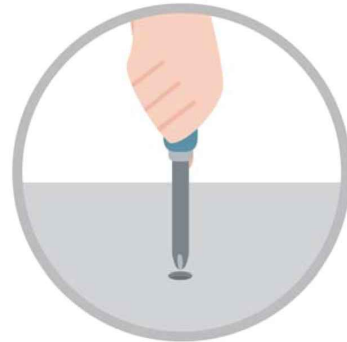


Turn clockwise to tighten and

Put the Center Rail (#6) on Slats (#8). Then take the Center Rail Supporter (#7) insert in the hole as in the picture and twist until tight.

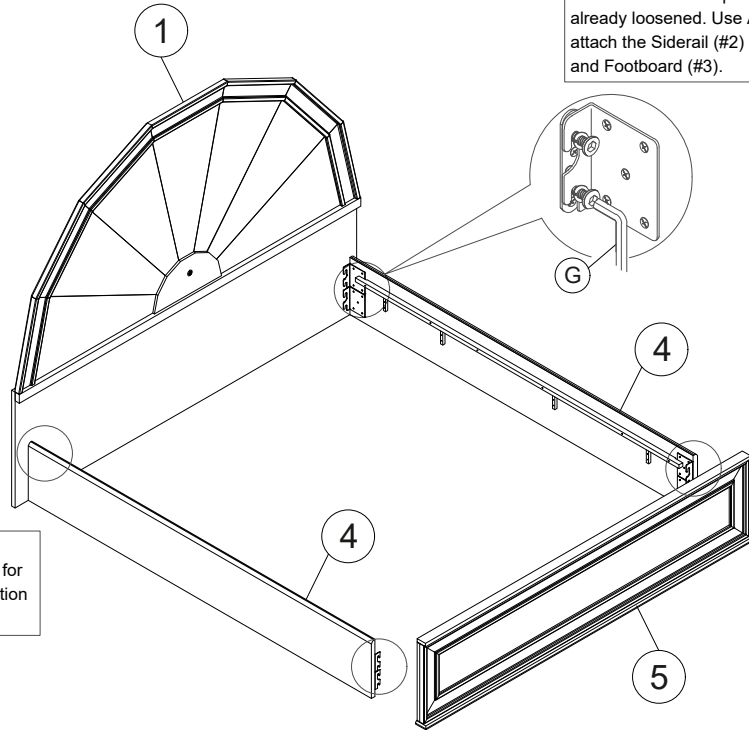

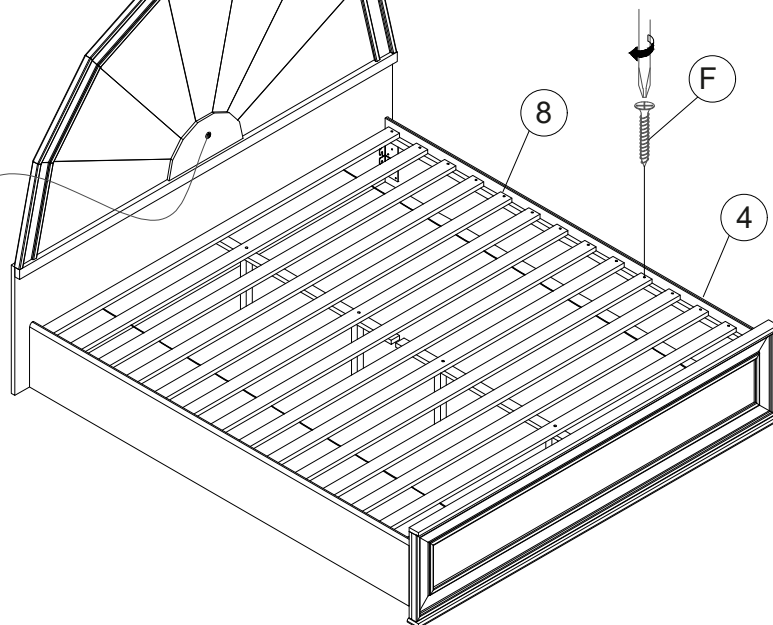

Attached Slats (#8) onto Siderail (#4) and secure by using Truss HD Screw (#F). Tighten with Screw Driver.

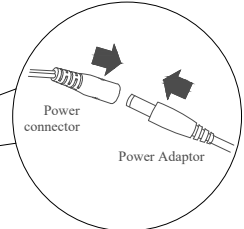
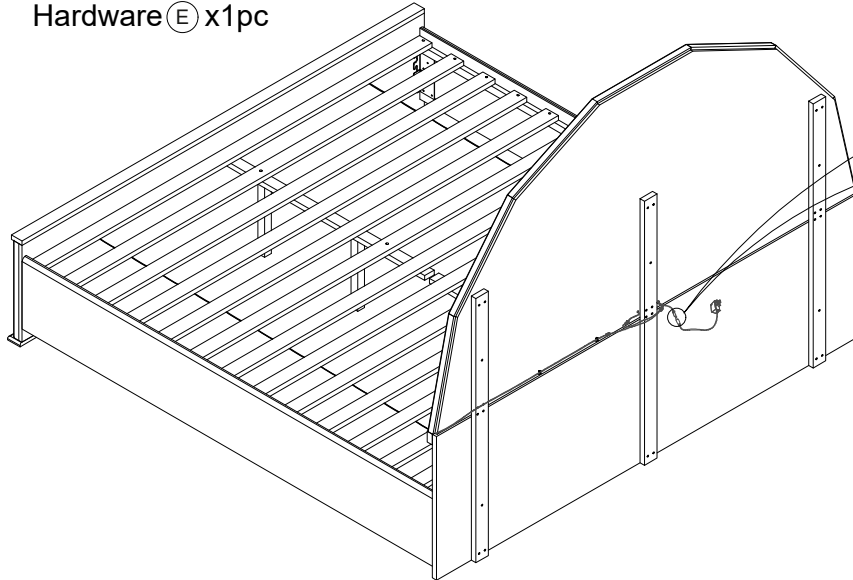
