CAUTION : You must read these Assembly Instructions before you proceed.




SAFETY WARNING

Never adjust chaise lounge or recliner backrest while seated.

Always make sure the backrest is flat before moving the chaise lounge.

Keep all limbs clear from under the backrest when it is in a raised position.

Serious finger, hand, or other bodily injuries may result from adjusting the chaise lounge backrest position while seated.


Care & Maintenance

- ⊗  ● Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊗  ● Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
- ⊗  ● Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊗  ● Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊗  ● Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊗  ● Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊗  ● Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  ● Keep away from sources of ignition.
- ✓  ● Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

Before Beginning Assembly:

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-


Assembly Steps

Overview




This Chaise Lounge has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chaise Lounge, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1




Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2




With assistance from your adult partner, please carefully upside down Backrest Frame (C) and Seat Frame (D). Insert two Post Connector (9) to Backrest Frame (C) and Seat Frame (D) by using Screw (8) as shown in the above picture. **Fully tighten the Screw.**

Step 3




From set 2. Attach Tray (E) and Tray Slide (I) to the Backrest Frame (C) by using Screw ①. **Fully tighten the Screw.**

Step 4




From set 3. Attach Front Leg Frame (F) to the Seat Frame (D) by using Bolts ②. **Fully tighten the Bolts.**

Step 5




From set 4, please carefully turn this side Seat Frame up as shown in the above picture. Attach Left Leg (A) to Backrest Frame (C) and Seat Frame (D) by using Bolts ② ③. **Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

Step 6




From set 5. Attach Leg Stretcher (G) to the Left Leg (A) .

Step 7




From set 6, please carefully turn this side Seat Frame up as shown in the above picture. Attach Right Leg (B) to Backrest Frame (C), Seat Frame (D) and Leg Stretcher (G) by using Bolts ② ③. **Fully tighten the Bolts.**

Step 8



Stand the Chaise Lounge up in step 7. Attach Wheel (H) to Left Right Leg (A) (B) by using Bolts ④, Round Steel ⑤, Washer ⑥ and Nut ⑦ as shown in the above picture. **Fully tighten the Bolts.**


Step 9




Place the Cushion (I) on the Chaise Lounge as shown above. Tight Cushion (I) ropes directly to the frame underneath the Backrest Frame (C) and Seat Frame (D) .

Step 10

Chaise lounge back reset level.



Lift up or drop down the back rest as your desisted



Push out or push in the table top as your desisted.

Caution: Be careful when folding Backrest to avoid the finger strapped at the folding joint.
Your Chaise is ready for use.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
