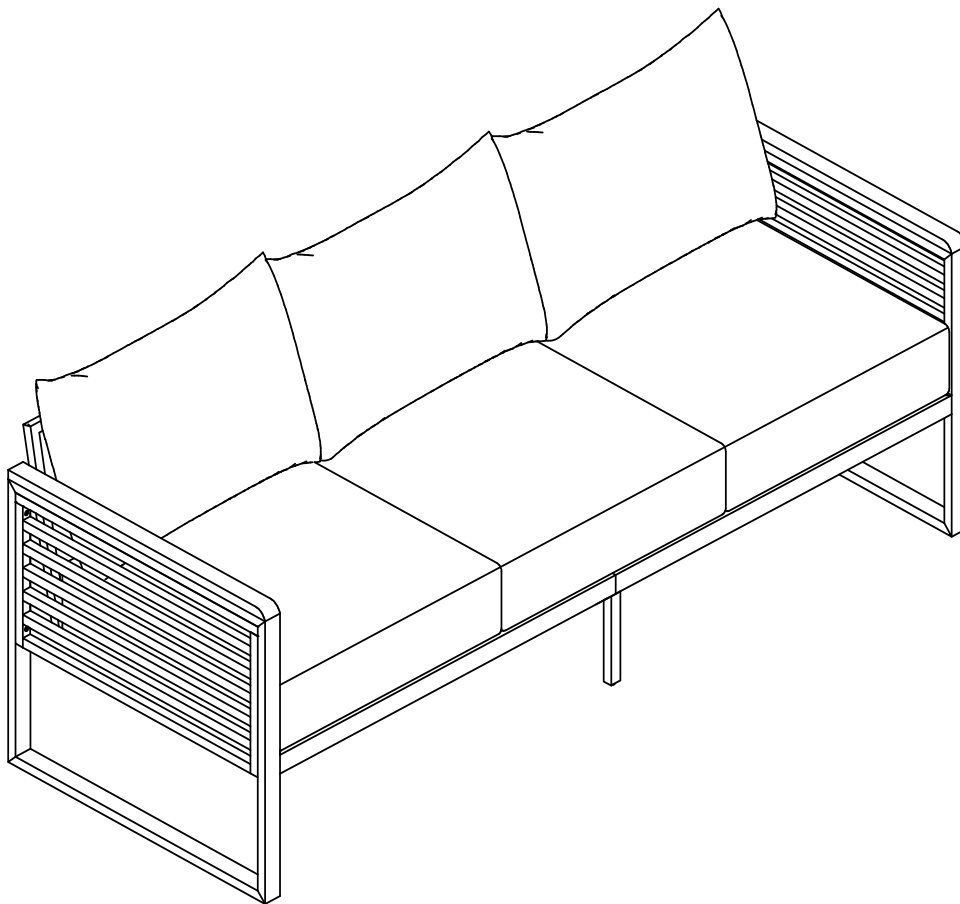

Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  • Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



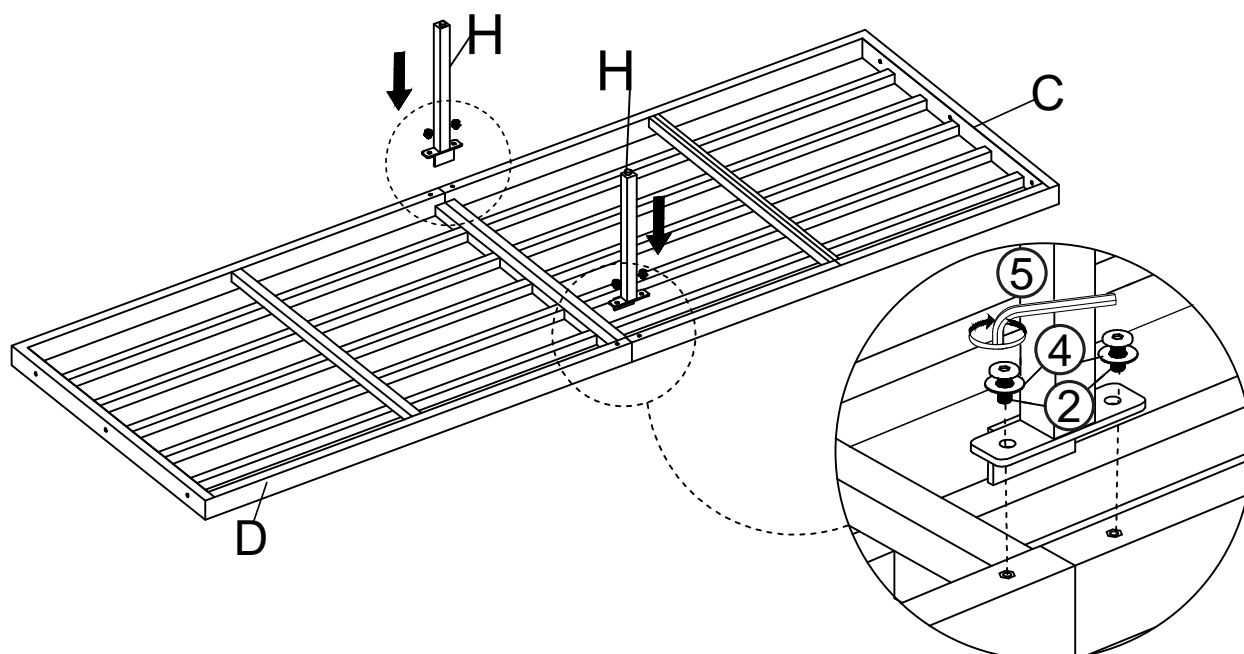
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2



