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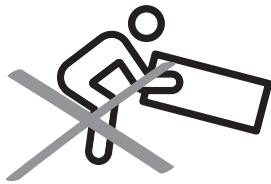
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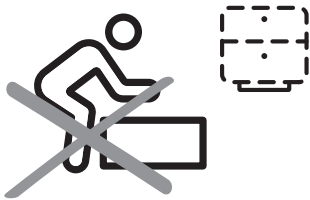
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Teamwork

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Suitable Location

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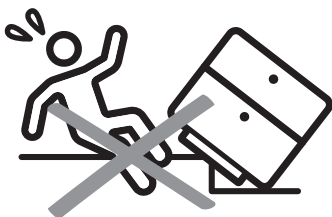
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Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

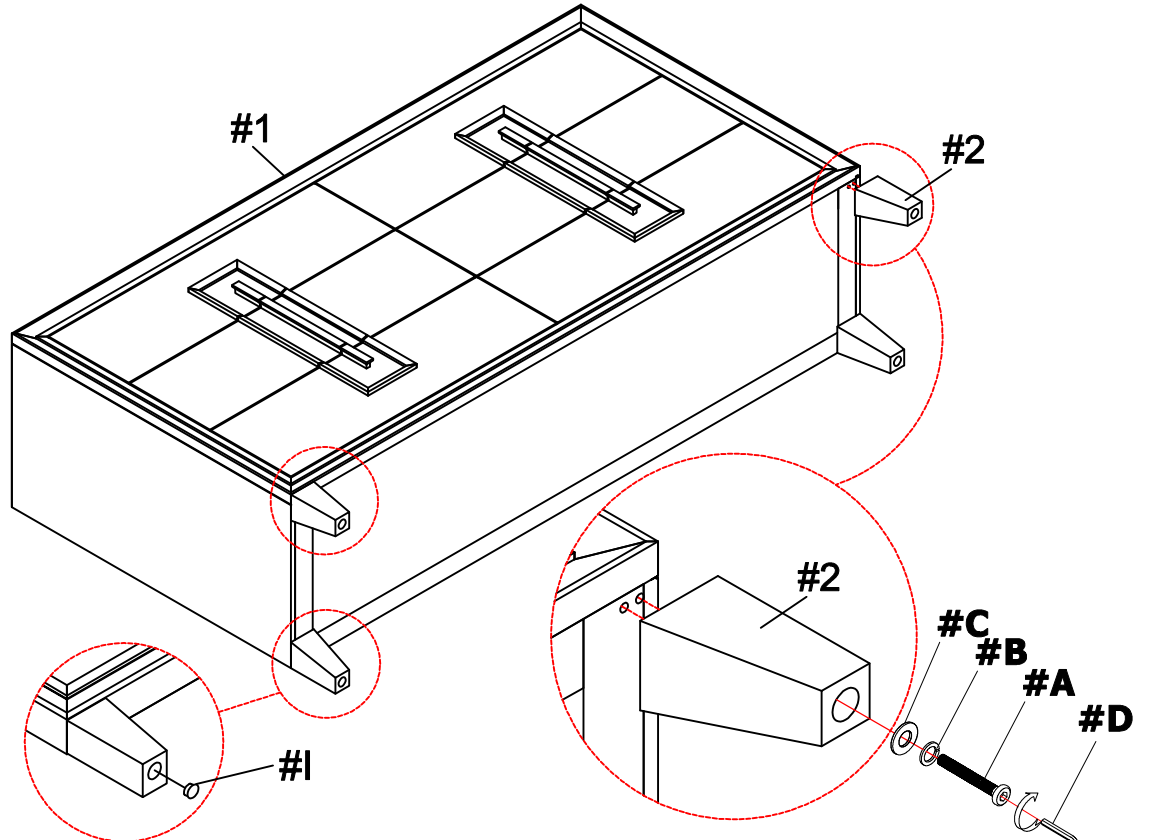
Exploded view

Align HB legs (#2L/R) to the headboard panel (#1), then secure using bolts (#A) with washers (#B,C).

