### Care & Maintenance



• Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



• Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



• Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



 To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor product minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



• Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



• Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



 To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine.
Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.



Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.




• Keep away from sources of ignition.

### Caution: This Chair is NOT a TOY.


Keep your child / children at bay during the assembly process.





## Assembly Steps


### Overview:




This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.



With the help of your adult partner, attach the Seat Panel (B) to the Backrest Panel (A) then secure by using Screws (3) with Allen Wrench (4) as shown in the picture above. **Do not fully tighten the Screws.** 




With the help of your adult partner, attach the Left Leg Panel (D) to the assembled part in Step 2 as shown above. Then:

**Step 3.1,** Secure the Left Leg Panel (D) to the Seat Panel (B) by using Screw ( $\widehat{1}$ ) with Allen Wrench ( $\widehat{4}$ ) as shown in the picture above.

**Step 3.2,** Secure the Left Leg Panel (D) to the Backrest Panel (A) by using Screw (2) with Allen Wrench (4) as shown in the picture above.

Do not fully tighten the Screws.




With the help of your adult partner, turn the assembled part in Step 3 left side down, and then attach the Right Leg Panel (C) to the above part as shown above. Then:

**Step 4.1,** Secure the Right Leg Panel (C) to the Seat Panel (B) by using Screw (1) with Allen Wrench (4) as shown in the picture above.

**Step 4.2,** Secure the Right Leg Panel (C) to the Backrest Panel (A) by using Screw (2) with Allen Wrench (4) as shown in the picture above.

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

#### Step 5:



Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Turn the Chair right side up.

Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Chair.

This will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.

Then get off the Chair and proceed to tighten the Screws in a sequential manner.

When tightening the Screws tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any Screws fully and then move on towards the next one.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Screws and execute this same process.

Your Chair is ready for use.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.