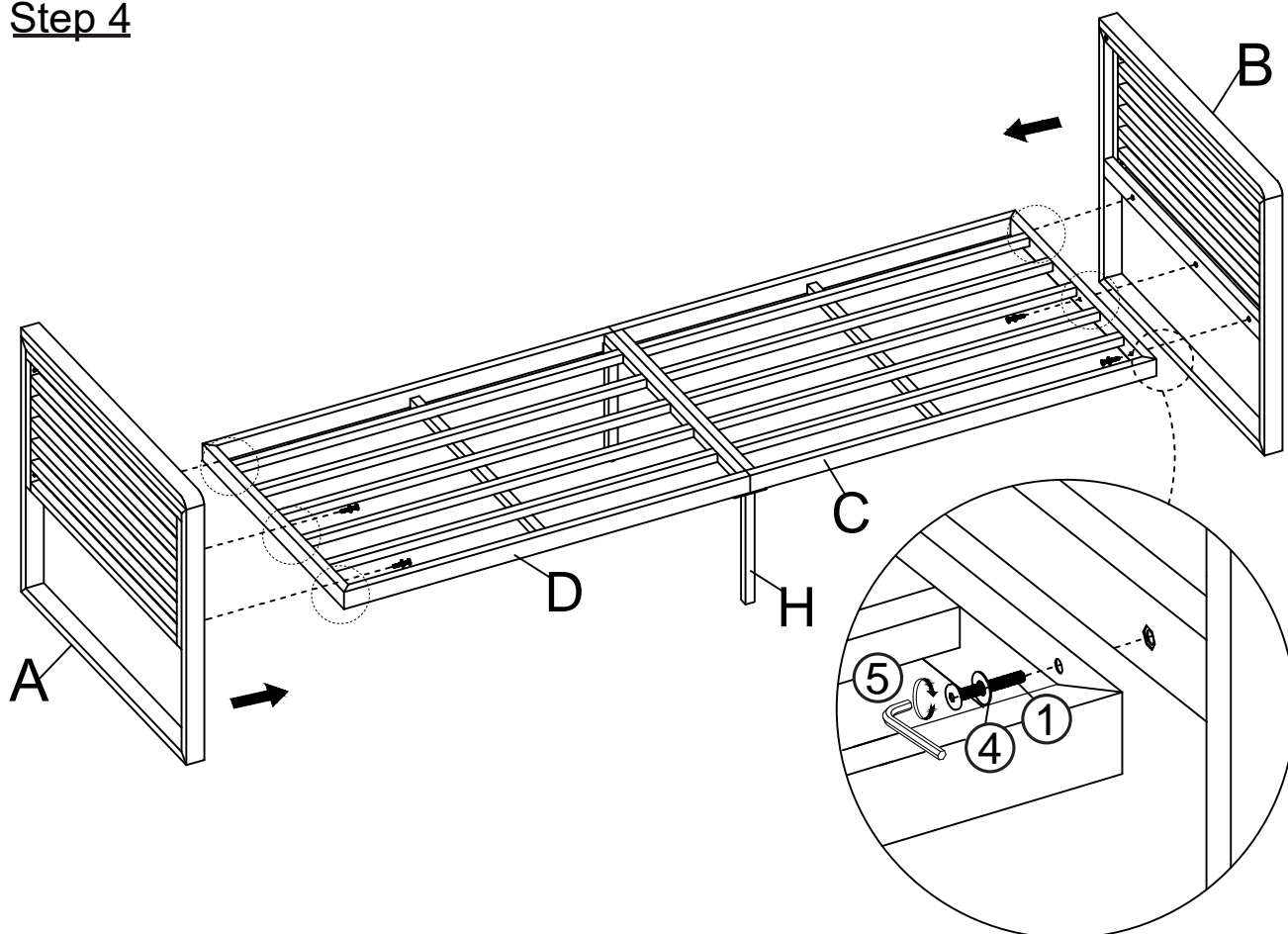
With assistance from your adult partner, place the seat Panel(D) and the seat Panel(C) facedown onto a clean, non marring surface, then attach them together by using the Bolts (1), Washers (4) and the Allen Wrench (5). **DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.**

