(1/2) Reversible 2-Seater with Pull-out Bed (Back rest is stored in RC)

(2/2) Reversible Chaise with Hidden Storage (Chaise arms are stored in LL)

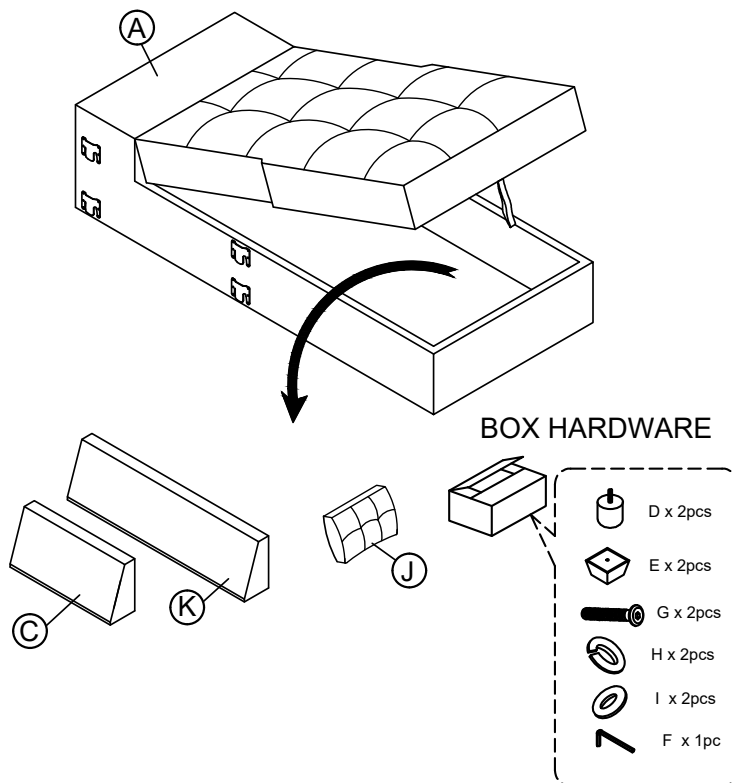


Legs and hardware are stored in the box, please take out for assembly

Care Instruction for Chenille Furniture:

In order to maintain the original appearance of your Chenille Furniture, please follow below simple care procedures:

- Avoid exposing furniture directly to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets. Sunlight and or exposure to heating and air conditioning outlets will fade/damage Chenille.
- Vacuum or wipe with a soft cloth to remove dust.
- Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connections are tight. Re-tighten if necessary.



For items used on wooden floor, hard surfaces or carpets, it is recommended to install protective pads under all legs and supports to avoid/prevent from damages/scratches and discoloration.
