Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor product minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.



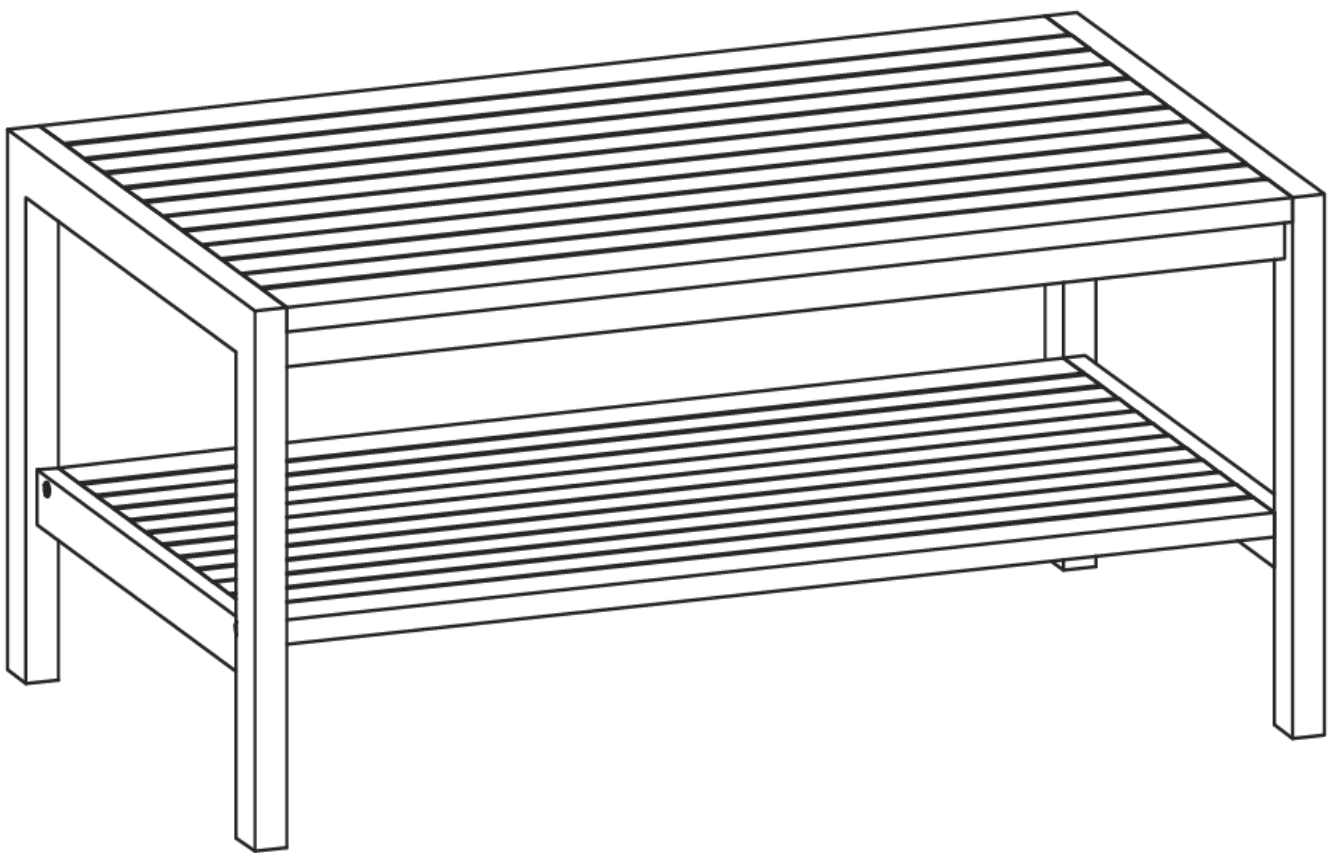
- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.







- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint- free cloth.

• Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



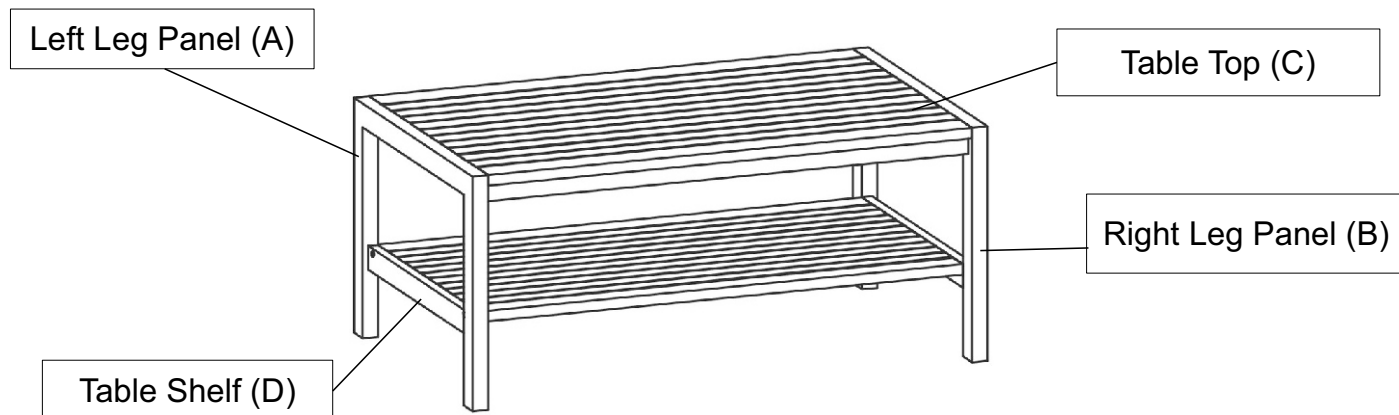
• Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

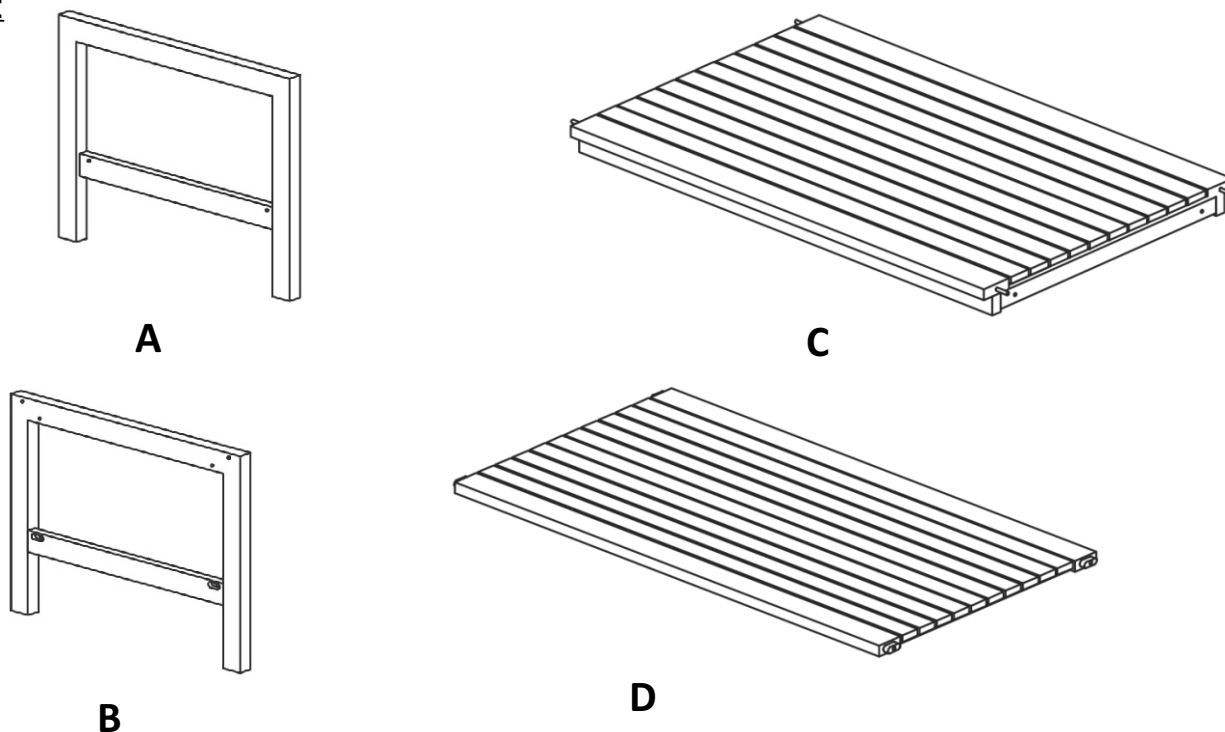
Overview:



FRONT FACING

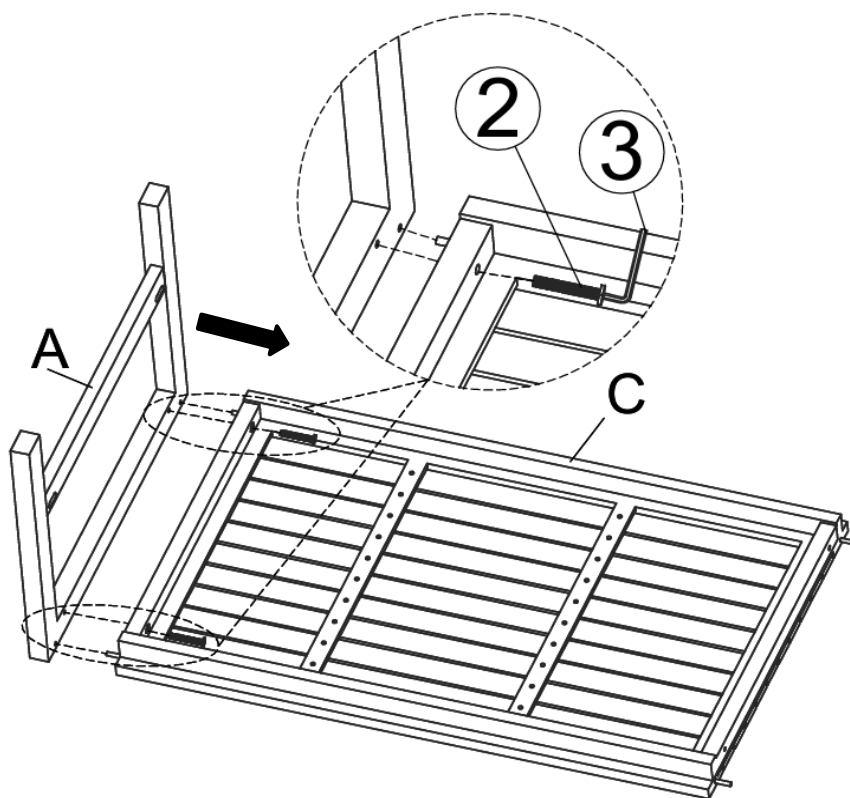
This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 20 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1:



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

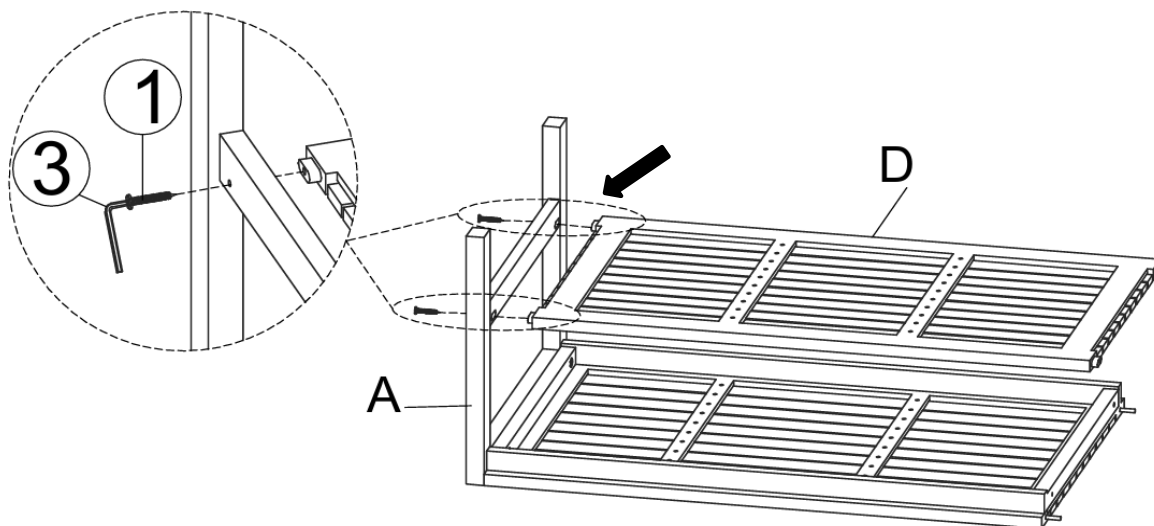
Step 2:



With the help of your adult partner, place the Table Top (C) with its underside skywards onto a clean, soft surface to avoid any scratch or damage to the product. Attach the Left Leg Panel (A) to the Table Top (C) by using Bolts (②) and Allen Wrench (③) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

