Assembly Instructions

CAUTION: You must read these Assembly Instructions before you proceed.




Never adjust chaise lounge or recliner backrest while seated.

Always make sure the backrest is flat before moving the chaise lounge.


Keep all limbs clear from under the backrest when it is in a raised position.

Serious finger, hand, or other bodily injuries may result from adjusting the chaise lounge backrest position while seated.



The examples pictured above are non exhaustive and are for your reference only







• Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



• Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



 To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor product minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



• Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



• Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



 To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine.
Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.




• Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



• Have 2 adultpartner in the assembly.




Do not assemble on flooring or carpet.



Assemble on a clean non-marring surface




Save all packaging until completion of assembly.




This Sun Lounger has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Sun Lounger, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




With the help of your adult partner,

Step 2.1, put the tenons of Right Lower Bar (I) and Right Upper Bar (G) to the mortises of Right Middle Leg (K) and then secure by using Bolts (⑤) and Allen Wrench (⑩) as shown above.

Step 2.2, put the mortises of Back Leg Frame (C) to the tenons of Right Lower Bar (I) and Right Upper Bar (G) of the assembled part in Step 2.1 and then secure by using Bolts (⑤), Nut (⑦), Bolts (⑥) and Allen Wrench (⑩) as shown above.

Note: Affix the Bolt (⑤) into the Nut (⑦) inside the Right Lower Bar (I) and Right Upper Bar (G) then remove Bolt (⑤) from the Nut (⑦).

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.




With the help of your adult partner,

Step 3.1, put the tenons of Left Lower Bar (H) and Left Upper Bar (F) to the mortises of Left Middle Leg (J) and then secure by using Bolts (5) and Allen Wrench (0) as shown above.

Step 3.2, put the tenons of Left Lower Bar (H) and Left Upper Bar (F) in the assembled part in Step 3.2 to the mortises of of Back Leg Frame (C) of the assembled part in Step 2 and then secure by using Bolts (5), Nut (7), Bolts (6) and Allen Wrench (10) as shown above.


Note: Affix the Bolt (⑤) into the Nut (⑦) inside the Right Lower Bar (I) and Right Upper Bar (G) then remove Bolt (⑤) from the Nut (⑦).

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.



With the help of your adult partner, attach Cross Bar (D) to the assembled part in Step 3 and then secure Cross Bar (D) to Left Middle Leg (J) and Right Middle Leg (K) by using Screws (①) and Allen Wrench (⑩) as shown above.


DO NOT fully tighten the Screws.



With the help of your adult partner, place Seat Panel (B) facing down as shown above.


Step 5.1, attach Front Legs (L) to Seat Panel (B) and then secure by using Bolts (5), Flat Washer (9) and Allen Wrench (10).

Step 5.2, attach Support Leg (E) to Seat Panel (B) and then secure by using Screws (1) and Allen Wrench (10). DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts and Screws.




With the help of your adult partner, attach the assembled part in Step 4 and Step 5 together by using Bolts (4) and Allen Wrench (10) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.




With the help of your adult partner, turn the assembled part in Step 6 left side down and then secure Left Middle Leg (J) and Right Middle Leg (K) to Seat Panel (B) by using Screws (2) and Allen Wrench (10) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Screws.



With the help of your adult partner, attach Backrest Panel (A) to the assembled part in Step 7 and then secure by using Screws (③), Flat Washers (⑧) and Allen Wrench (⑩) as shown above.

DO NOT fully tighten the Screws.



Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Sun Lounger.

This will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.

Then get off the Sun Lounger and in a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts, Screws at all joints until evenly connected.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts, Screws and execute this same process.

Place the Cushion (M) by affix the Magic Tape Straps on the Seat Panel (B) as shown above.

WARNING!! IF SUN LOUNGER IS NOT STABLE, IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT. Your Sun Lounger is ready for use.

This Sun Lounger can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Note: Align the Backrest of Sunlounger in position you want.
