



 - ✓ Spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.




Assembly Steps




This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 20 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




Attach Left leg (A) to Seat panel (C). Use Allen wrench (4) with Bolts (2). DO NOT: Fully tighten the Bolts.




From step 2, using the Allen wrench (4), attach Back panel (D) into assembly as shown above by using Bolts (1).

DO NOT: Fully tighten the Bolts.




From step 3, using the Allen wrench (4), attach Right leg (B) into assembly as shown above by using Screw (3).

DO NOT: Fully tighten the Bolts and Screw.



From step 4, using the Allen wrench (4), attach bolts (2), Bolts (1), Screw (3) into assembly as shown above.

DO NOT: Fully tighten the Bolts and Screw.




With assistance from your adult partner, turn the Loveseat right side up. Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Carefully sit on the Loveseat. This pressure will help align all parts at all joints.

Then get off the Loveseat and proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner.

When tightening the Bolts tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any Bolt fully and then move on towards the next one. If there are any wobbles after tightening, loosen the Bolts and execute this same process.




Place the Seat Cushion (E) and Back Cushions (F) on the Chair as shown above.


Overview



This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 25 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.




Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.



Please carefully upside down Table Top (H). Insert Table Leg (G) to Table Top (H) by using Bolts (2) as shown in the above picture.

DO NOT: Fully tighten the Bolts and Screw.





Stand the Table up with assistance from your adult partner.

Then EXERT pressure, push floorwards onto the Table with both hands.

This pressure will help the Table reach full alignment at all joints.

Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.

If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.

When tightening the Bolts tighten sequentially.

Do not tighten any Bolt fully and then move on towards the next one.

If the table still wobbles, loosen the Bolts and execute the same above process.

It is important to stabilize the table. If it is not Stable, it could lead to damage of the product.

Your Table is ready for use.

This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list? The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.
- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
