In addition to installing the restraints, to help prevent tip-over



Assembly Preparation

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-


Overview



FRONT FACING


This Bedside has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bedside parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



With help of your adult partner, carefully stand the Bedside. Install the Knob(②)on the Door with the help of Screw driver (①) as pictured above.

Step 2



Place the Bedside to the Wall.

This Bedside is now ready to use.

Caution: This Bedside can only be used on flat, level surface.


Tip-over Restraint Device Installation Instructions



Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from tipping furniture.

To help prevent tip-over: ALWAYS secure this furniture to the wall using Tipover Restraint Device.



Usage For Tipover Restraint Device:

To secure Bedside against wall, attach two Brackets (5) on wall and product, use Tipover Restraint Straps (8) to connect the Brackets (5) .

Step 3



3.1) Drill two holes on wall at same height as Brackets (5) on Bedside with Power Drill (4).

You can mark these points in two ways as below:


1) Move the Bedside back to the wall. Mark two points same height as Bedside on the wall.

Note: The Brackets need to be secured to solid, load bearing surface. Please use a Stud Finder(not supplied) if needed to locate the Wall Frame.

2) Measure the height of the Brackets (5) with ruler/measuring tape and mark on wall to keep them accurate and same height.


3.2) Insert Wall Plugs (7) into drilled holes on wall with Hammer (3).

Step 2



Attach Brackets (⑤) to Wall Plugs (⑦) using Wall Plug Screws (⑥) with Screwdriver (①).

Step 3



Move Bedside to the wall.

Pull the Restraint Straps (⑧) through the Brackets (⑤) on the wall and Bedside one by one, and pull the Restraint Straps (⑧) tight.

This Bedside is now ready to use.

Caution: This Bedside can only be used on flat, level surface.

Care & Maintenance



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a passed barner to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside. for indoor use only.



- Not for commercial use. for residential use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick - up shills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