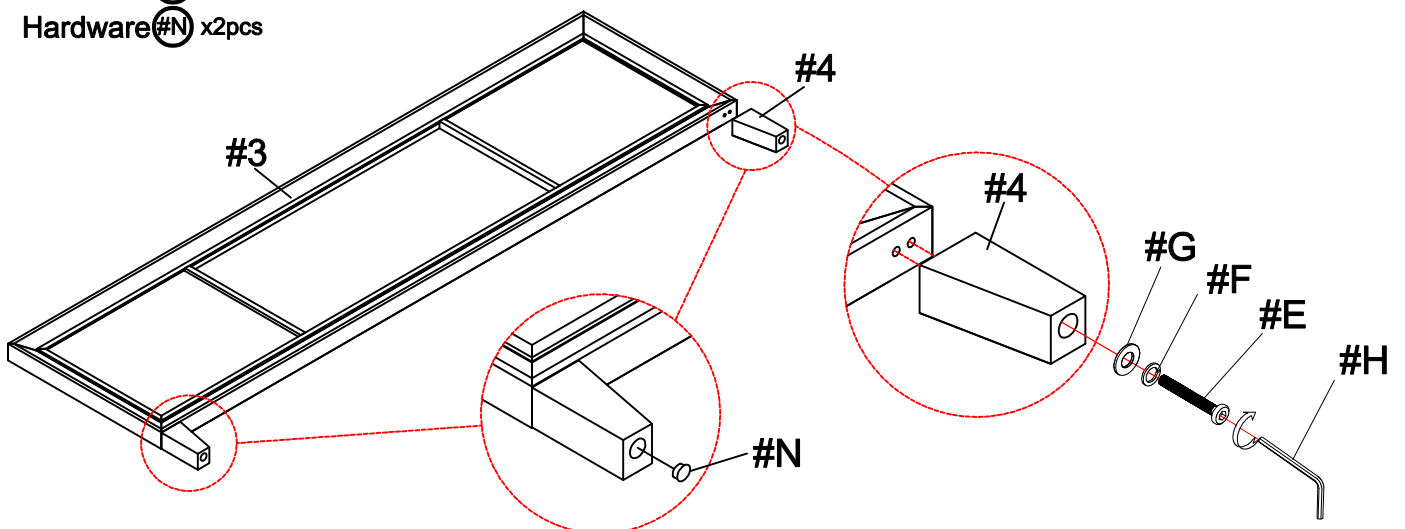

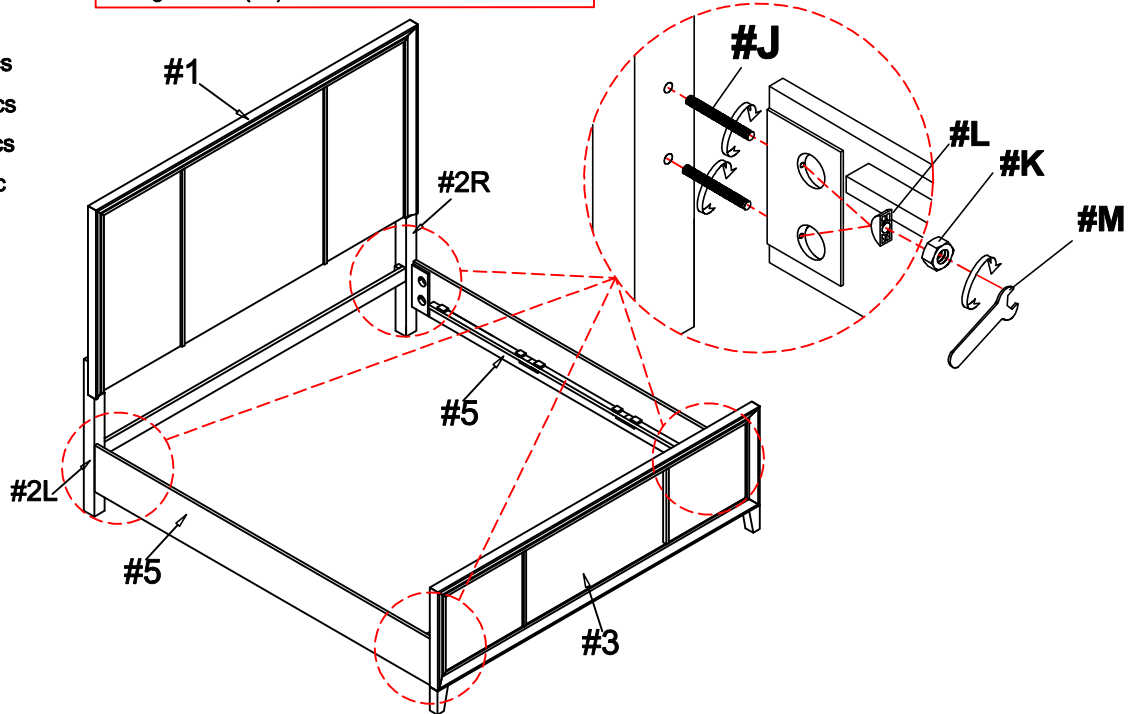

Attach threaded pins (**#J**) to the headboard (**#1**) and footboard (**#3**), Align side rails (**#5**) to the pins (**#J**), then align half moon washer (**#L**) and secure using hex nut (**#K**).

