Please loose the TRUSS screw from Headboard (#1) front near to bottom for left and right side. Also, the same action on Footboard (#3).

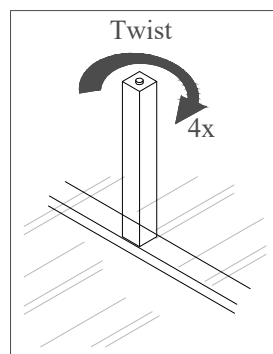


Please hook Screw plate on Side Rail is already loosened. Use Allen Key (#B) to attach the Side Rail (#2) to Headboard (#1) and Footboard (#3).

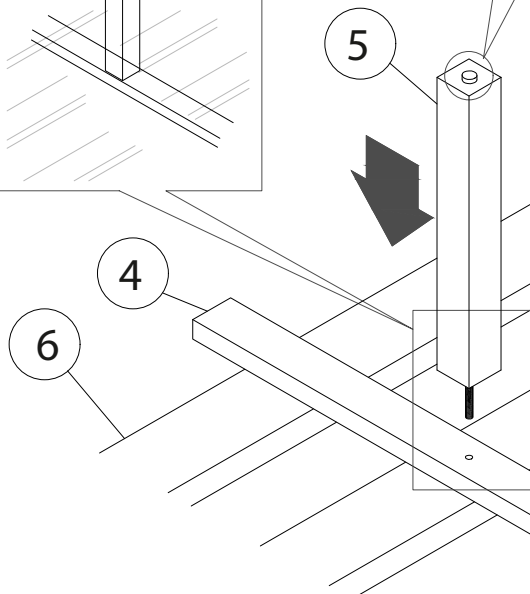

Put the Center Rail (#4) on Slats (#6). Then take the Center Rail Supporter (#5) insert in the hole as in the picture and twist until tight.



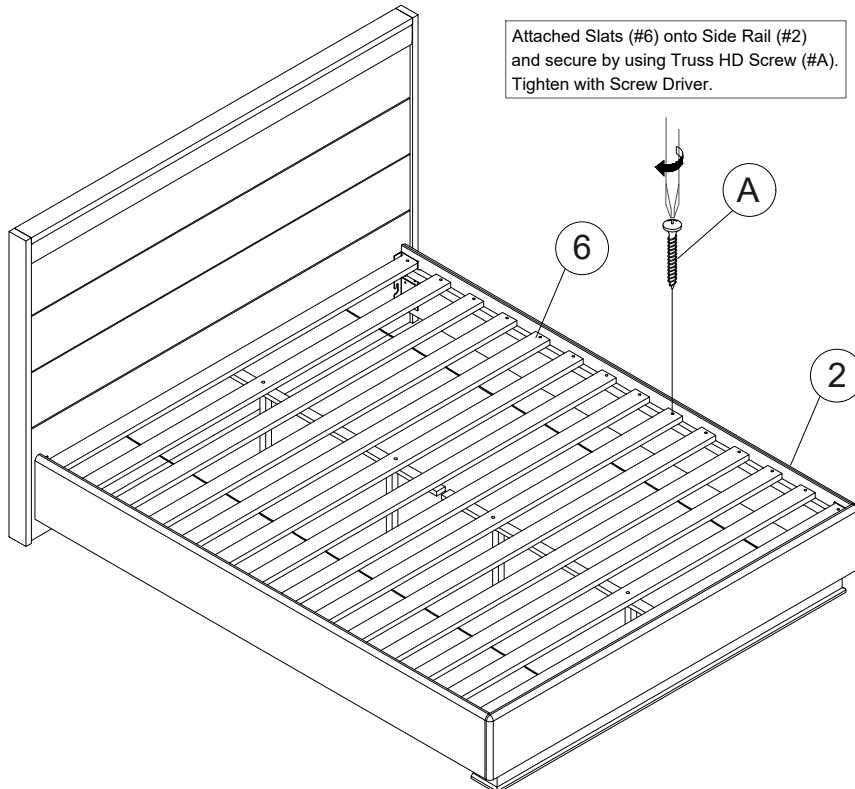
