
Care & Maintenance













Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.

 Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



 Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



 Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

Please look in trundle bed for hardware packs and legs. Sets often ship in multiple boxes and may arrive a day or two apart.







<u>Overview</u>




This CONVERTIBLE SOFA BED has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.




Attach the Leg(\bigcirc) to the Armrest(A) with Gasket(\bigcirc), fasten in clockwise. Repeat the same step to another Armrest(B).






Attach the Connector(5) to the Armrest(A&B) using Bolt(1), Washer(12) with M6 Allen Key(10).

Step 3




Attach the Armrests(A&B) to the Back&Seat Frame(D) using Bolt(4) and Washer(6) with M8 Allen Key(9).




Attach the Connector L(4) and Connector R(5) to the Rear Baffle(G) using Bolt(3) and Washer(6) with M8 Allen Key(9).

Attach the Rear Baffle to the Armrest using Bolt(③) and Washer(⑥) with M8 Allen Key(⑨).



Attach the Front Baffle(F) to Trundle Bed(E) using Bolt(②) and Washer(①) with M6 Allen Key(⑩).




Attach the Wheel((8)) to the Trundle Bed(E) using Screw((11)), fasten with screw driver(not provided).

Step 7


Insert the two side wheels of the trundle bed into the two lower connectors in front of the armrest.







Step 9



Open the zipper on the back of the backrest and take out two support legs. Press the button on the side of the support legs to fold it back.

Put down the backrest and make it a bed.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

• What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list? The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.
- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