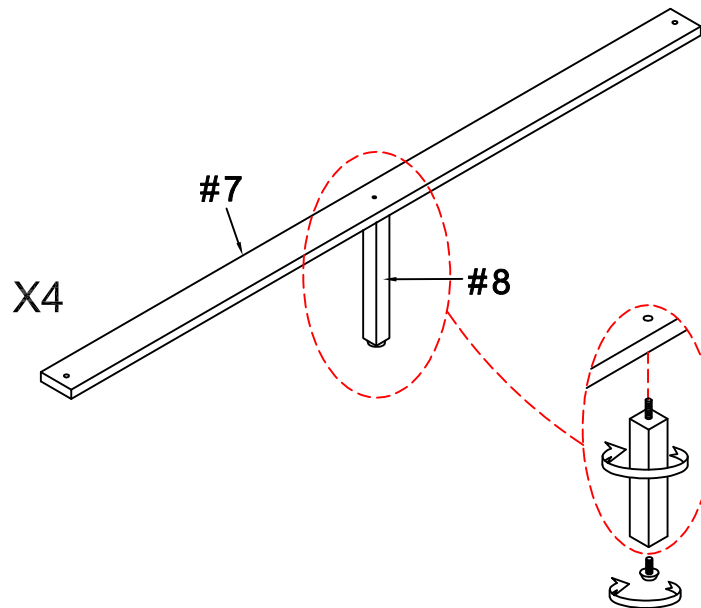

Attach support legs (**#8**) to slats (**#7**).

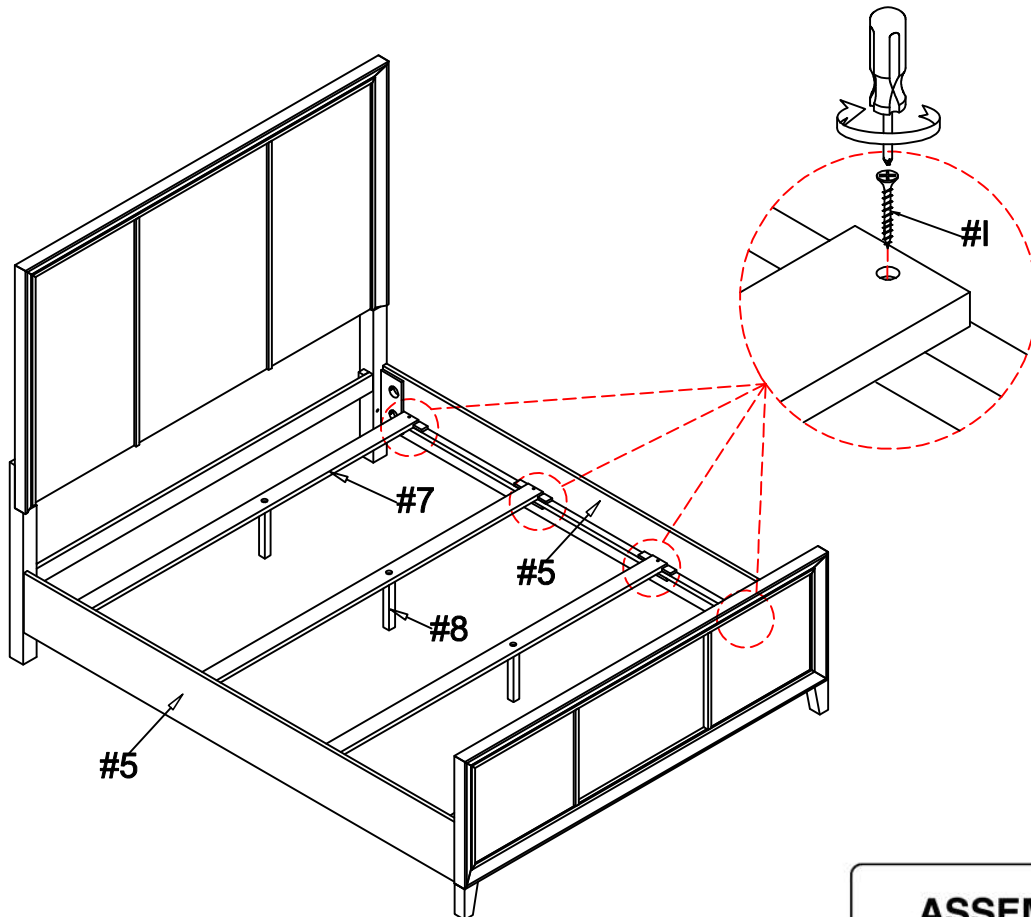

Align slats (#7) to the side rails (#5), then secure by using screw (#1).
