
















 To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.

Assembly Steps


Overview



This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair parts, the above picture is provided to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




Place the Left Leg (A), Right Leg (B) and Seat Frame (E) with its inner side face skywards onto a clean, soft surface to avoid any scratches or damages to the product.

With the help from your partner, stand the assembled Left Leg (A), Right Leg (B) and Seat Frame (E) standing as shown in picture above.

Align the Mounting Position of Left Leg (A), Right Leg (B) into the Mounting Position of Seat Frame (E) as shown above.


Then, affix the Seat Frame (E) with Left Leg (A) and Right Leg (B) by using Hex Screw (1) with Allen Wrench (M4) (6).



Align the Mounting Position of 2 Back Leg (C) into the Mounting Position of Seat Frame (E) as shown above.


Then, affix the Back Leg (C) to Seat Frame (E) by using Bolts (3) with Allen Wrench (M4) (6).

Step 4




Align the Mounting Position of Back Leg (C) into the mounting positions of Backrest Frame (D).

Then, affix the Back Leg (C) to Backrest Frame (D) by using Bolt (3) and Connecting Cap (4) with Allen Wrench (M4) (6).




Align the Mounting Position of Left Leg (A), Right Leg (B) into the mounting positions of Backrest Frame (D) as shown in picture above.

Then, affix the Left Leg (A), Right Leg (B) to Backrest Frame (D) by using L Bracket (5), Hex Screw (2) with Allen Wrench (M4) (6).




Align the Mounting Position of Left Leg (A), Right Leg (B) into the mounting positions of Backrest Frame (D) as shown in picture above.


Then, affix the Left Leg (A), Right Leg (B) to Backrest Frame (D) by using L Bracket (⑤), Hex Screw (②) with Allen Wrench (M4) (⑥).



Put Seat Cushion (F) on the Seat Frame (E).



Tight ropes under the Seat Cushion (F) on the Seat Frame (E).



Put Back Cushion (G) on the Chair.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

• What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list? The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.
- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