Step 3



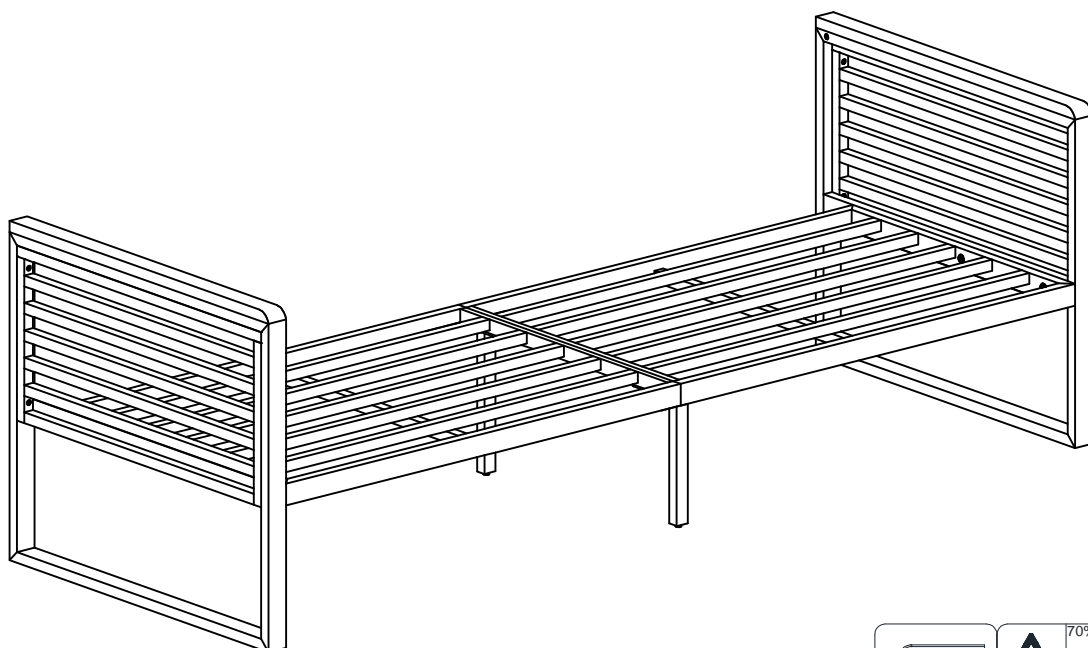
Then attach the Leg panel (H) to Seat panel frame by using Bolts (2), Washers (4) and Allen Wrench (5). **DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.**

Step 4

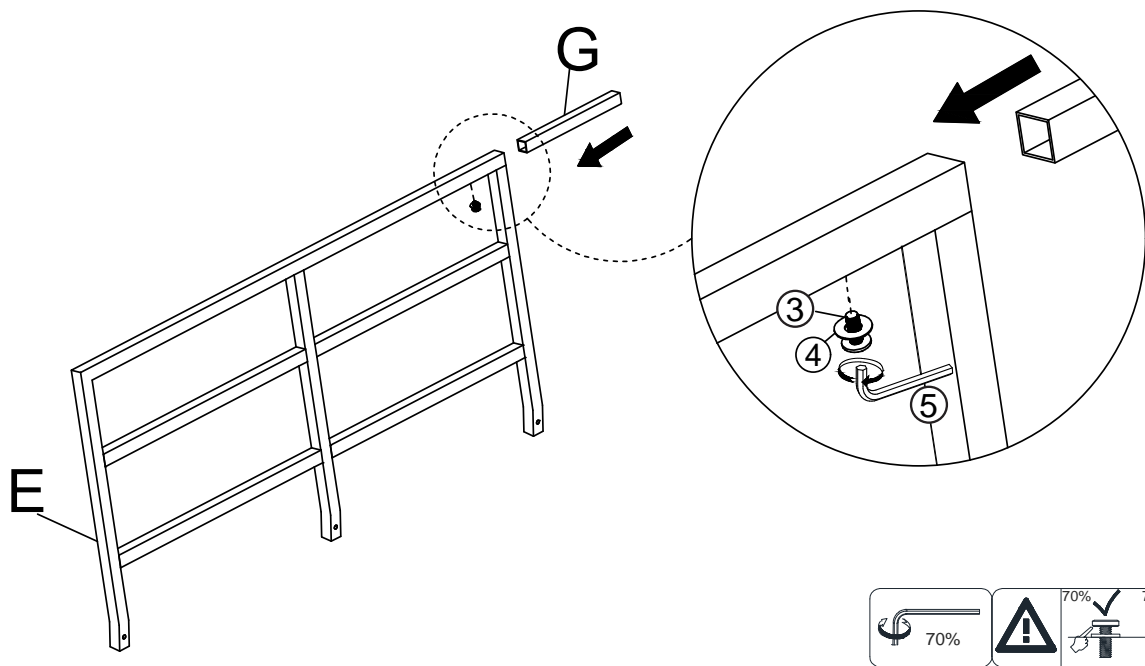


With assistance from your partner, attach the Left Leg Panel (A) and Left Leg Panel (B) to Seat panel frame by using Bolts (1), Washers (4) and Allen Wrench (5).

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.



