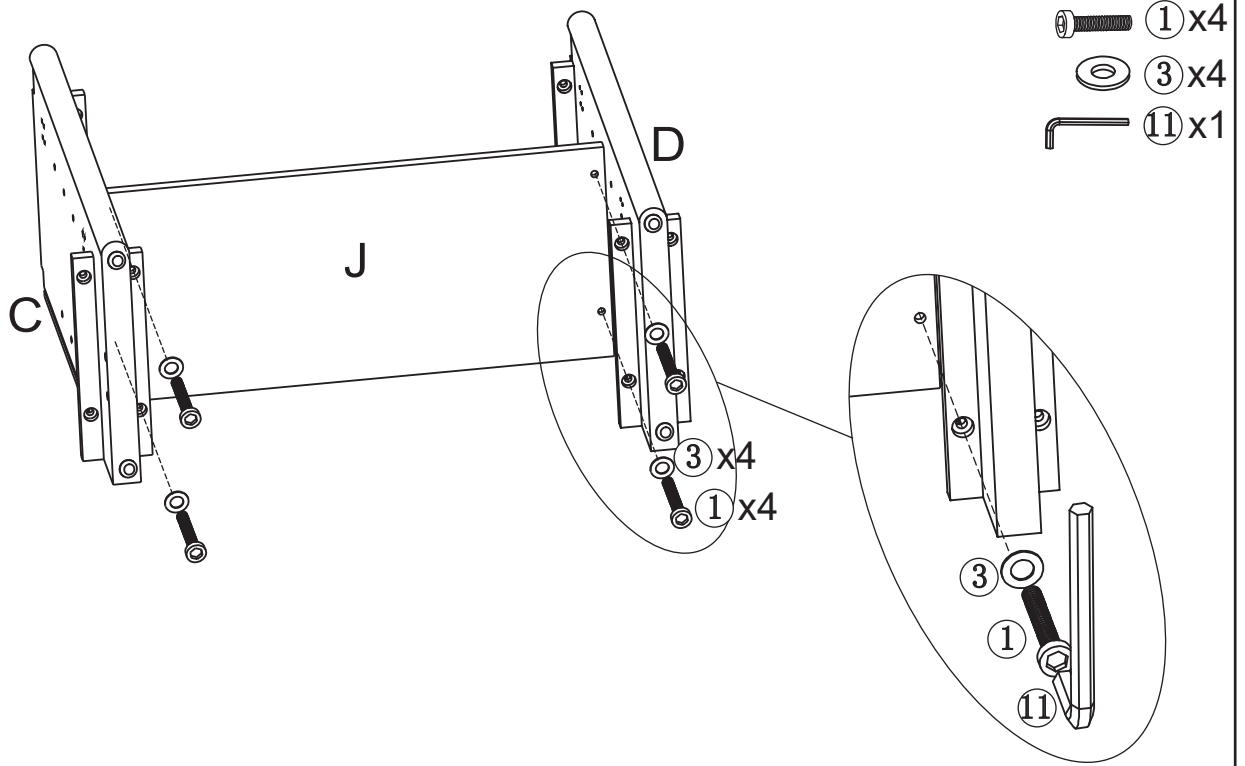
Assembly Steps

Overview



This Buffet Cabinet has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Buffet Cabinet parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

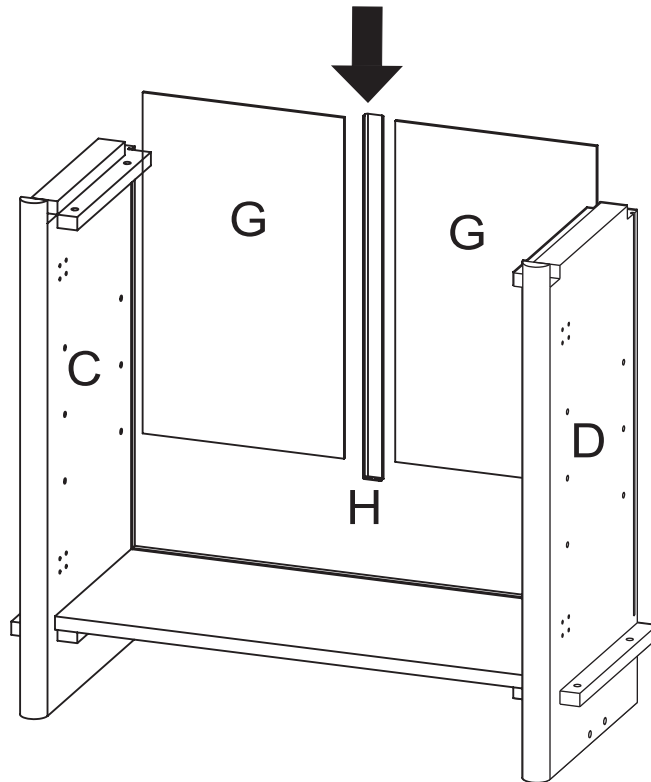
Step 1



Attach the middle bottom panel(J) to the left side panel(C) with bolt(①) and flat washer(③) using allen wrench(⑪).

