Align side rails (4) to the bolts of the headboard Leg (3) and footboard (2). Fully tighten the bolts.



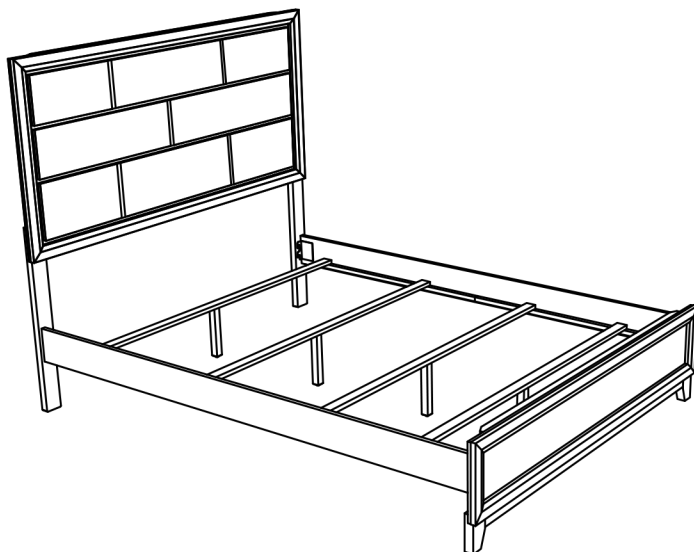
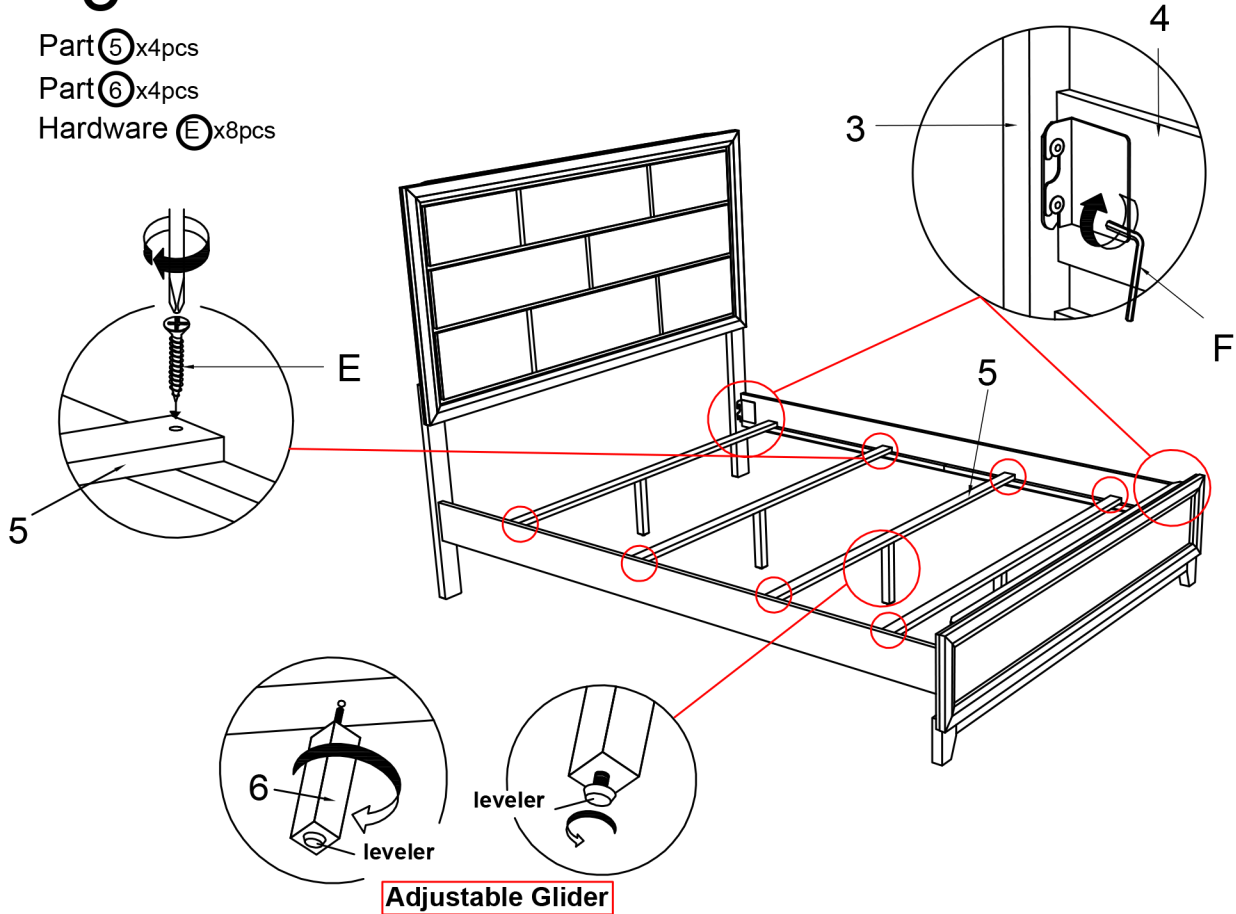

Tighten the screw back after putting the handle facing outside.



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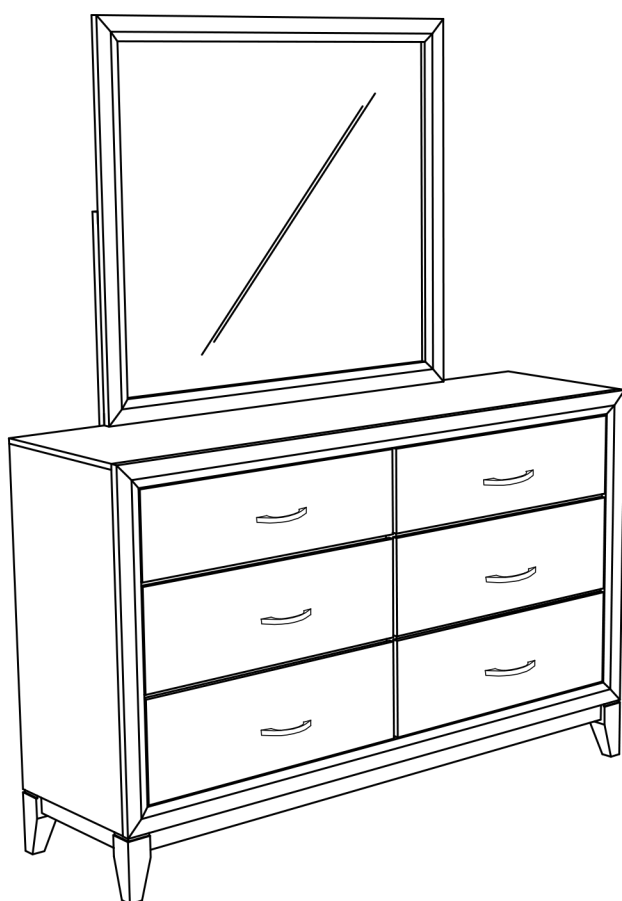