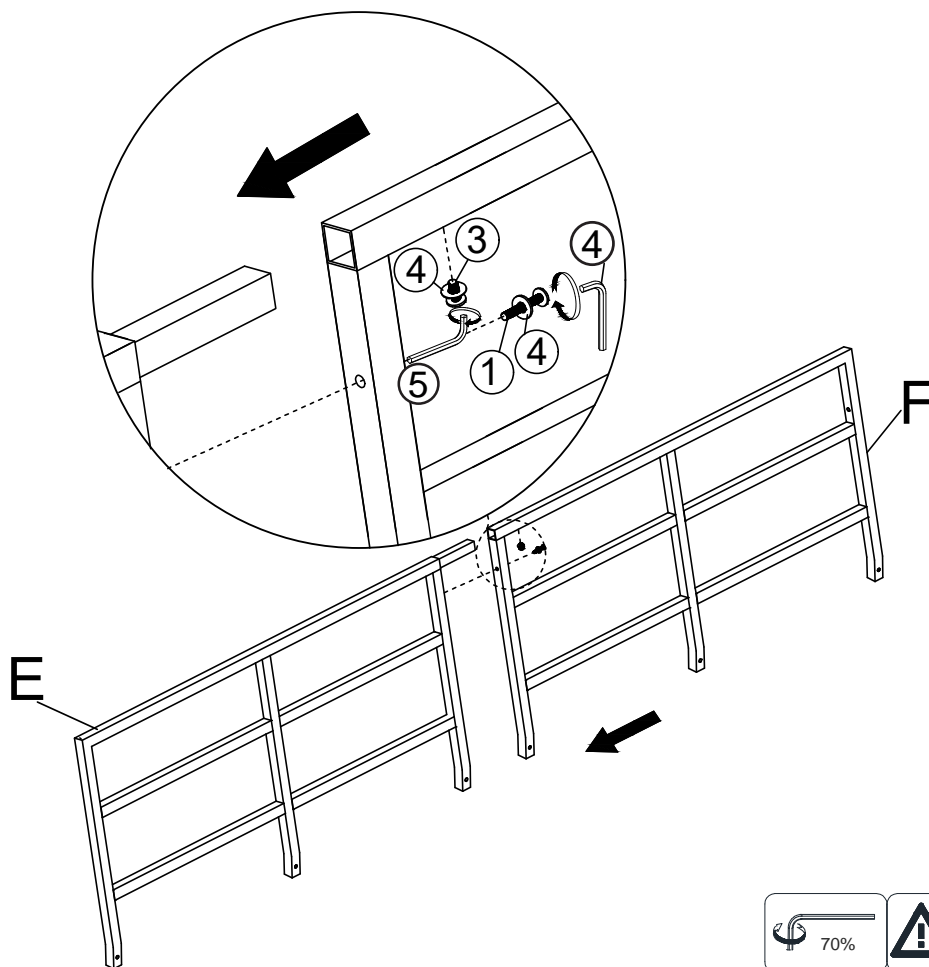
Step 5



Place the Backrest Panel (E) and the Support Bar (G) down onto a clean, non marring surface, then attach them by using the Bolts (3), Washers (4) and the Allen Wrench (5).

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 6

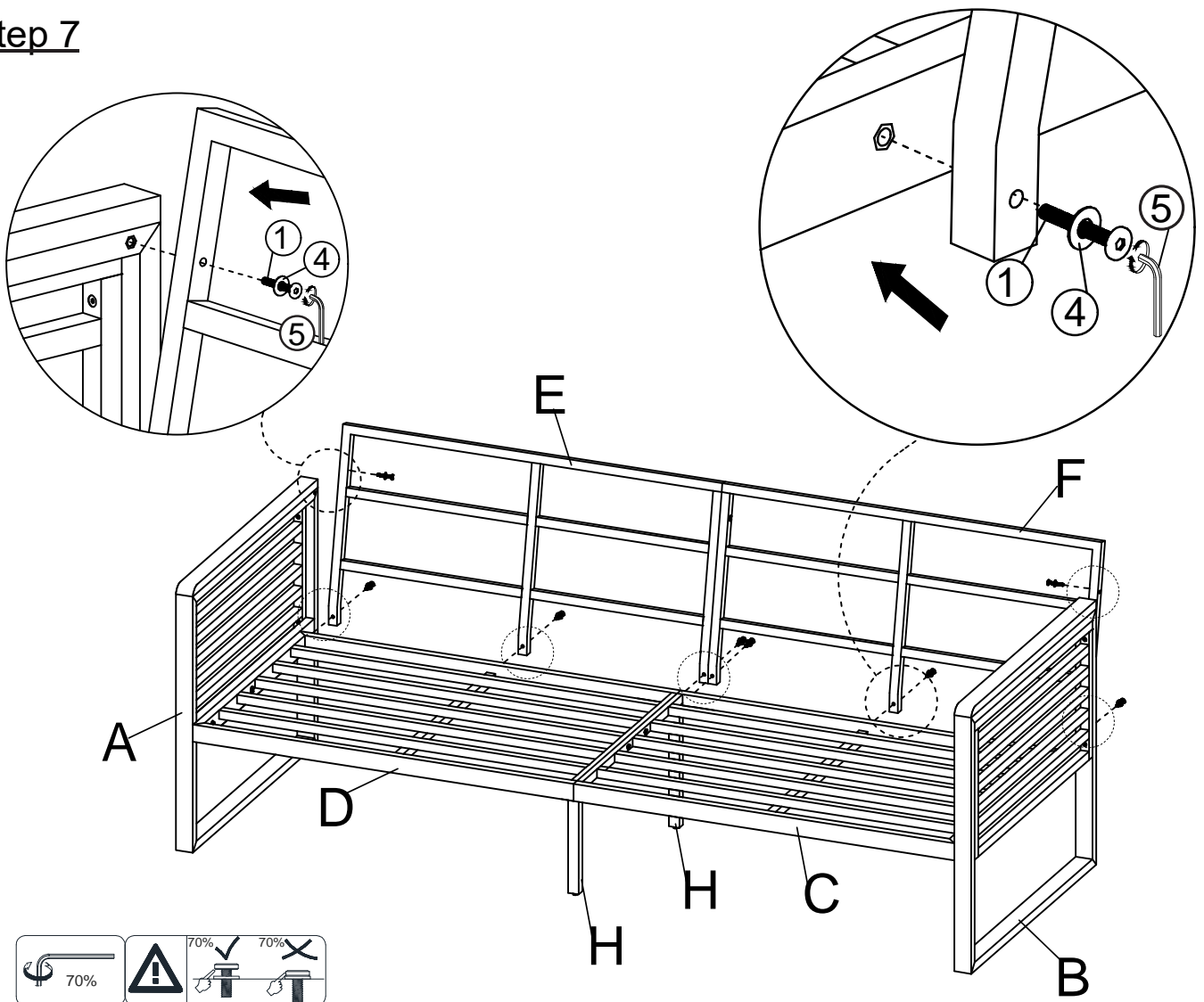


Then attach the Backrest Panel (F) by using Bolts (3), Washers (4) and Allen Wrench (5).