Repeat the previous steps to the right side panel(D) .

Step 2



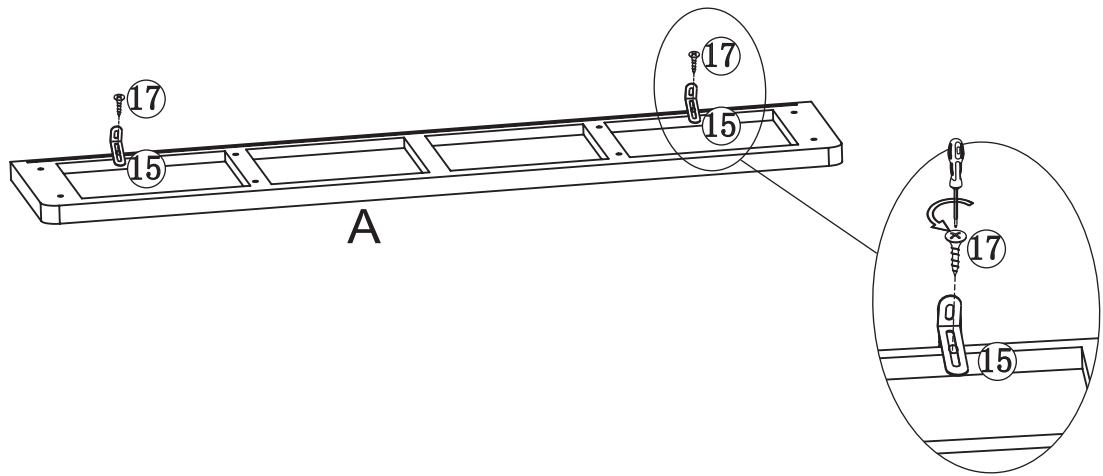
Insert the back panel(G) into the groove of the left side panel(C) and the right side panel(D).

Insert strip(H) into the groove of the left side panel(C) and the right side panel(D).

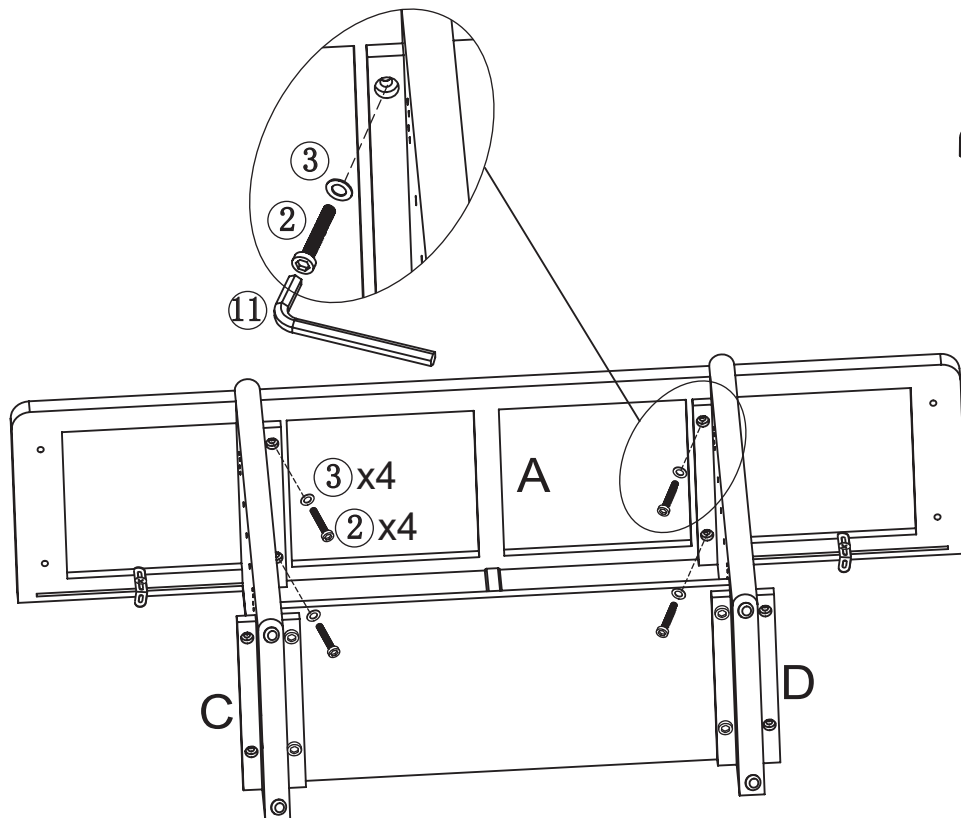
Attach the long side of anti-tipping iron sheet(⑮) into the top panel(A) with screw(⑰) using screwdriver.

