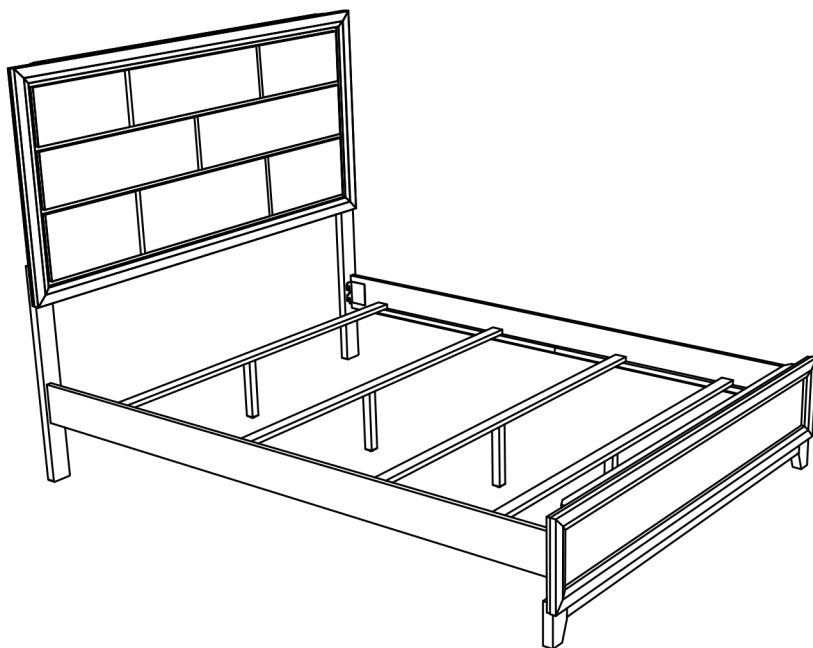

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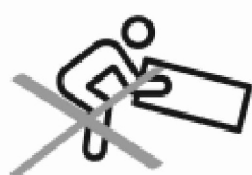

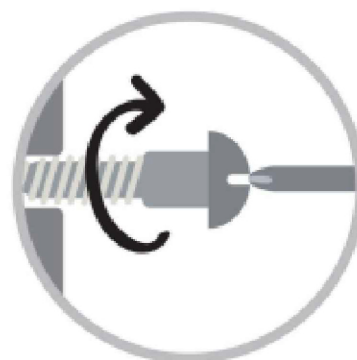
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Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
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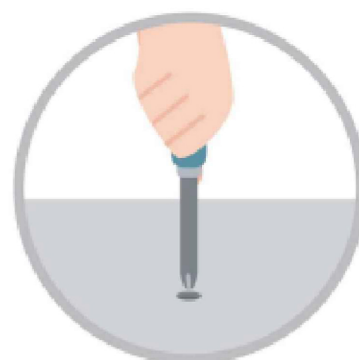

Align side rails (4) to the bolts of the headboard Leg (3) and footboard (2). Fully tighten the bolts.