And attach backrest E and F by using Bolts (1), Washers (4) and Allen Wrench (5).

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

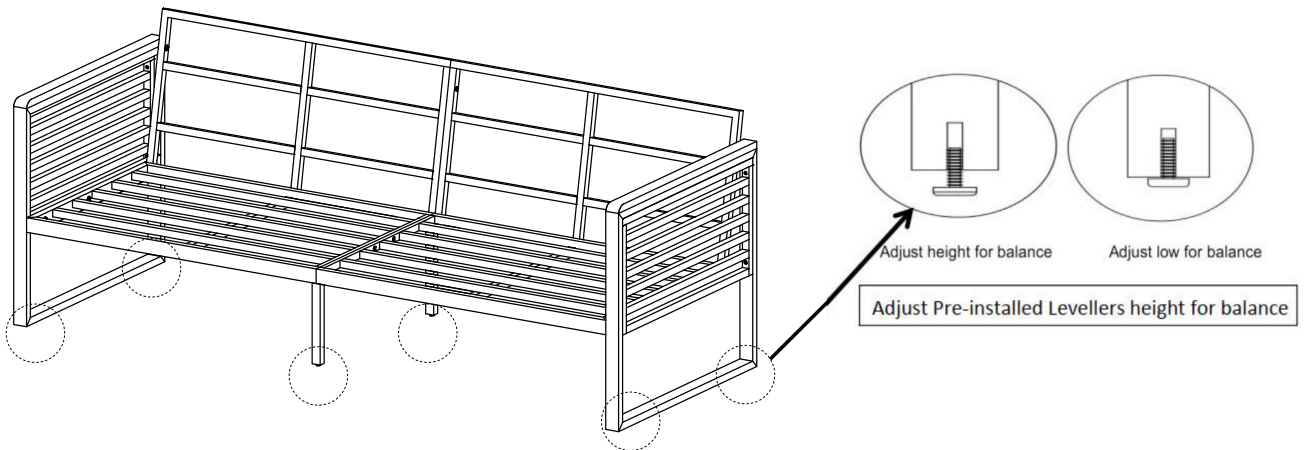

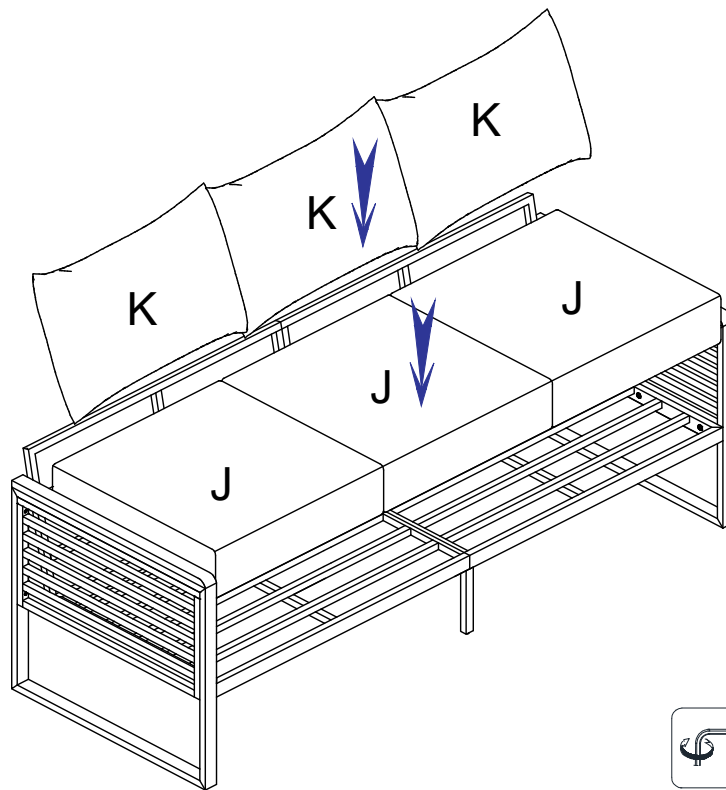


Then attach the Backrest Panel frame to the Seat and Leg frame by using Bolts (1), Washers (4) and Allen Wrench (5).