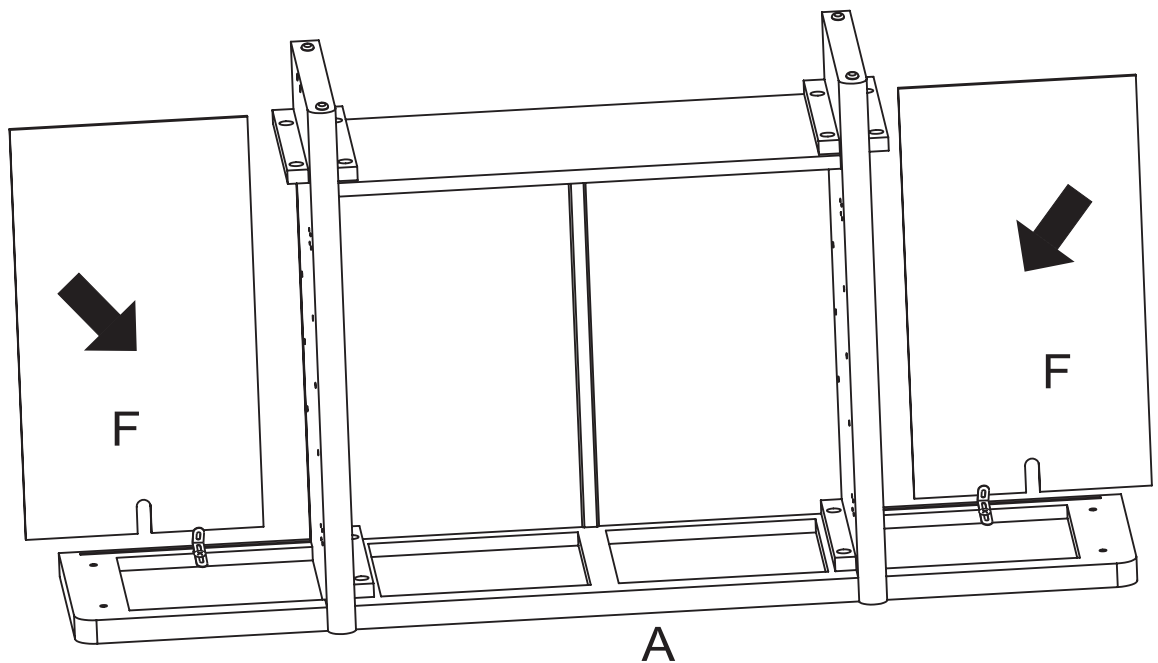

Attach the top panel(A) to the left side panel(C) with bolt(②) and flat washer(③) using allen wrench(⑪).

