- 1** Insert PVC Dowel (K) into the pre-drilled holes of the Upper Crossbar (C) and the Lower Crossbar (D).



-
- 2** (i) Place the Table Top (A) upside down on an even surface. Attach the Leg (B) to the frame of the Table Top (A) using JCBB Bolt (G), Lock Washer (I) and Flat Washer (J) with the Allen Wrench (N).
- (ii) Use PVC Dowel (K) as a guide to align and attach the Upper Crossbar (C) to the Leg (B) using JCBC Bolt (F) and Nylon Washer (L) with the Allen Wrench (M).

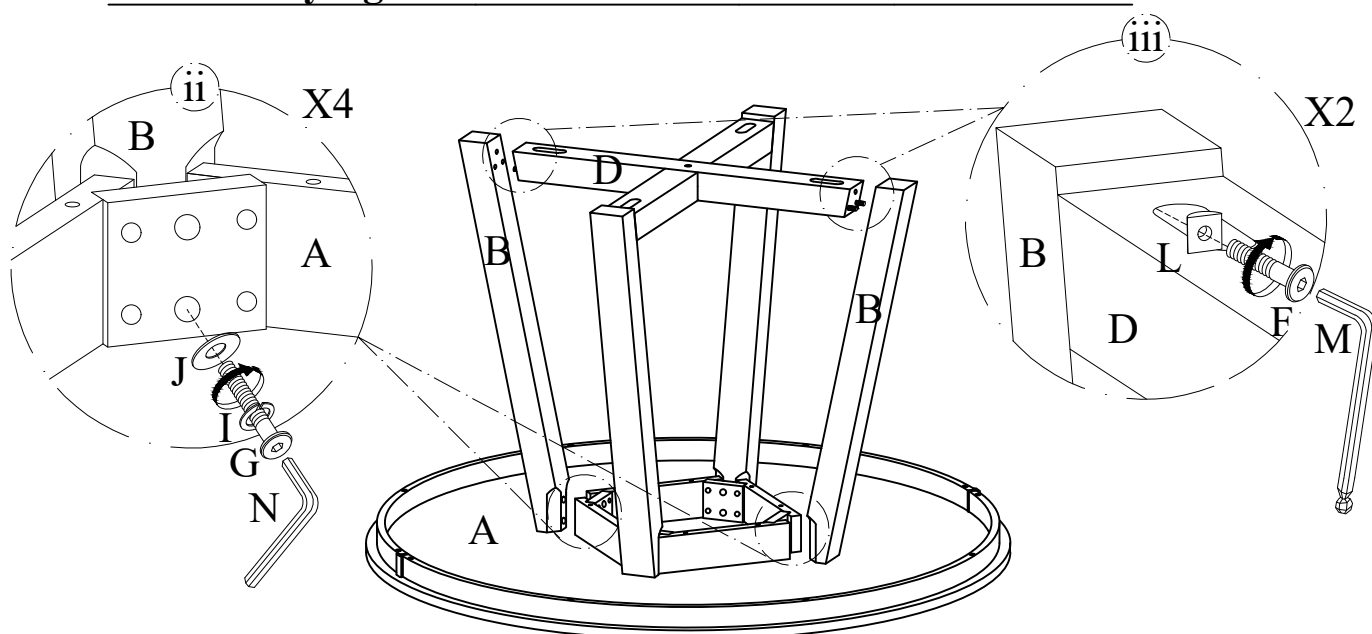


3 Slot the Lower Crossbar (D) into the Upper Crossbar (C).

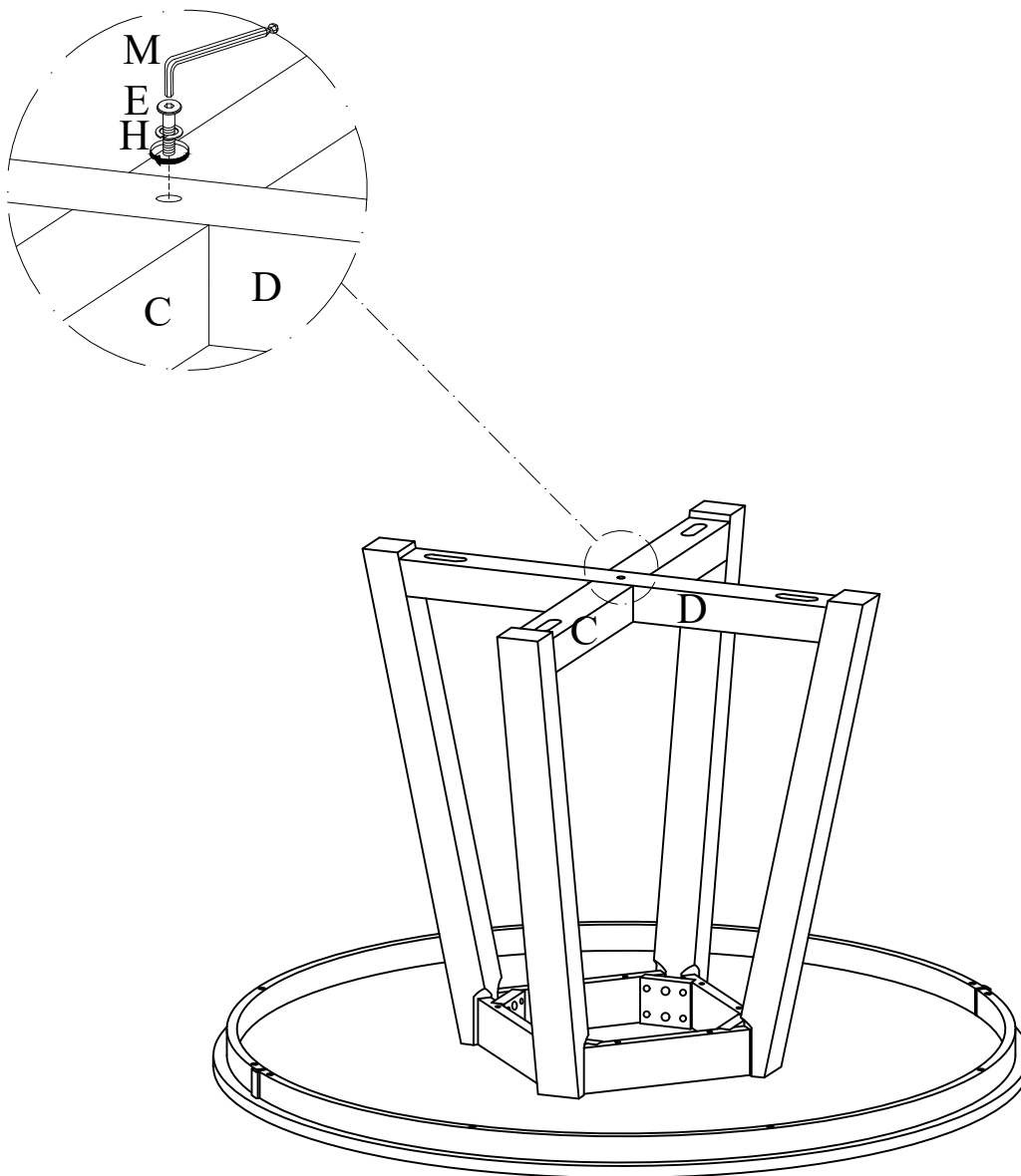


- 4** (i) Use PVC Dowel (K) as a guide to align and attach the Leg (B) to the Lower Crossbar (D) and the frame of the Table Top (A).
(ii) Secure the Leg (B) to the frame of the Table Top (A) using JCBB Bolt (G), Lock Washer (I) and Flat Washer (J) with the Allen Wrench (N).
(iii) Secure the Leg (B) to the Lower Crossbar (D) using JCBC Bolt (F) and Nylon Washer (L) with the Allen Wrench (M).

**** Do not fully tighten the bolts until all bolts are attached.**



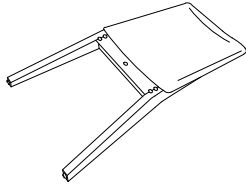

- 5** Secure the Lower Crossbar (D) to the Upper Crossbar (C) using JCBC Bolt (E) and Lock Washer (H) with the Allen Wrench (M).