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

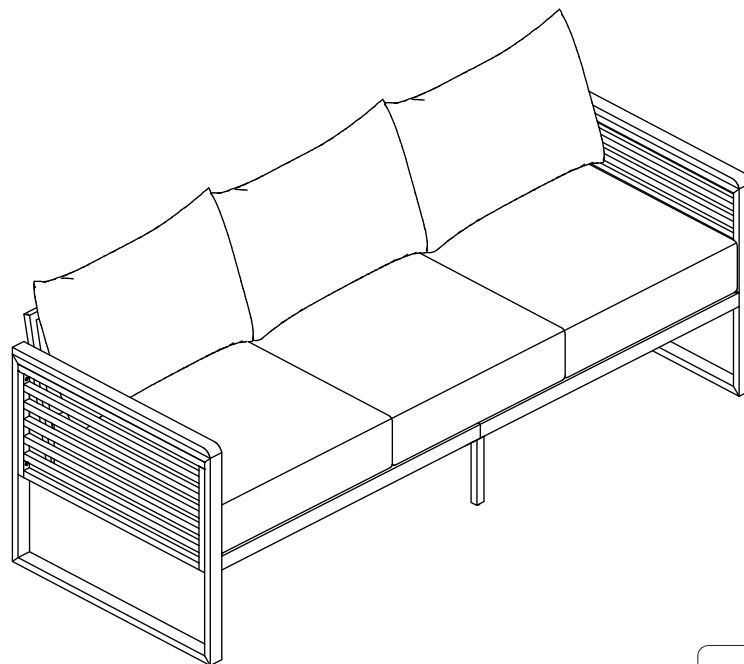
Step 8





With assistance from your adult partners, turn the Chair back to normal flat ground.
 Place the Seat Cushion (J) and the Backrest Pillow (K) onto the Chair as shown above.
 Place the Chair on a LEVEL surface.
 Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.
 Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Chair. This pressure will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.
 Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface. If no wobbles are found, proceed to tighten the Bolts and Screws in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.
 Adjust the Levelers until the Chair is level with the ground.
 To adjust the Levelers, get assistance from an adult partner to lift/lean and hold the Chair while you are working.

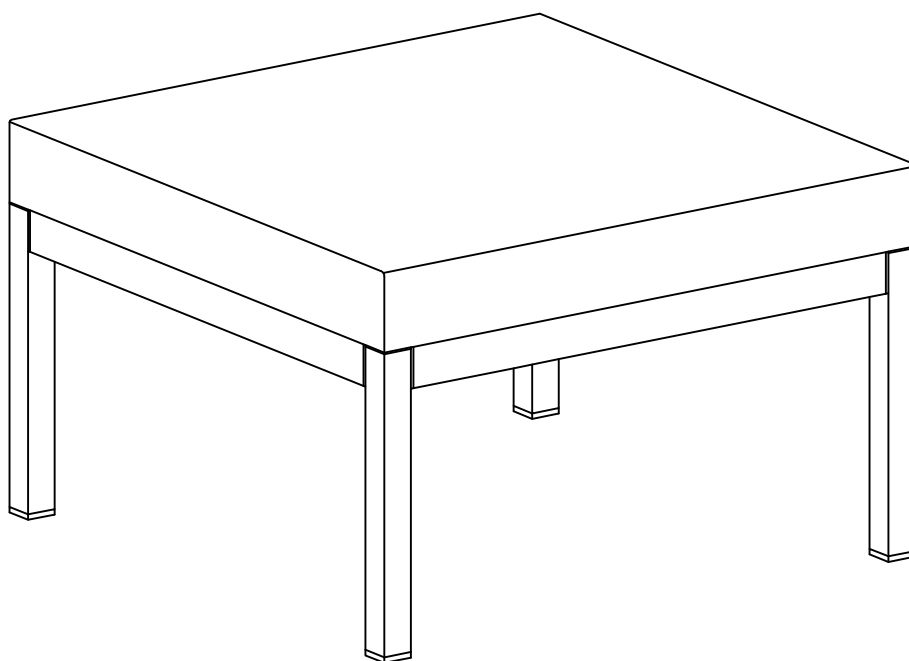

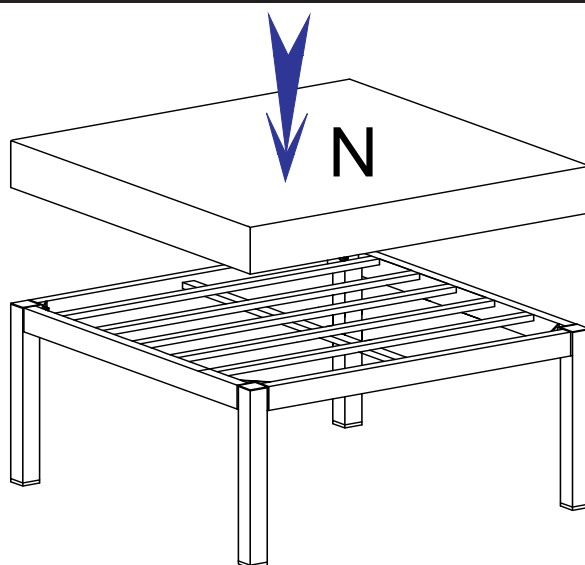
Step 2



Attach Leg Panel (M) to Frame Panel (L) by using Bolts (1), Washer (2) with Allen Wrench (3). Repeat the same process with the remaining three Legs (M).

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 3



Then, turn it right side up.