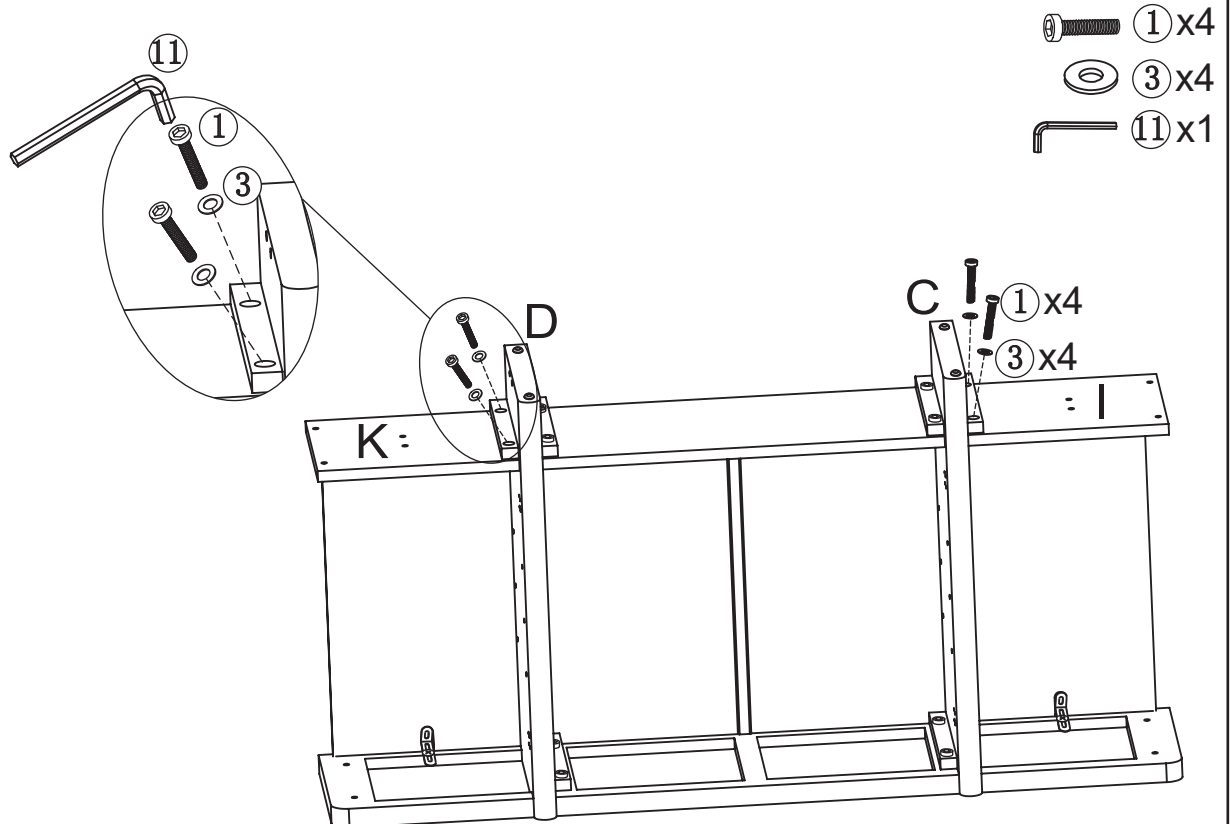
Repeat the previous steps to the right side panel(D) .

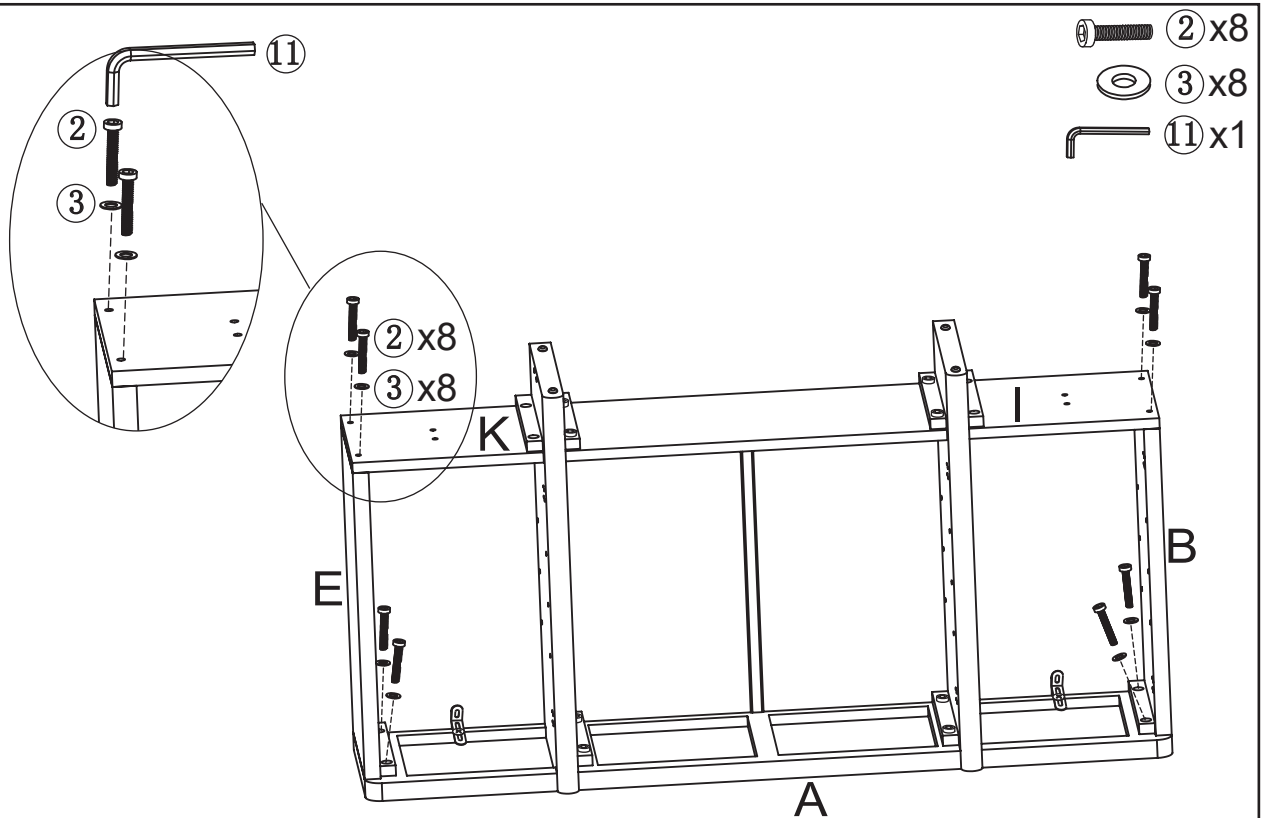
Insert the back panel(F) into the groove of the top panel(A).