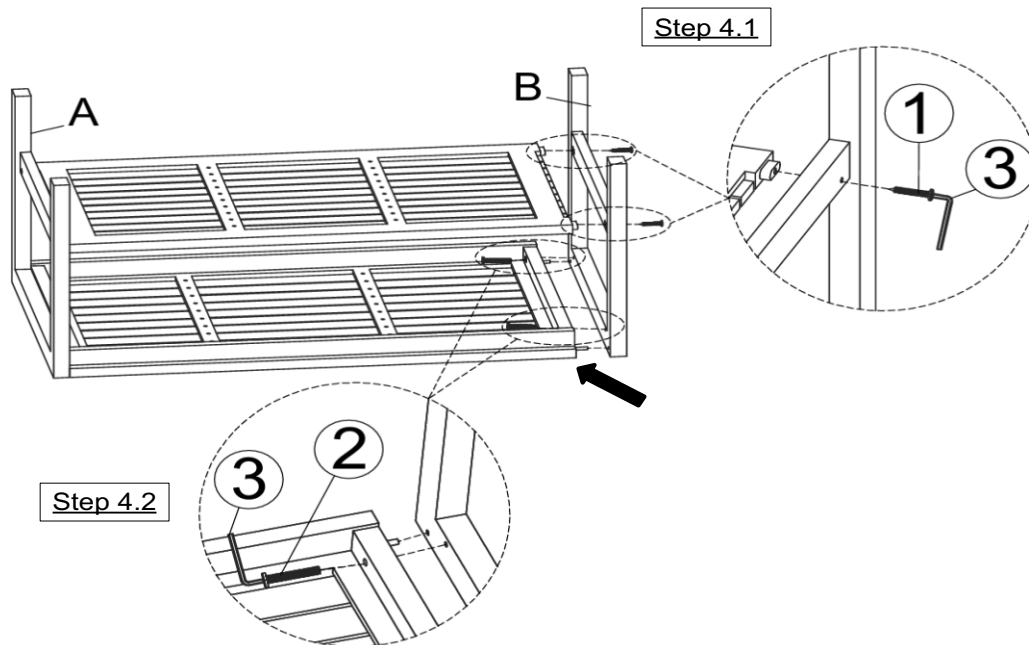
Step 3:



With the help of your adult partner, attach the Table Shelf (D) to the assembled part in Step 2 and then secure the Table Shelf (D) to the Left Leg Panel (A) by using Screws (①) and Allen Wrench (③) as shown above.

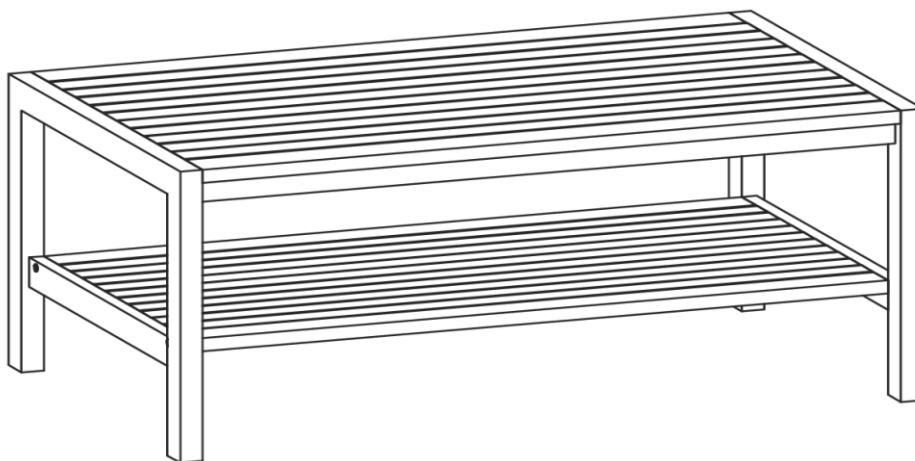
Do not fully tighten the Screws.

Step 4:



With the help of your adult partner, attach the Right Leg Panel (B) to the assembled part in Step 3 and then,
Step 4.1, secure the Right Leg Panel (B) to the Table Shelf (D) by using Screws (①) and Allen Wrench (③) as shown above.
Step 4.2, secure the Right Leg Panel (B) to the Table Top (C) by using Bolts (②) and Allen Wrench (③) as shown above.
Do not fully tighten the Bolts and Screws.

Step 5:



With the help of your adult partner, stand the Table up.
Exert pressure floorwards, onto the Table with both your hands.
This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach full alignment status.
Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.
If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Bolts and Screws in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.
When tightening the Bolts and Screws tighten sequentially.
Do not tighten any Bolt, Screw fully and then move on towards the next one.
If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts, Screws and execute the same above process.
WARNING!! IF TABLE IS NOT STABLE, IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.
Your Table is ready for use.
This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.