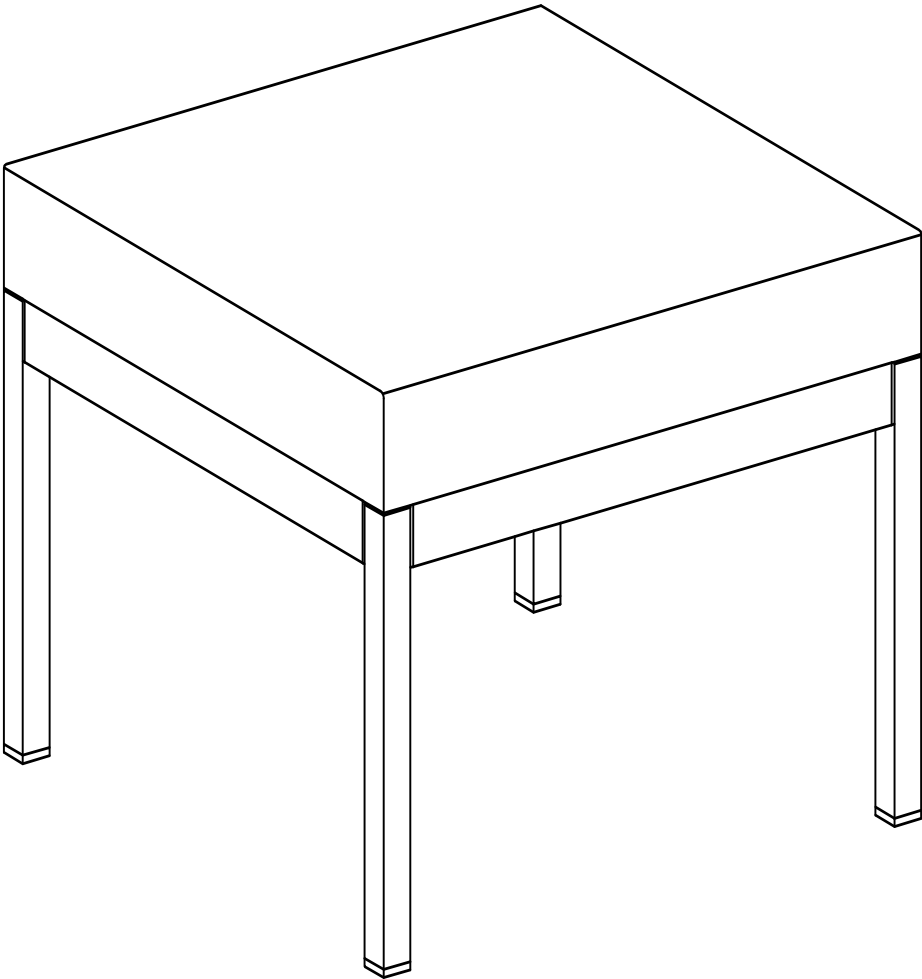
Place the Seat Cushion (N) onto the Chair as shown above.

Place the Chair on a LEVEL surface.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Chair. This pressure will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.

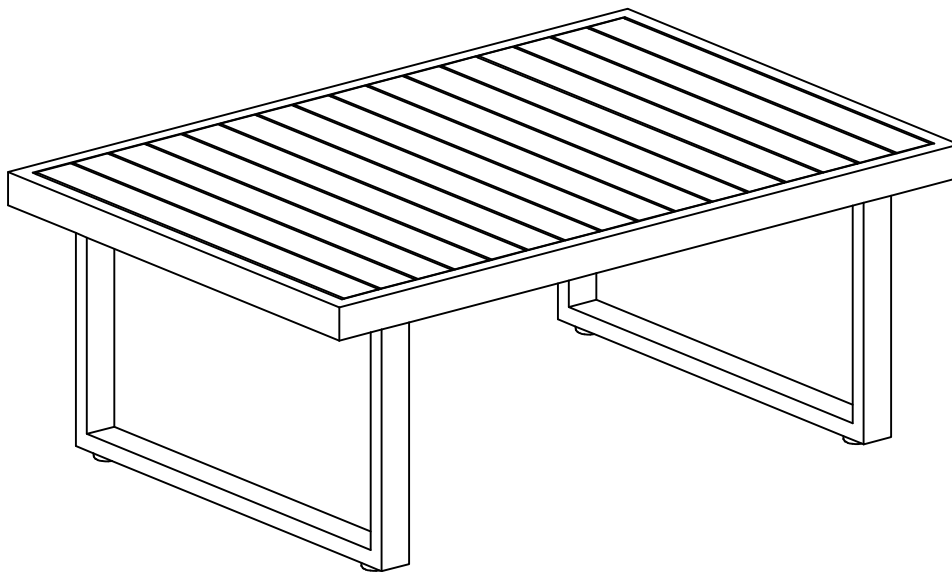

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non - marring surface.