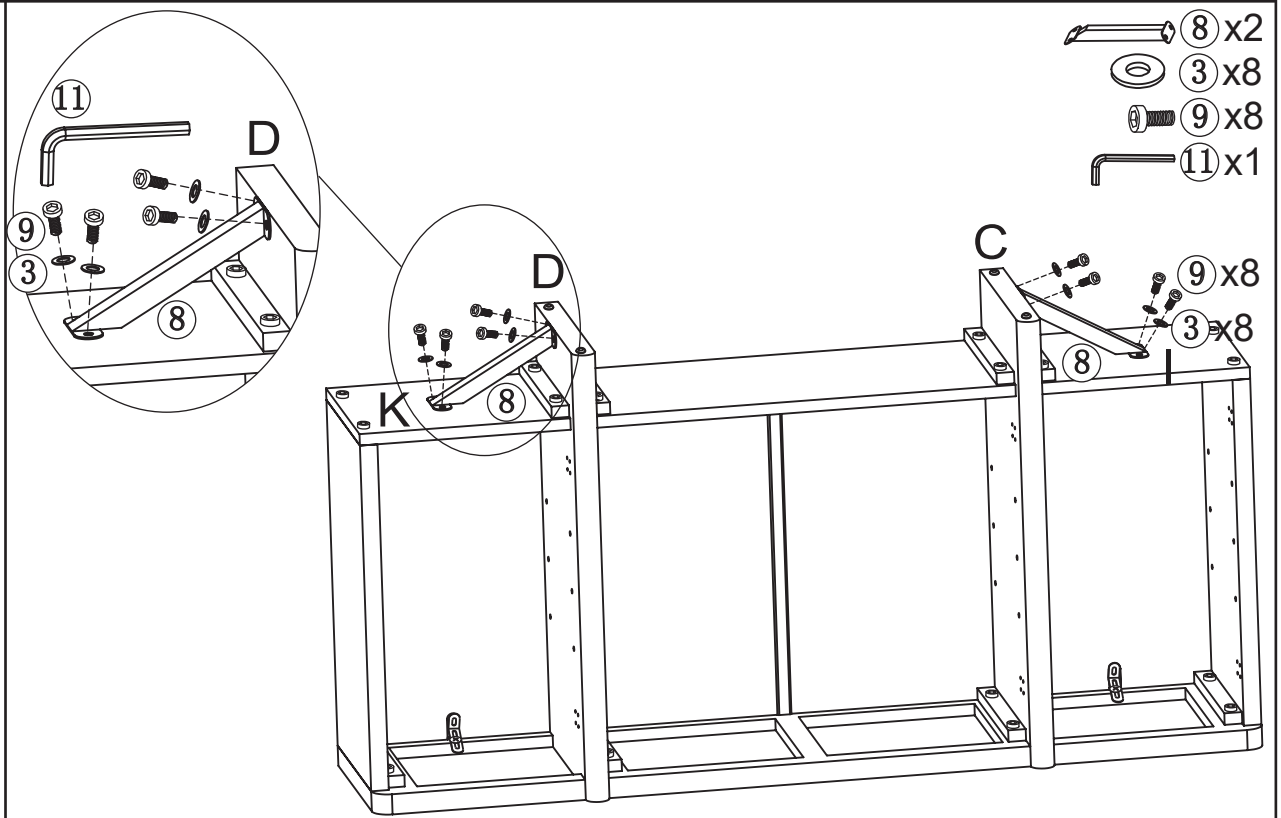
Attach the left bottom panel(I) to the left side panel(C) with bolt(①) and flat washer(③) using allen wrench(⑪). Attach the right bottom panel(K) to the right side panel(D) with bolt(①) and flat washer(③) using allen wrench(⑪).

Step 7



Attach the left side panel(B) to the top panel(A) and the left bottom panel(I) with bolt(2) and flat washer(3) using allen wrench(11). Repeat the previous steps to the right side panel(E) .