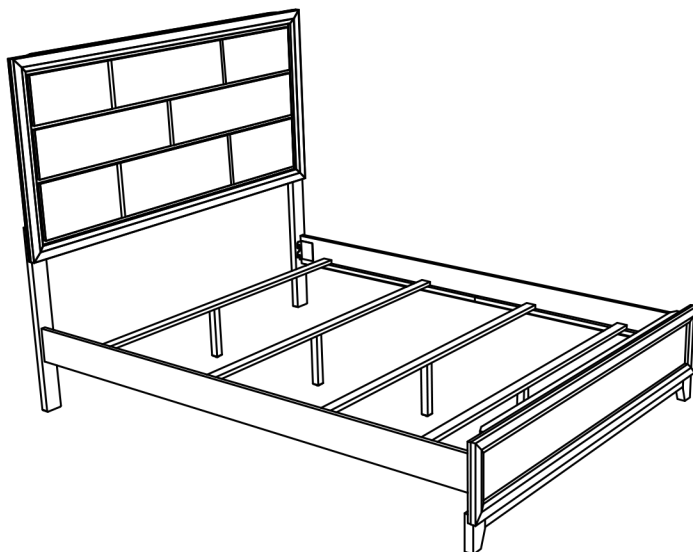
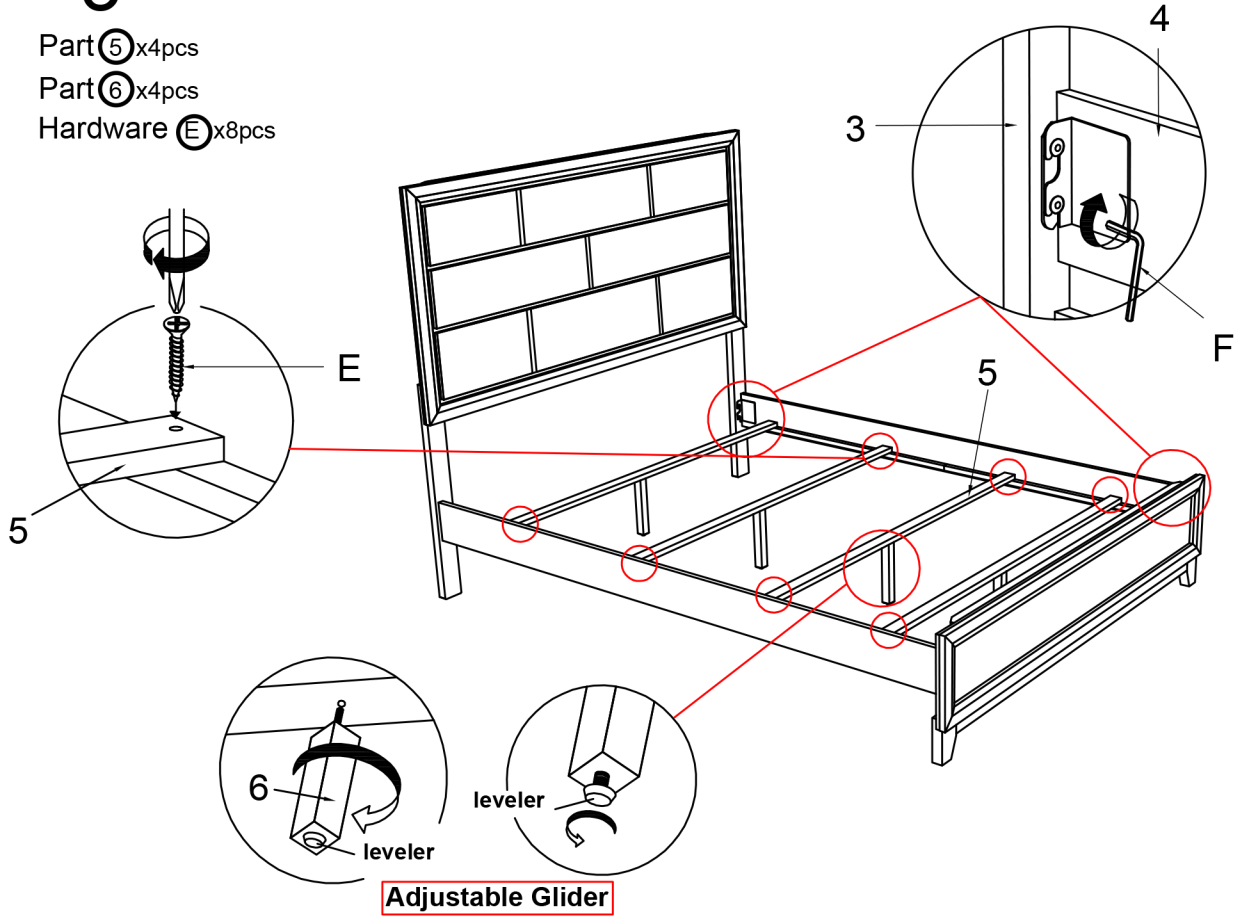

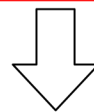
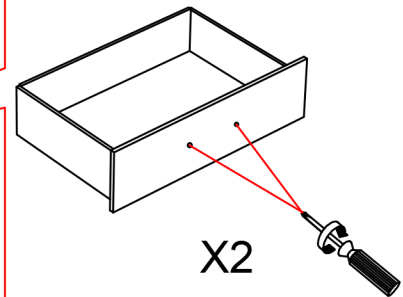
Remark : Turn the Night Stand to upside down position as shown.



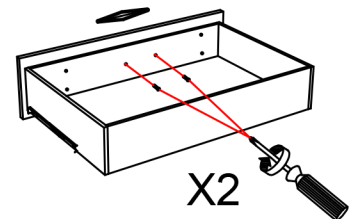
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS