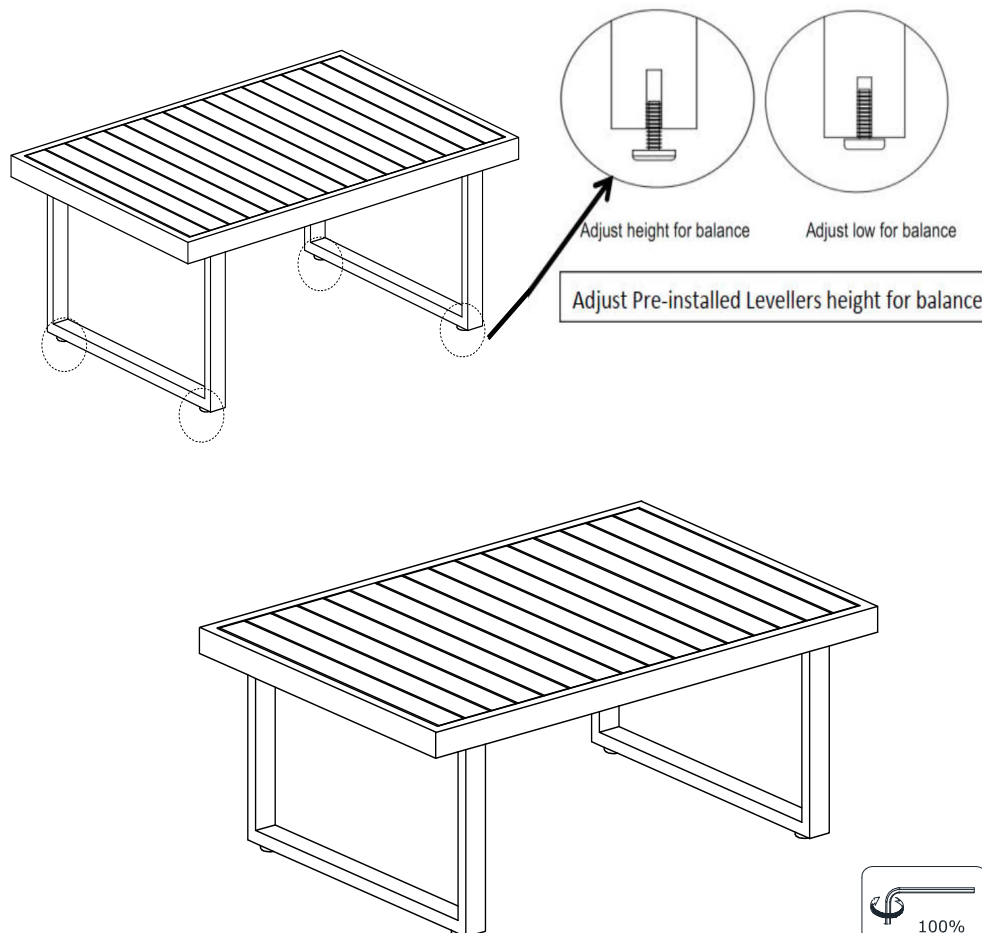
Step 2



With assistance from your adult partner, place the Table Top (Q) facedown onto a clean, nonmarring surface, attach Leg Panel (P) to Table top (Q) by using the Bolts (1), Washers (2) and the Allen Wrench (3). Repeat the same process with the remaining leg.

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 3



Turn it right side up.

Place the table onto a flat level surface.

Then Exert pressure onto the table with both hands follow floorwards, this pressure will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.

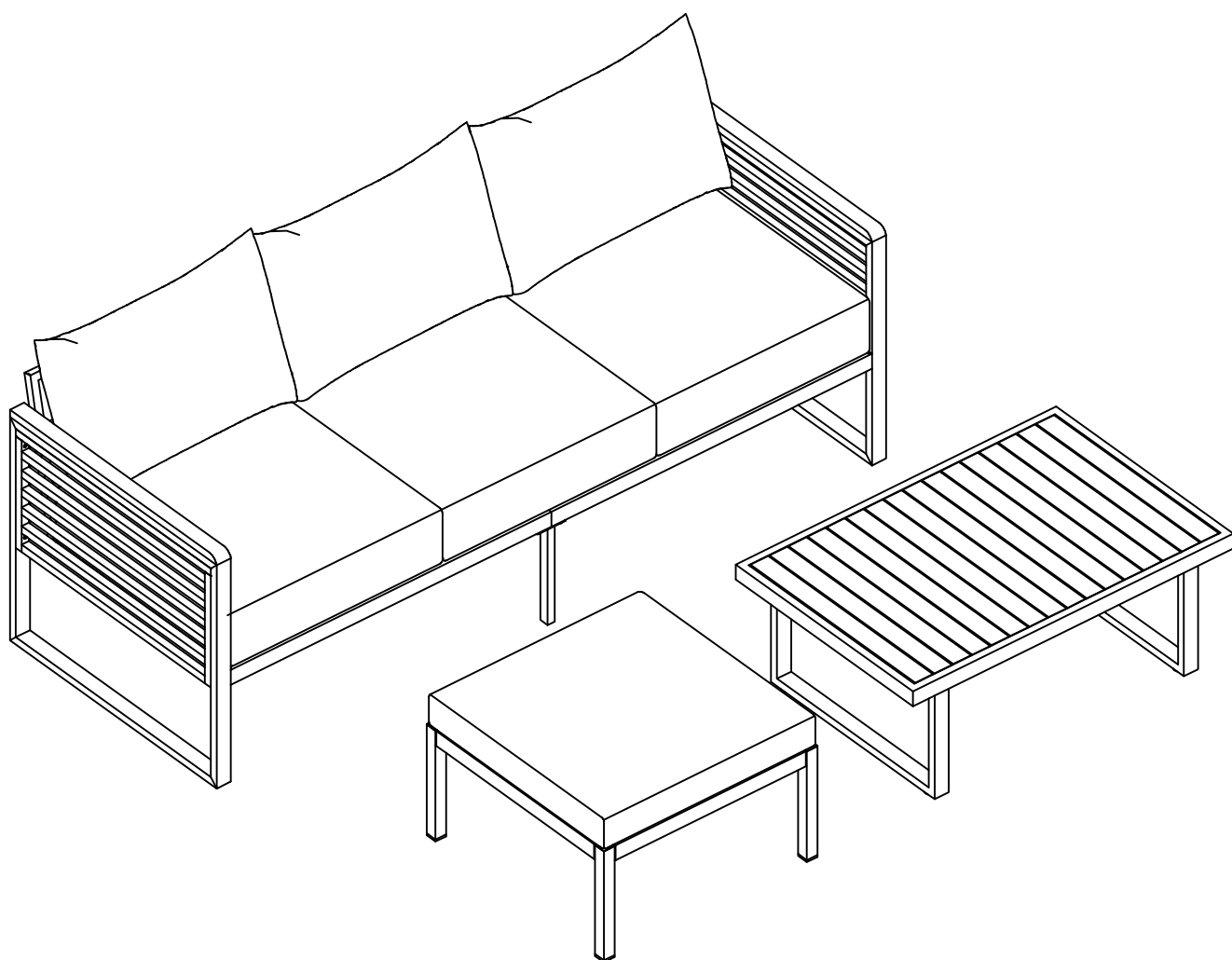
Check for wobbles on a Level surface.

If no wobbles are found, in a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts and Screws at all joints untill evenly secured.

Inspect the table and make sure all parts areadequately connected.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