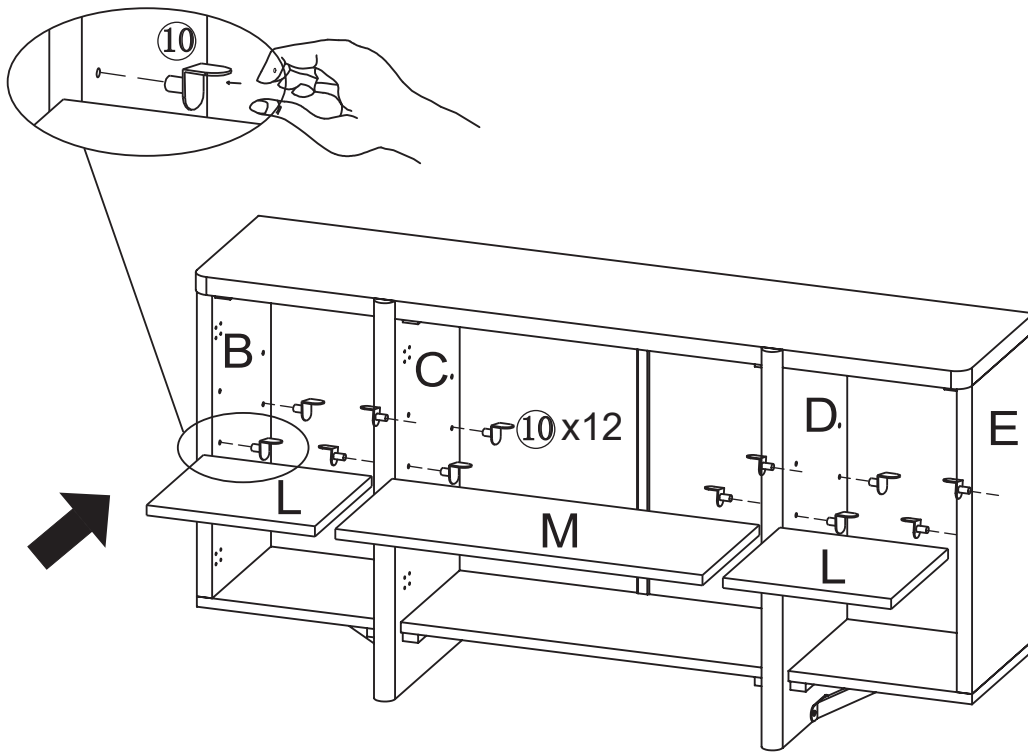
Step 8



Attach the metal support strip(8) to the left side panel(C) and the left bottom panel(I) with bolt(9) and flat washer(3) using allen wrench(11). Repeat the previous steps to the right side panel(D) and the right bottom panel(K).

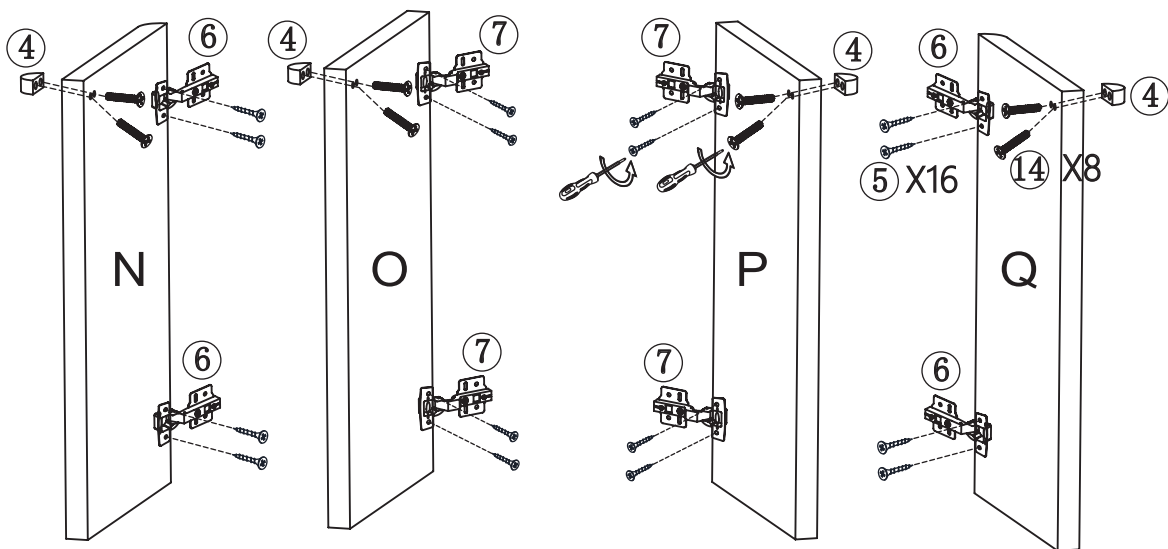
Inset shelf pin(⑩) into the left side panel(B,C) and the right side panel(D,E). Put left & right adjustable panel(L) and middle adjustable panel(M) on the shelf pin(⑩).

