#### Care & Maintenance



Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



 Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



• Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



 Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



• Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



 Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



• Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



 Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

NEVER suspend strings over bed.



Not intended for children under the age of six. INFANTS HAVE DIED FROMBECOMING ENTRAPPED IN BEDs. Openings in and between bed parts can entrapthe neck and head of a small child.

NEVER use bed for child under the age of six.

The mattress must be appropriately sized for the bed. If the mattress is undersizeddangerous gaps can exist and a person can become entrapped or entangled in theframe and suffocate.


This Bed has multiple parts and may require up to some 60 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bed parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.




Attach Headboard (A) to Headboard (B) with wooden dowels (2) and metal hardware (3)




Attach the metal hardware (4) to the Headboard (B) with screws (8) & the Support Frame (F) with screws (9) and necessary assembly tools (Not included) (12).




Attach the metal leg (E) to the Footboard (C) using screws (10) and the necessary assembly tools (Not included) (12).




Attach the metal hardware (4) to the Footboard (C) with screws (8) & the Support Frame (F) with screws (9) and necessary assembly tools (Not included) (12).



Attach the Metal Hardware (5) to the left and right rails (D) with screws (5) along with the necessary assembly tools (Not included) (12).



Attach the left and right side rails (D) to the Headboard (B) and Footboard (C) using wooden dowels (2) and Bolts (1) along with the necessary assembly tools (Not included) (12).



Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list? The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.
- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
