom(⑨) to Back Panel(J) using AllenWrench (⑩).



16.1 Drill two mounting positions on the wall with Power Drill(⑮), insert Wall Anchor Screw(⑫) into drilled mounting positions on the wall with Hammer(⑯). Move the cabinet back to the wall, lock by Screw(⑬) and Restraint Bracket(⑪) with Allen Wrench(⑩).

16.2 Attach Restraint Bracket(⑪) to Top Panel(A) with Screws(⑭) using Allen Wrench(⑩).