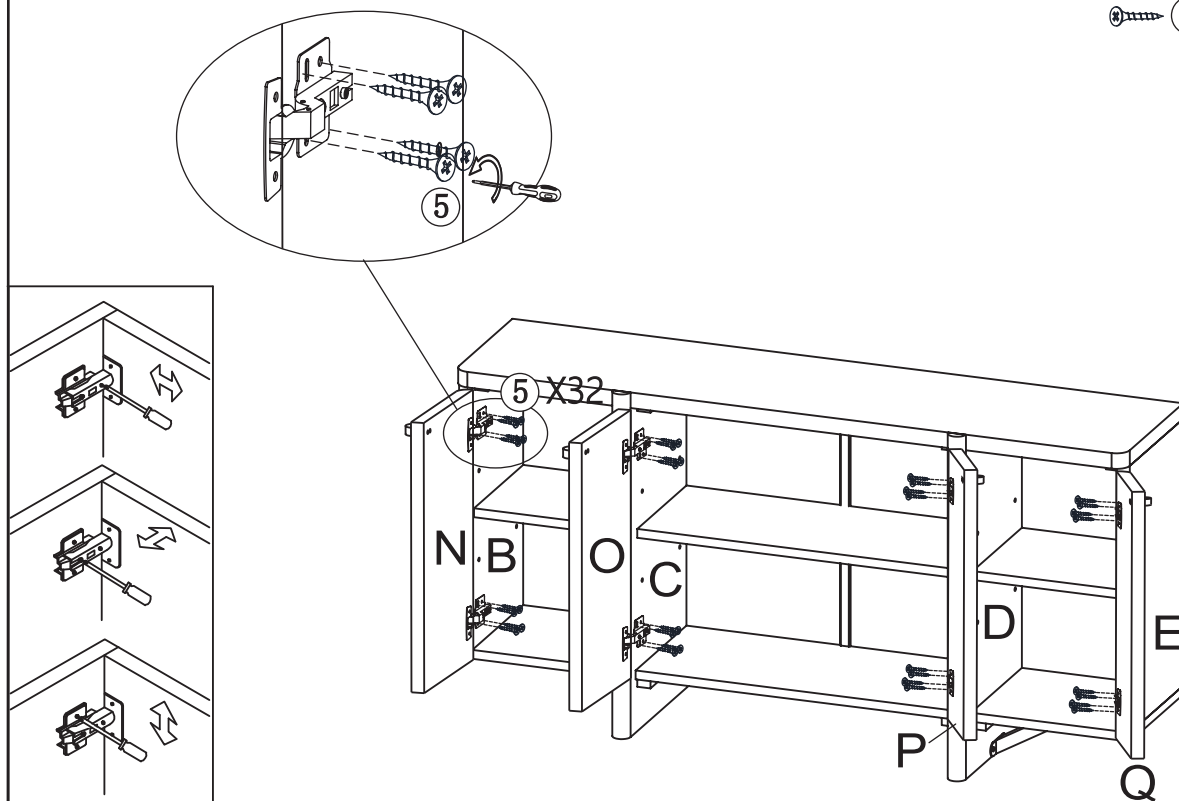

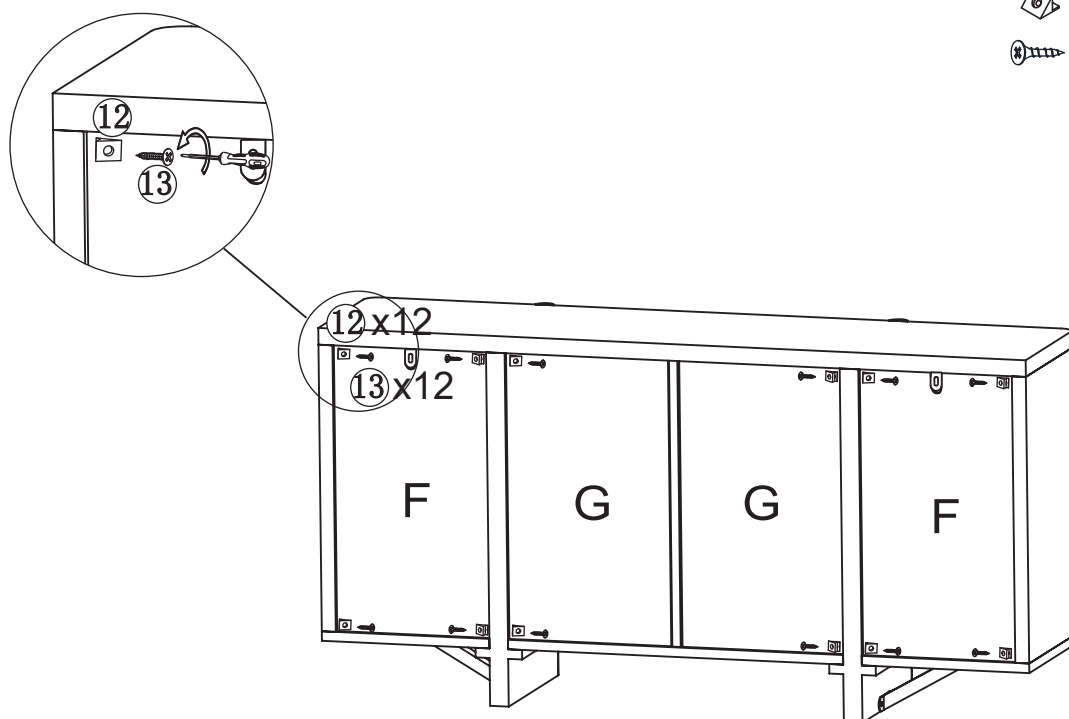

Attach left door panel(N,O) to left side panel (B,C) with screw(⑤) using screwdriver.Repeat the previous steps to right door panel(P,Q) .

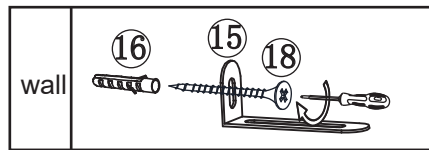

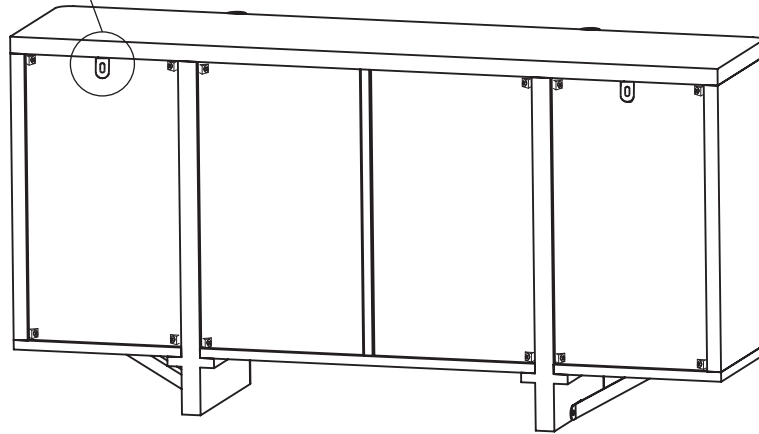