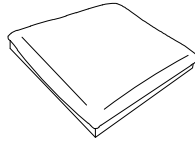
Cleaning & Care

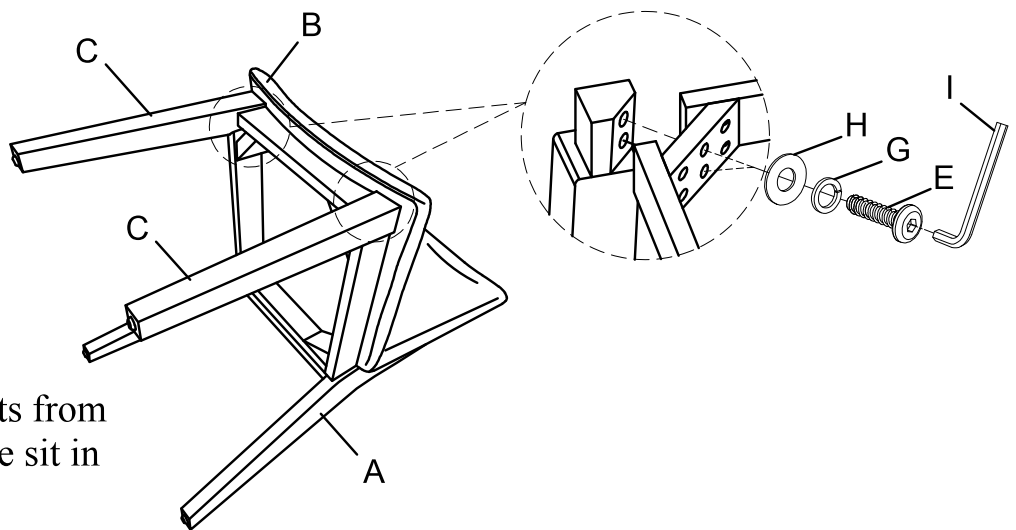
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-
- 1** Attach the Seat Cushion (B) to the Back Frame (A) using Bolt (F), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) into the corner holes, and using Bolt (D), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) into the middle holes, tightening with the Allen Key (I).



Take the Allen Key and turn the bolts until the legs are secured. **DO NOT TIGHTEN THE BOLTS COMPLETELY.** Stop when you feel you are adding force to tighten the bolts.

- 2** Attach the Leg (C) to the Seat Cushion (B) using Bolt (E), Lock Washer (G) and Flat Washer (H) with the Allen Key (I).



Helpful Tips

*While tightening the bolts from underneath, have someone sit in the chair.

Stand the chair on an even surface and check for balance. If the chair wobbles slightly, apply downward pressure on the uneven leg and tighten the bolts to correct the imbalance. Once the chair is balanced, apply downward pressure evenly in the center of the chair and tighten all bolts, being careful not to over-tighten beyond the hole depth.