Attach plastic button(⑫) into the back panel(F,G) with Screw(⑬) using Screwdriver.

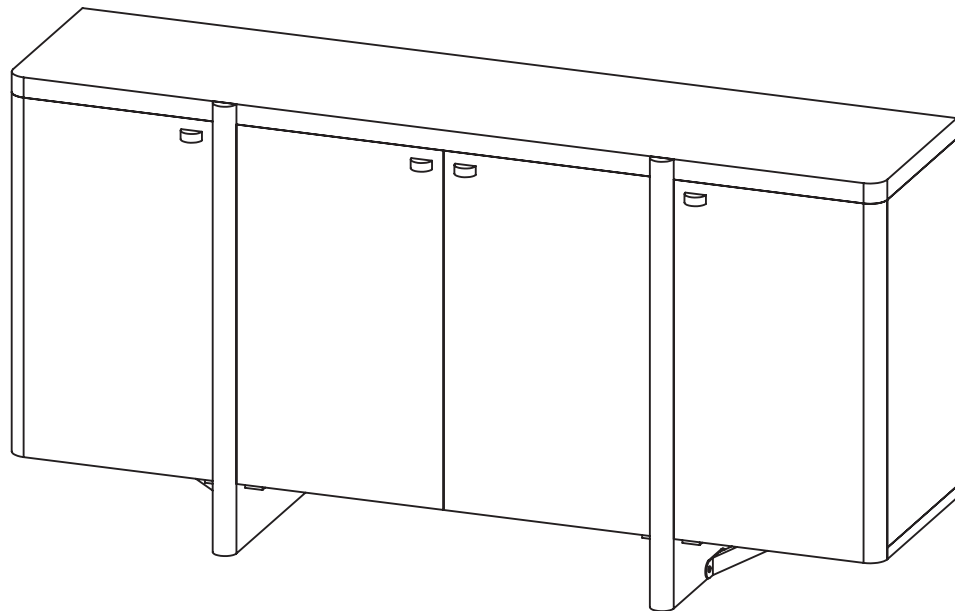

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water. Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals. By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
